Columbian, Washington School Contracts Awarded 50 Yrs. Ago

Contract covering all work for both Bell High School and Washington School was awarded for \$31,600 on August 27, 1907. Schools Start 50th Year.

Fifty years is a long time for a school building to last. The many changes in building and educational methods in the past half-century. The high school erected on Campbell street in 1908 lasted just thirty years before it gave way to the \$150,000 structure on Madison street which opened September 1, 1938. One Local School Built In 1873 --- Two Others Start 50th Year



Pictured here are three Rahway schools which are of real ancient lineage. At the right on top is the Washington School which is over on Grand avenue and below is the Columbian School, still in use on New Brunswick avenue. Just fifty years ago this week the contract to build the two schools, Washington and Columbian, was awarded for \$31,600. On September 1st they start their fiftieth year of service. All three schools together, cost less than \$50,000. The present Franklin School cost \$150,000 and the High School over \$750,000.


