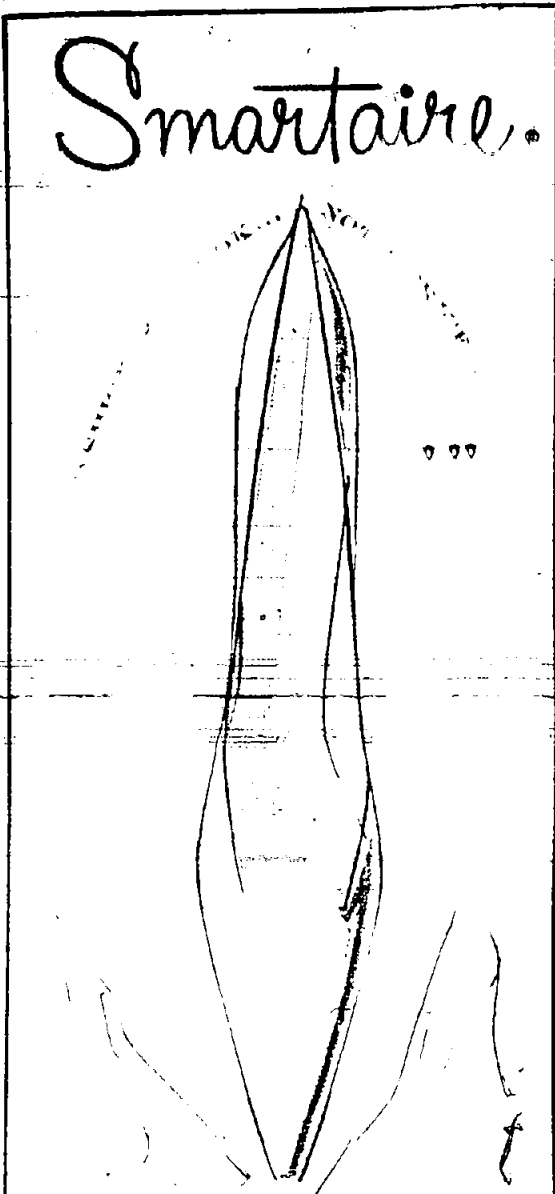

In Hospital.
Outlined

Your doctor is notified as soon
as you are admitted. He will issue
all orders for your care and treat-
ment until you are discharged. The
hospital staff can act only on his
orders. Of course, your doctor will
visit you regularly in the hospital.

Nurses—Registered nurses, in-
cluding practical nurses, and un-
certified aides are on duty on all floors
24 hours a day.

Private duty nurses may be ar-
ranged for by your doctor. These
nurses are on the hospital staff and
are paid directly by the patient.

Smoking—Smoking is not al-
lowed in the patient's rooms, ele-
vators or corridors, but is permit-
ted in the main lobby and in the
cafeteria. Patients and visitors are
asked to obey the smoking rules.
For the welfare of all and for the
safety of the hospital, we cannot
be lenient.

Television and Radio—If you
turn on your television or radio,
remember to keep it tuned so that
it will not annoy others. The hours
permitted are from 7 a.m. to 10
p.m. Television sets may be ac-
quired at the Hospital Shop.

Parking Area for Visitors—A
large paved parking area at the
corner of Jefferson Avenue and
Stone Street has been constructed
for visitors. No other area or drive-
way on the hospital property may
be used by the visitors. The hospi-
tal does not assume responsibility
for the use of the parking facility
or for the safety of vehicles parked
there.

Visitors' Entrance—Visitors are
requested to use the main entrance
to the hospital immediately adja-
cent to the parking area on Stone
Street. This entrance leads to the
office, the Hospital Shop, and
the elevators to the various floors.
Cameras—Please respect the
privacy of the patients in the hos-
pital and do not bring a camera.
No flash is to be used.

No Food to be Brought In—The
hospital furnishes adequate and
nourishing food for the patients.
Friends and relatives are not to
bring in food. This is to prevent
conflict with your doctor's treat-
ment. Unmanufactured food can be
dangerous for you.

Organization of Association in 1916 Marked Modest Beginning of Rahway Hospital

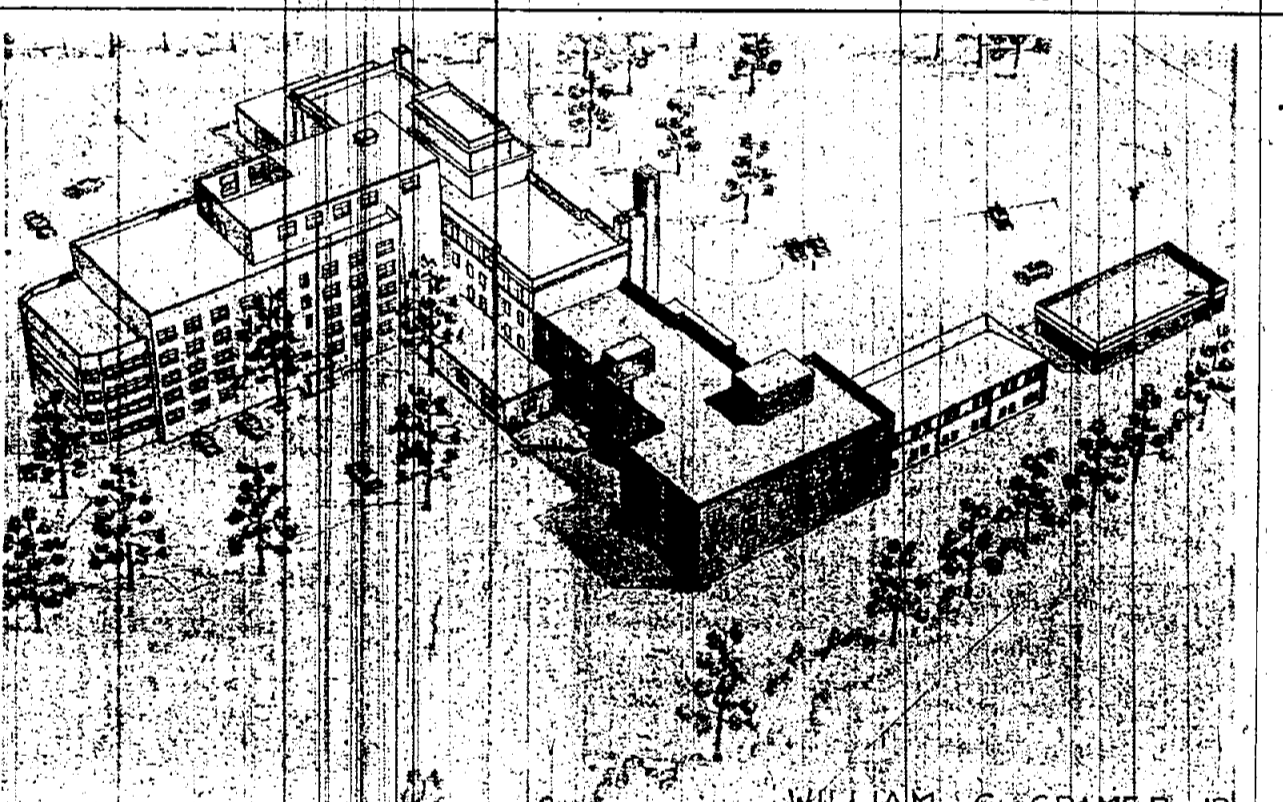

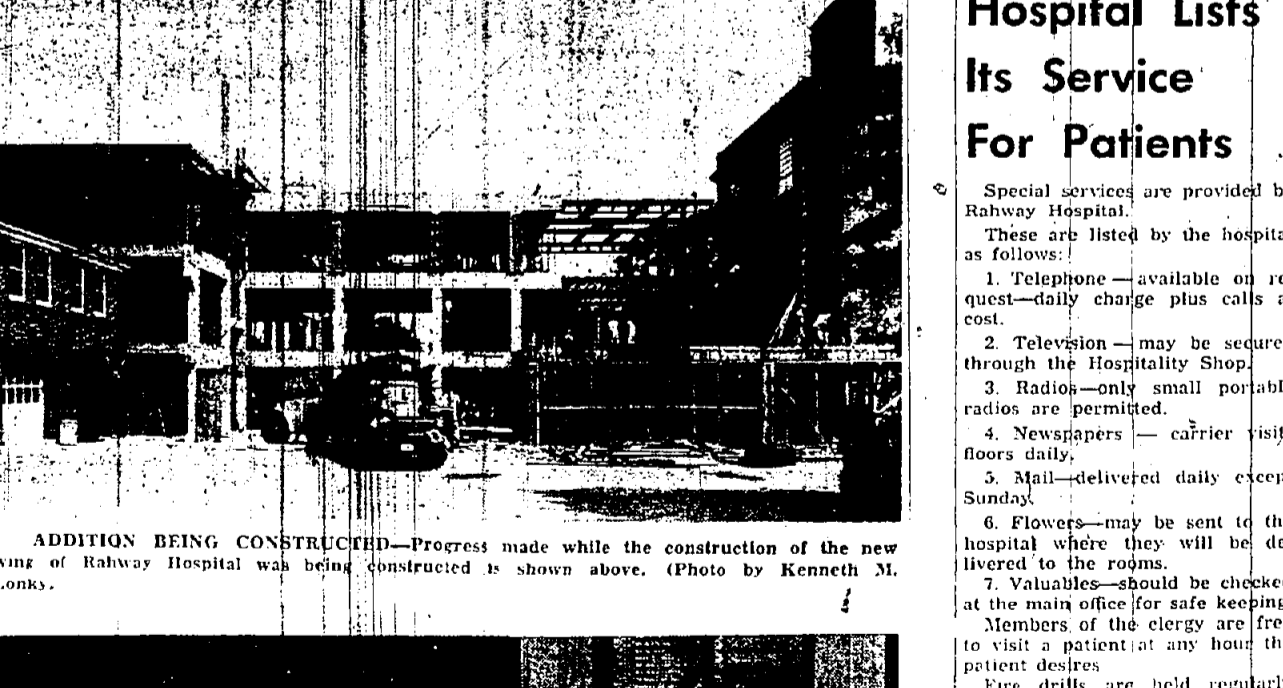

Mail**—delivered daily except Sundays. **6. Flowers**—may be sent to the hospital where they will be delivered to the rooms. **7. Valuables**—should be checked at the main office for safe keeping. **8. Fire drills**—are held regularly to insure the safety of all patients. **9. Disaster drills**—are held regularly for the training of hospital personnel.

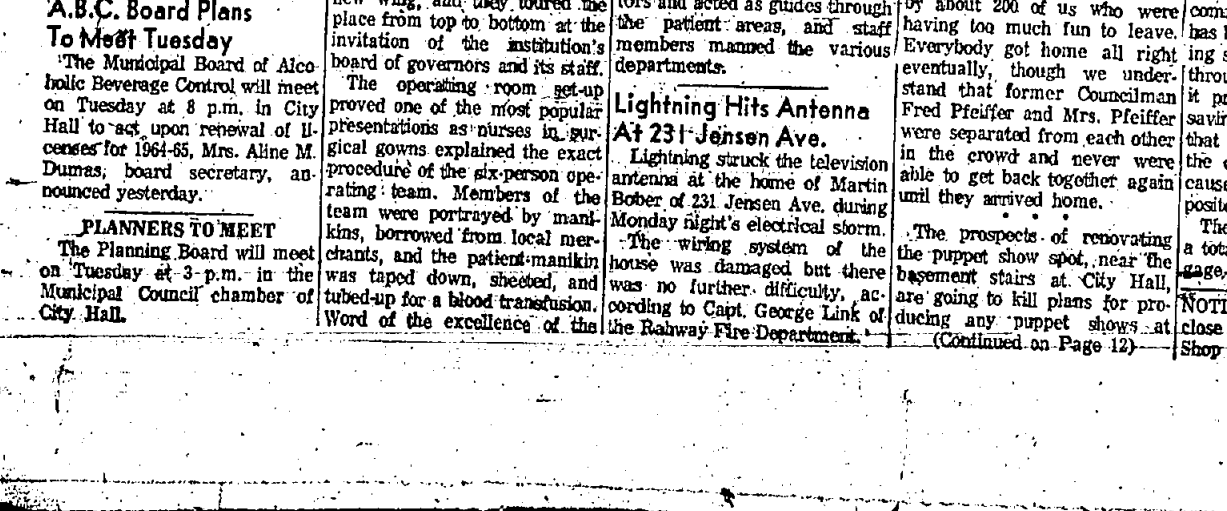
