## Plans to Be Completed In May for New Station In Rahway, Kiehn Says

Preliminary plans for a new Penn Central Railroad passenger station in Rahway have been completed by the State Department of Transportation and final plans and specifications are being prepared, Assemblyman Herbert H. Kiehn of Rahway announced yesterday.

Assemblyman Kiehn said he received a letter from Nelson Slater, assistant commissioner of public transportation, in answer to a query about plans for the Rahway station. A report that funds for the Rahway project were being diverted for construction of the Elizabeth station brought out the inquiry. The Elizabeth passenger station of the Penn Central burned last May 16. Mr. Slater stated in his letter that architectural and engineering work for the Rahway station is being done by the Penn Central staff. The final documents for the Rahway station are scheduled for completion on May 17, 1972, Mr. Slater wrote. He added that he expected both the Rahway and Elizabeth projects to be completed in 1972.

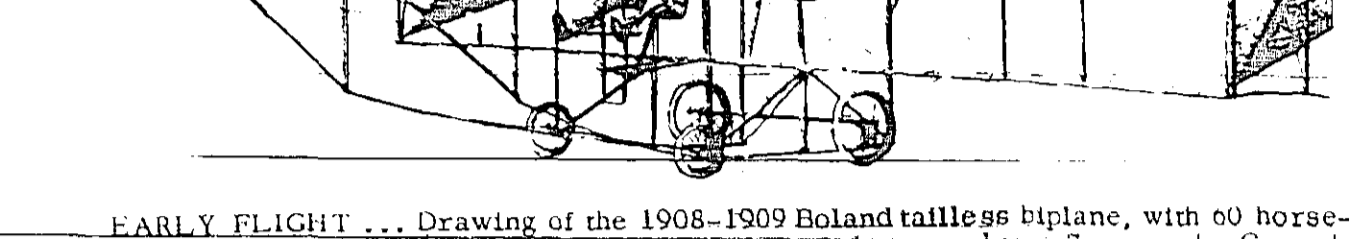
Mr. Gilgannon acted as a reader at masses at St. Mary's and was also a member of the church's choir where he often served as a soloist.
