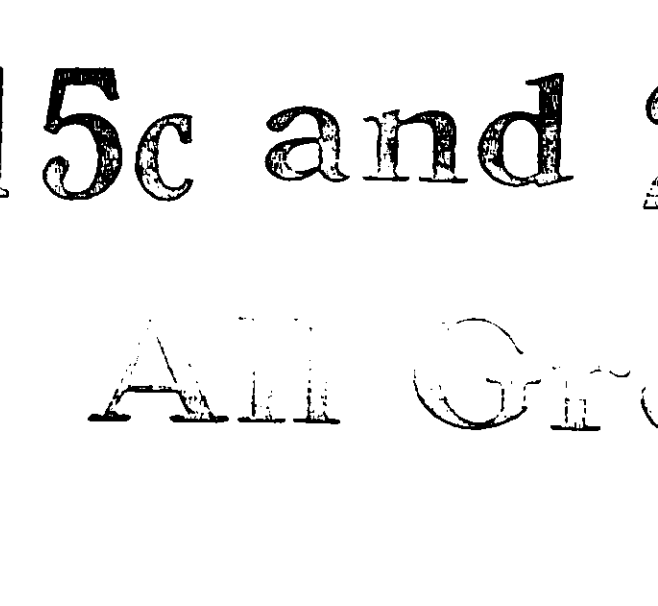
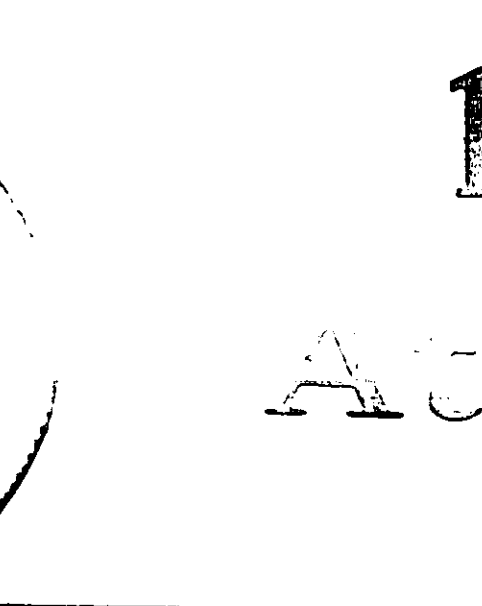

of such restraint shall be upon the party contending that such restraint is not reasonable.

It makes the violation of the law a crime and defines in detail and with great exactness what specific acts shall in themselves, at all times constitute unlawful restraint of trade within the meaning of the Sherman anti-trust act, thereby removing the uncertainty and the consequent ineffectiveness of a criminal statute caused by the recent Supreme Court decision.

It likewise provides very definitely for such punishment of the combinations which engage in these illegal practices as to make it improbable that they will continue them.

It makes the violation of any combination for violation of law the basis of damage claims from all who have been injured by these combinations. And it provides, in addition to each dissolution as the court may order in the course of the Standard Oil and tobacco trust, the restitution of money illegally wrested from victims other through contracts in restraint of trade or the destruction of the business of the individuals.

It also removes the danger of future parties losing the right to punishment through the statute which it provides that a cause of action should not be barred if the defendant has been injured by the law.

The La Follette measure, though largely the work of the senator from Wisconsin, represents the combined thought and labor of a group of distinguished lawyers of progressive sympathies. The measure is a masterpiece of legislative art, clear, concise, and effective.

It is clear that to accept a final party in the public mind, the definition of what acts constitute a violation of the law is of the utmost importance.

It is no wonder that Champ Clark is pleased with the record made by the Democrats in Congress. In less than two years they have made a record which has been made under adversity and successful leadership.


