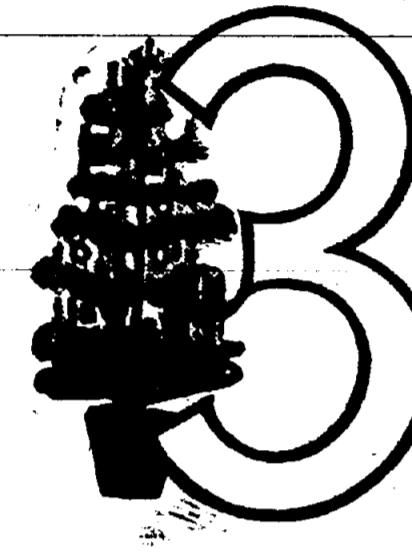

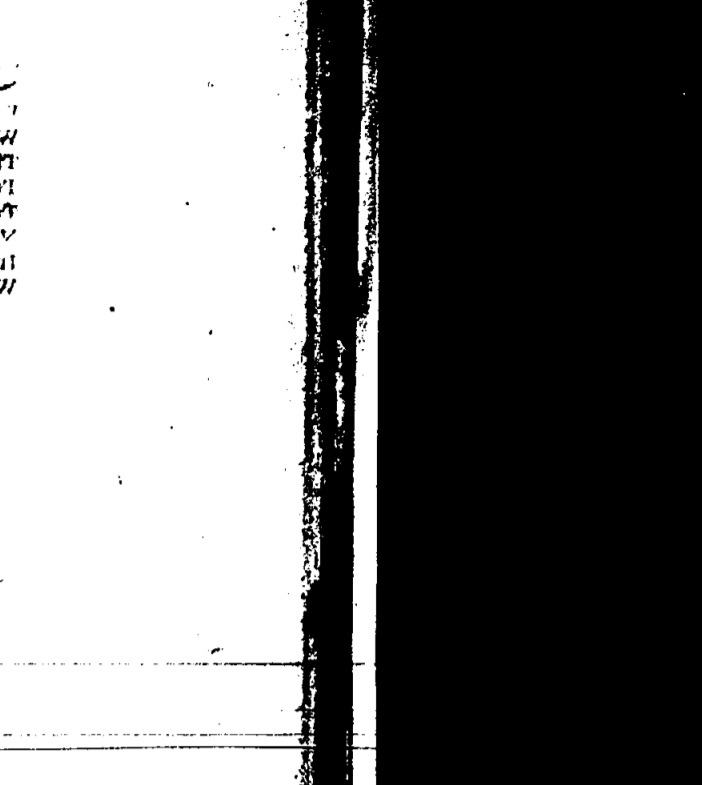

She was impetuous, bold, dazzling and scornful, often insolent, and made the King ridiculous by her relations to the stage, yet she was created Duchess of Cleveland and vastly enriched by the merry monarch.

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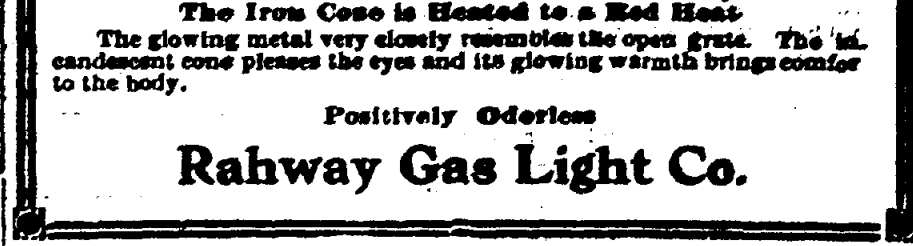

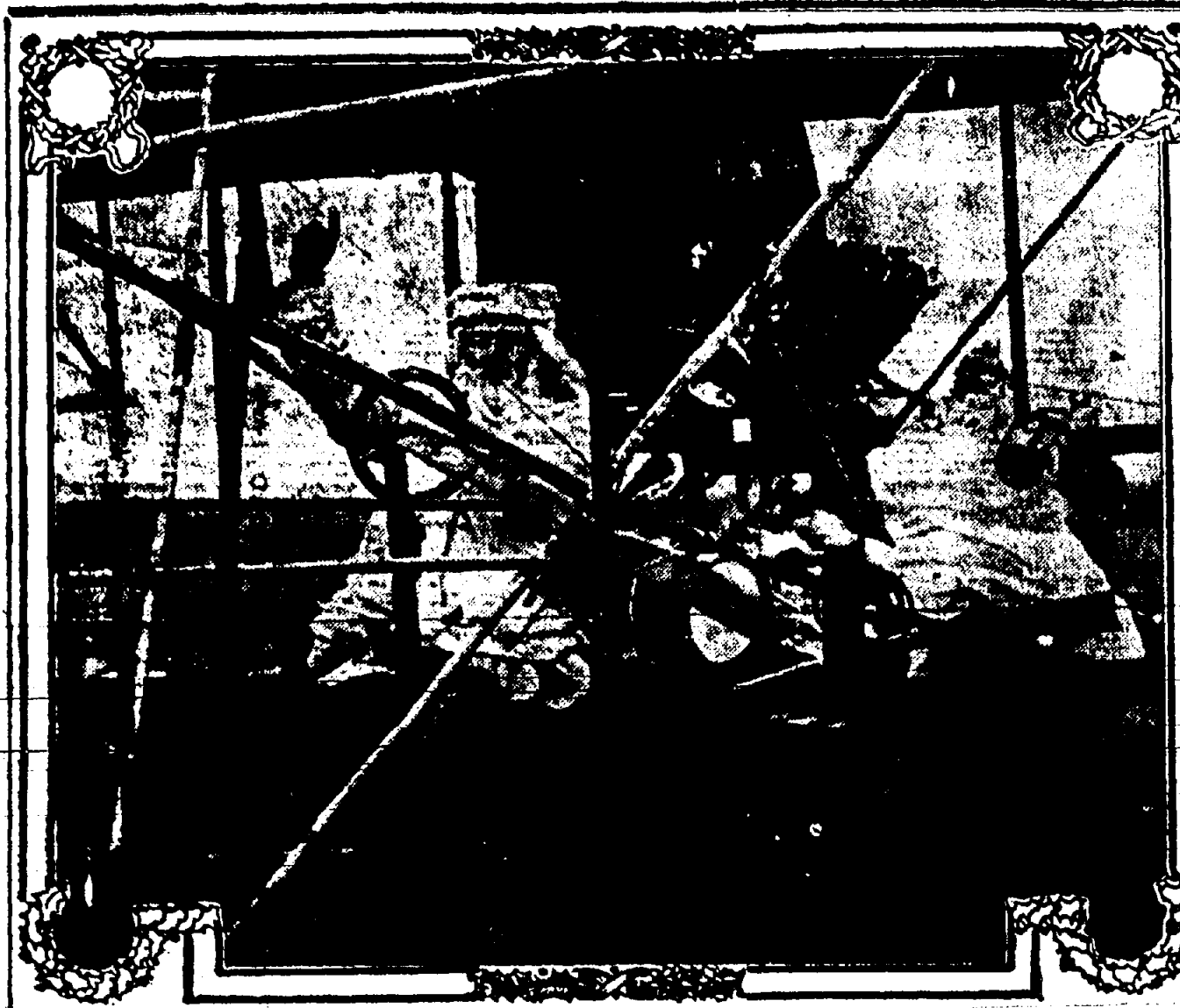

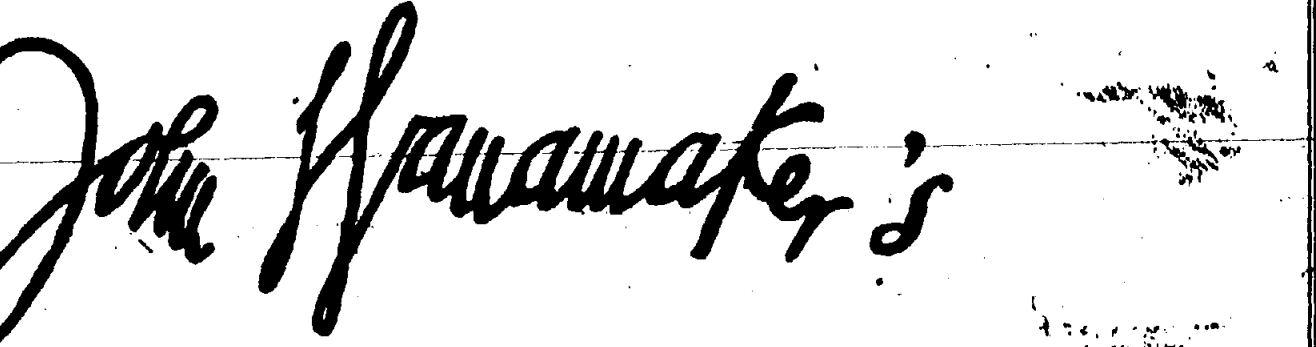
