Even skunk has dropped its ungraceful name "Alaska Sable" and under its own name holds a high place in fashionable favor.

A Novel Combination

A novel combination new this season is the trimmed with skunk, made up most attractively in sets of stole and muff, that are set off with soft floppy bows of black mesaline satin. Broadtail and ermine make a most distinguished contrast. The long scarf stole of the black fur with ends of ermine are trimmed with narrow bull fringe. The muff of the same fur has Vandyke points that are very new and smart. Muffs are all very large, very flat and so flexible that they can be crumpled up in any direction.

Stiffness of any sort is a thing of the past in making up furs, and weight has disappeared with the stiffening. Many of the new muffs have pockets on the outside.

Expensive Pieces

Sets for young girls and for wear with tailored suits are of Civet cat, Lynx, Raccoon, Muskrat and American Fox. These all wear well and lend a very fashionable air to the plainest get up, or go well with more elaborate clothes.

Coronets Bars

The huge bars of elegant materials that were carried by peeresses at King George's coronation to hold all the various things that might be needed during the long hours in Westminster Abbey, have set the style for elaborate hats this year. All sorts of brocades and velvets, materials, embellished with beads, gold or silver galloons and embroideries, are used for these hats, and one sees them quite as much on the street as at the theatre, when they are seen more in keeping with the surroundings. Bars of match the hat, muff or stole are what all the girls desire and there made up with velvet and for the most favored bits of elegance. 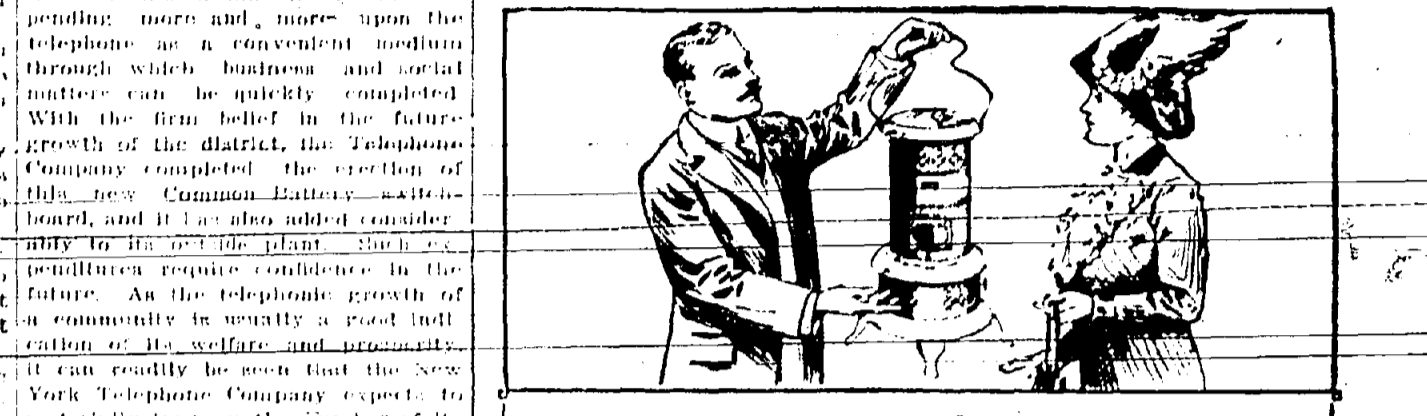

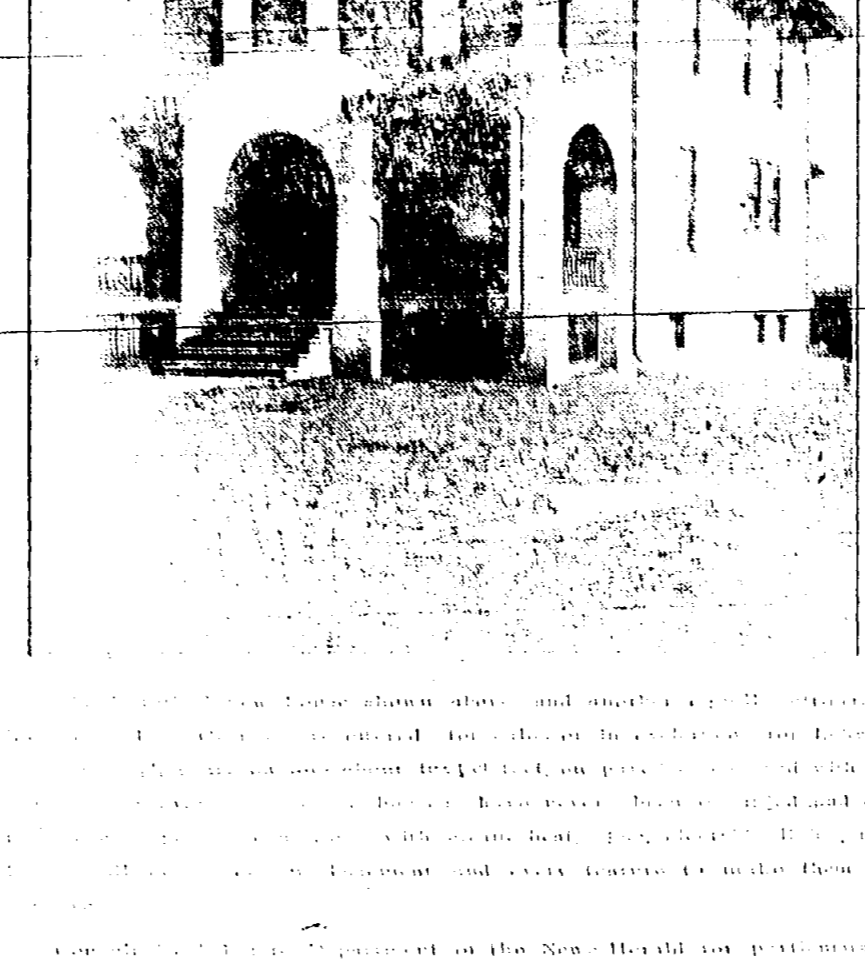
