Extension to Pay Road Assessments Denied by Council

Denied four homeowners who were assessed anywhere from \$450 to \$8,000 for work done in the controversial Navesink-Drambail Roads improvement project. The council, after a long session, refused to grant the extension to pay the assessments when council members were asked to place the matter to rest for the first time at a Monday night special meeting.

Founder of 3 Organizations In Clark to Be Feted Mar. 10

Miss Emma J. King, a founder of the Clark Volunteer Emergency Squad, the Clark Historical Society and its leading historian, will be honored by the three organizations at a dinner on Friday, March 10, at 7 o'clock in the Log Cabin, Raritan Road, Clark.

Miss King is the daughter of Benjamin King, one of Clark's first mayors and a director of the Union County Board of Freeholders in 1890 and 1899.

Born during the blizzard of 1888 in the Westfield Avenue home in which she still resides, Miss King attended Scudder School in Clark and was graduated from Rahway High School.

In 1917, Miss King was appointed as the first trustee of the Clark Historical Society. She also is the delegate to the Second District of the New Jersey State First Aid Council and recently received her 24th perfect attendance pin.

Miss King feels strongly that persons who do not participate as members of political parties lose the most important part of their heritage as American citizens. To support her belief she was an organizer and charter member of the Clark Republican Club in 1924. She has missed five meetings.

Major William J. Maguire assigned Miss King to the Clark Centennial Committee in 1964. She was a major contributor to the "History of Clark Township" published that year.

Miss King, a member of the Christian Missionary Alliance Church on Denman Avenue, recently received a 46-year attendance award from the congregation.

Although Miss King retired last year as a retirement officer of both the elementary and high school systems, her activities on behalf of the community continued. In June 1970, she was elected to the board of trustees of the Clark Volunteer Emergency Squad.

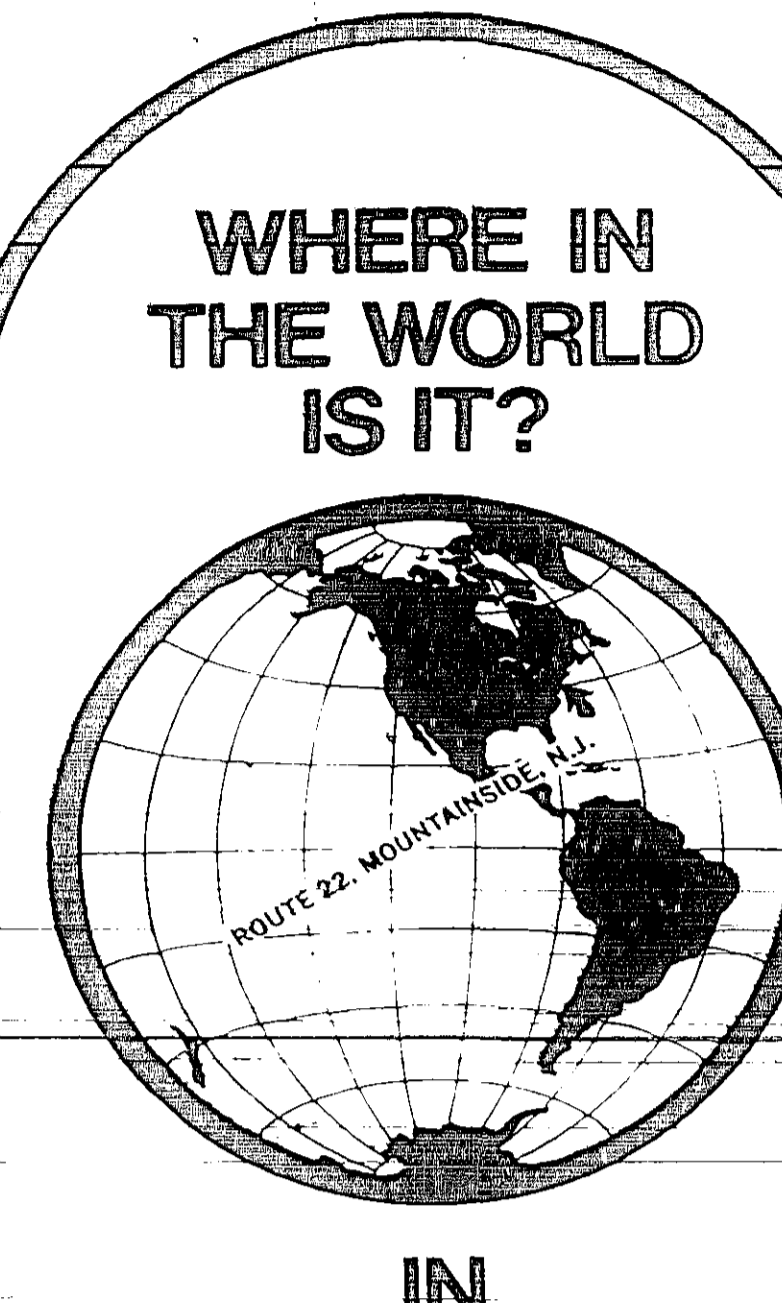

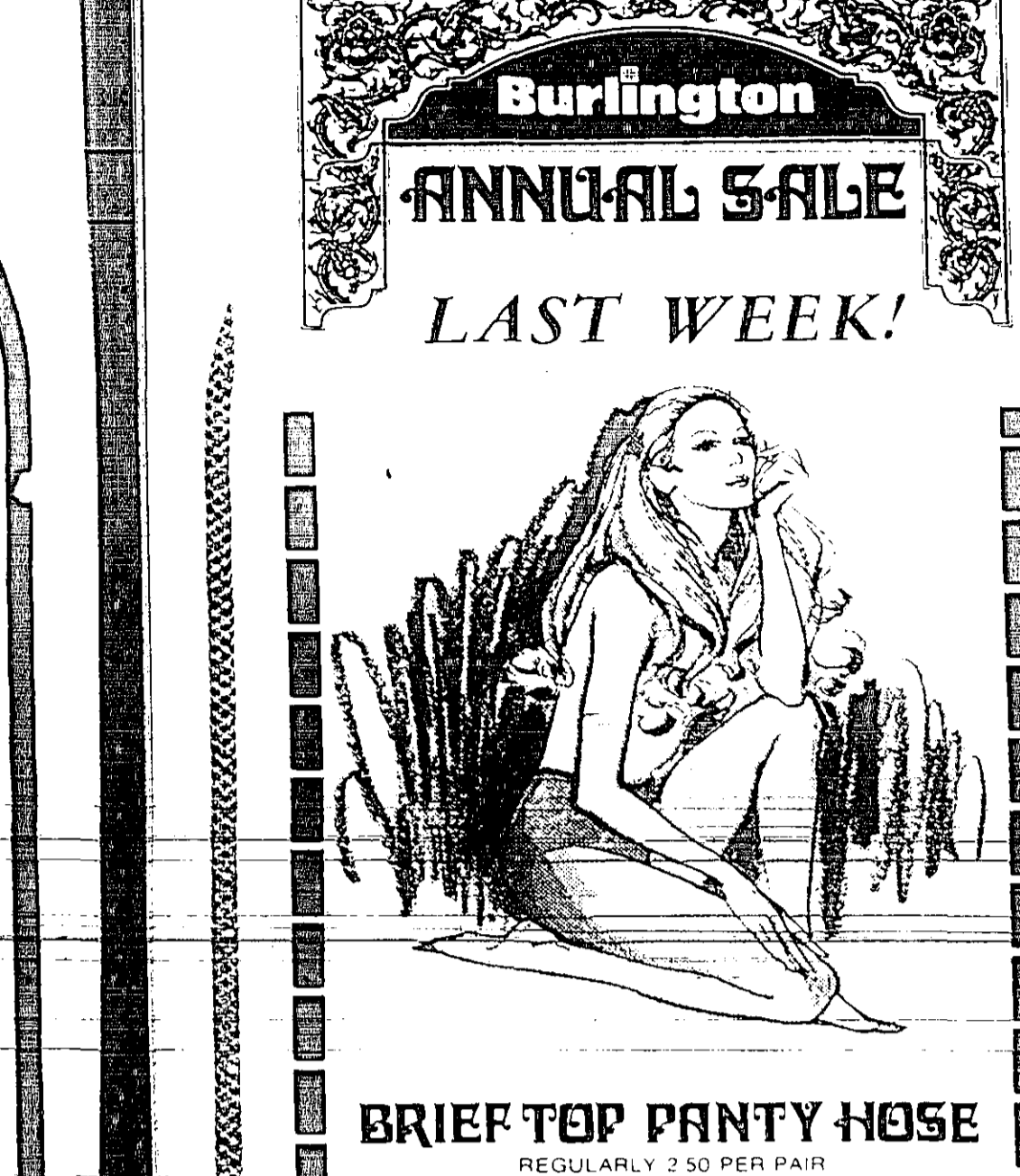
