Details of Bill Regulating Detergents Explained

UNION COUNTY STATE SENATE DELEGATE LEADER
Last week I reported on the decision to buy or what to buy, leaves permit the state to regulate the sale of detergents that belong to the consumer. Presidential Freeze Is Meaningless In Face of Wild US Spending Policies
And Abrogates Basic Contract Rights
The distance between Presidential edict and local affects has been widening in years recent. For that reason, the President's freeze on wages and prices is meaningless. Americans, led by a bipartisan array of steady politicians, have come to believe that a depression is in the inferior banking system, minimum wages, and union contracts in restraint of trade and production could have no day of reckoning.
How often has the sentiment been expressed: "With all of the federal government's money, we can't get the economy, we can never have a depression again." For those of you reading this editorial that believe that the government's present policy is a depression, and that "financial dooms day" isn't all that distant.
Dr. Milton Friedman, a Rahway native and one of the nation's economic advisers, commenting on the President's recent moves to curb inflation and the faltering value of the dollar abroad, said the symptoms are being treated, not the causes. Inflation is not merely the affects of a sick system, corrupted mainly by government spending and printing money. It is a symptom of a deeper malady, one of which are complete abrogations of basic economic rights. Why should the government, which has spent billions of dollars in the hands of foreigners, especially Central Europeans, who cash these extra dollars in an exchange bank for gold. The President stopped the payment of legitimate debts to Europeans, and that move did not undercut the dollar. The mechanical means of the President's officers of that company...

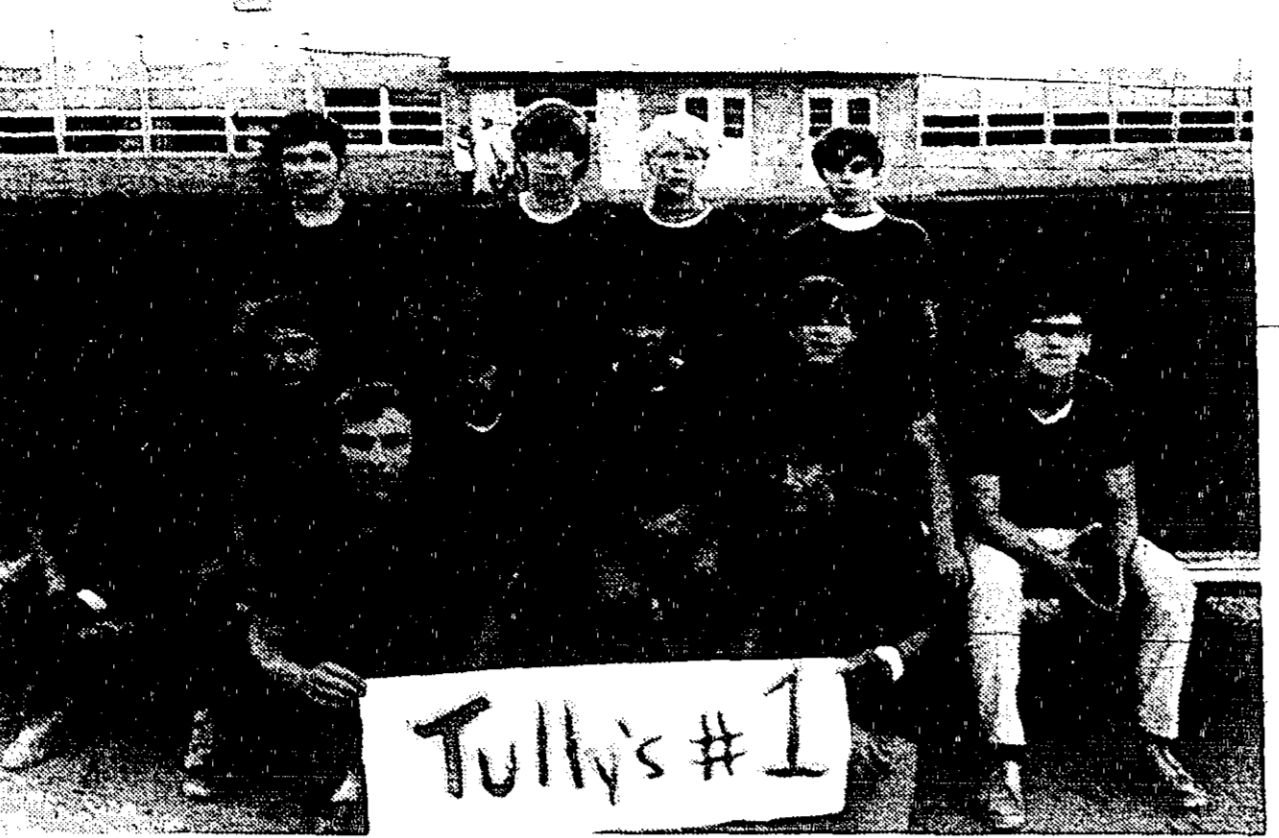

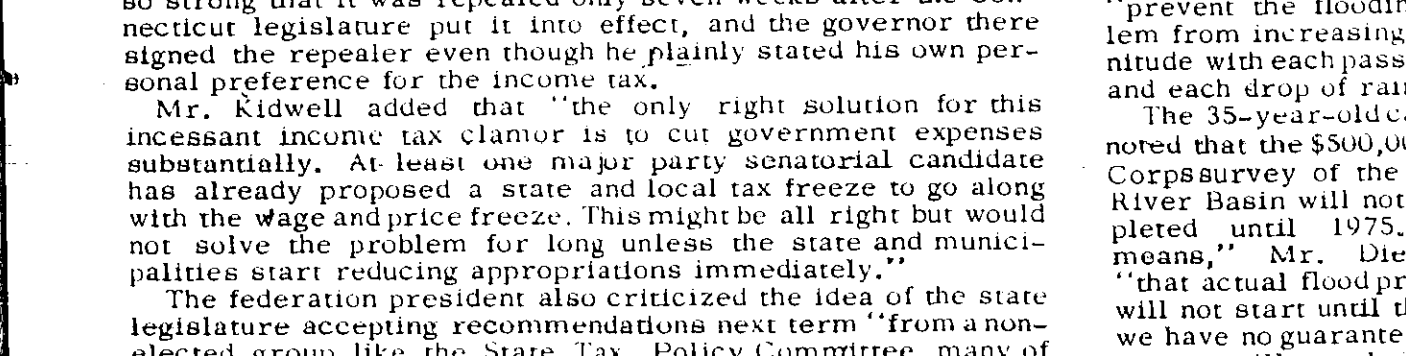
