A new plan says many women invest to provide a nest egg for their children. Probably a lot more than you think. It takes a large sum of money, but there's a way to give a child a nest egg that will help you save on taxes at the same time.

If an estate planner says you should put in \$10,000 to \$20,000, you may think that's a lot of money. But the child's tax rate is probably much smaller than yours, perhaps even zero. That will lower your taxes, especially if you have other children. You can also give away for the child in your own savings account, collecting interest on it. If you thought velour garments were costly last year, look at them this year and get your sewing machine out. This way you can cut the cost of velour clothing by about one-third. The reason is that velour is made of two layers of fabric. One layer is a soft, fuzzy material called pile, and the other is a smoother fabric. You can buy the pile fabric separately and sew it onto the smoother fabric. This way you can save a lot of money.
