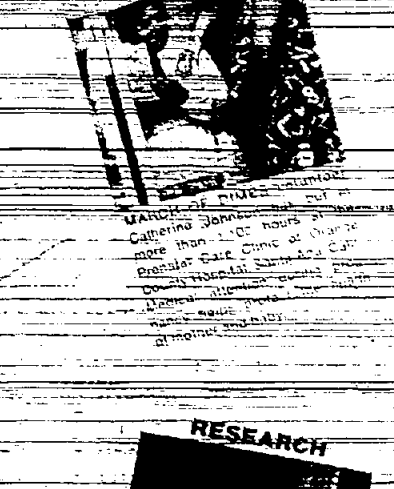

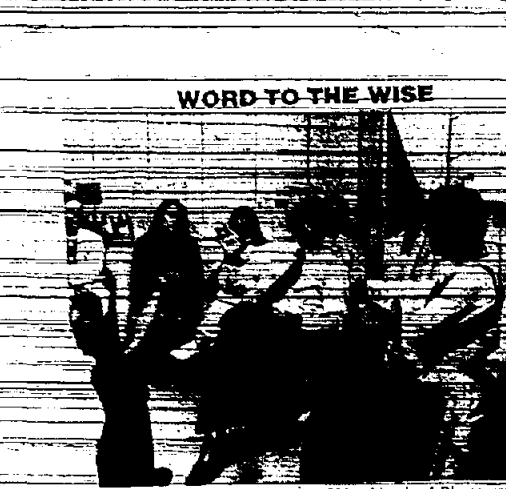
SKILLED STUDY: A young child is seen studying at a desk.



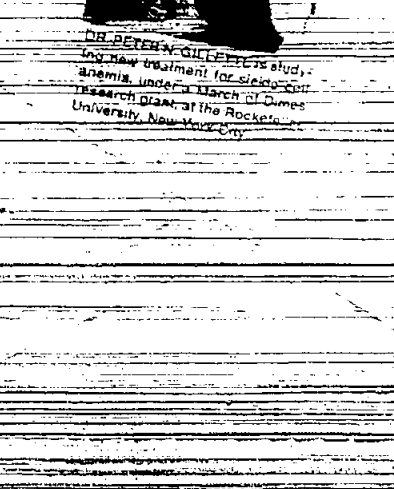

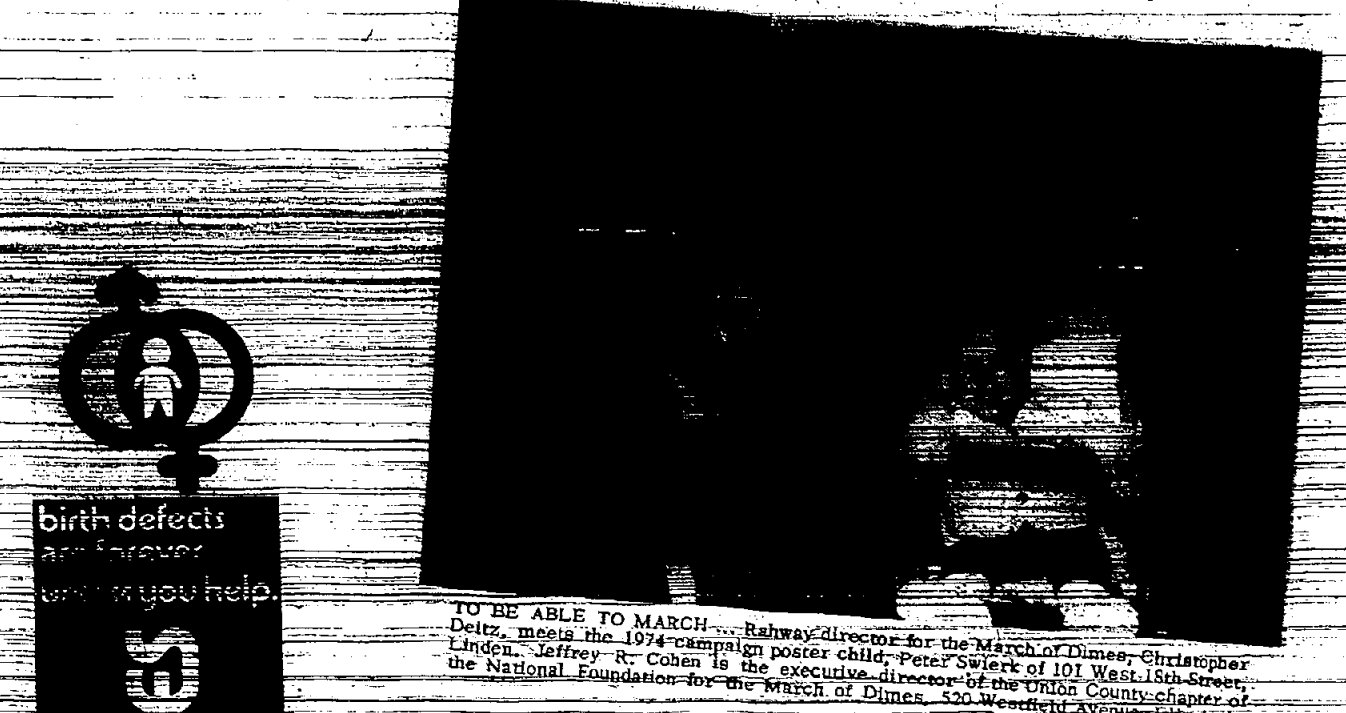

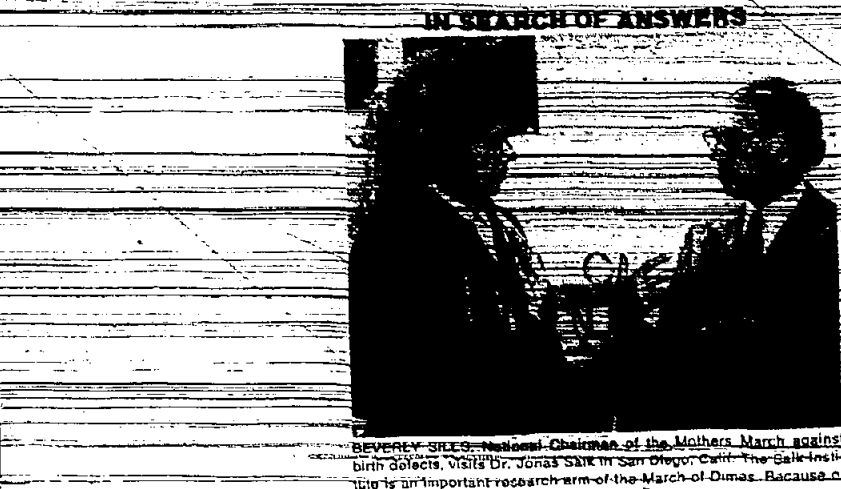

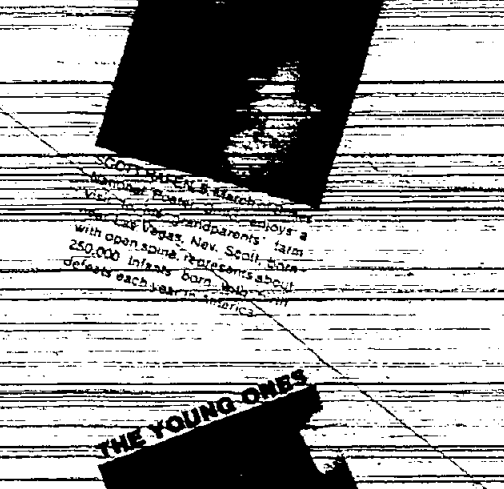
