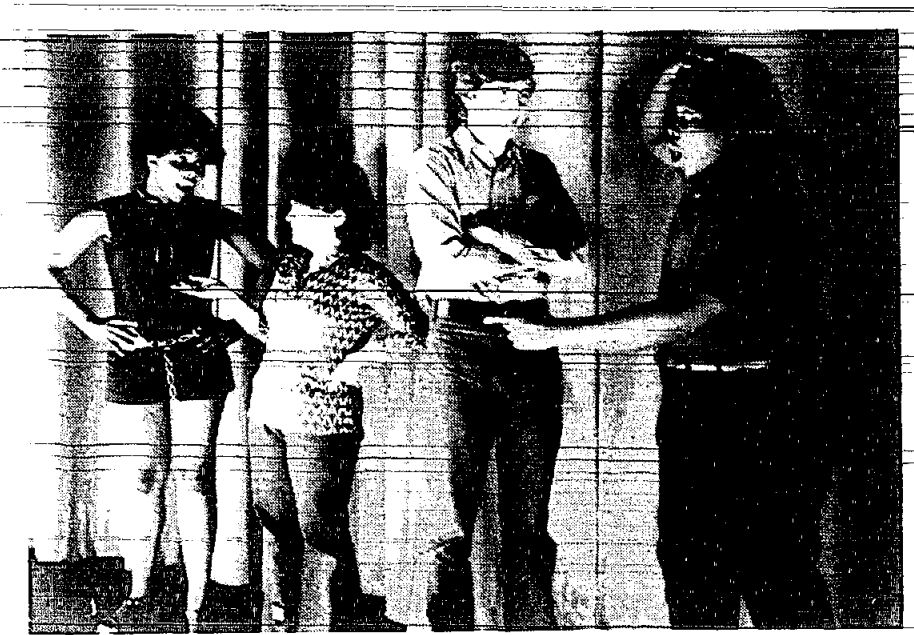

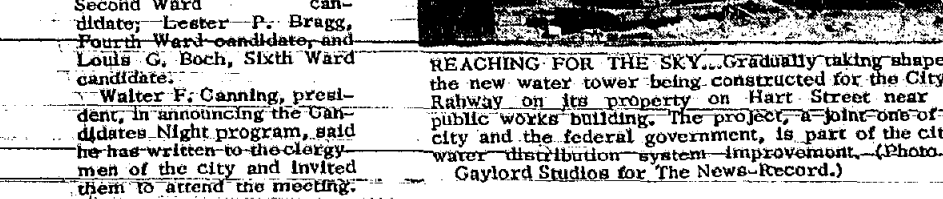

## Apartment of Case Draws Picketers

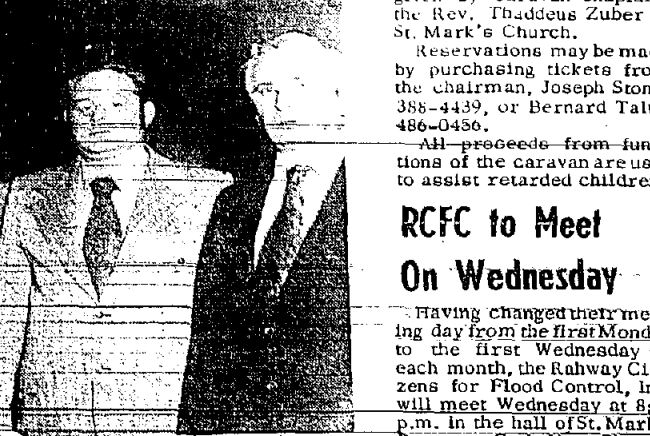
