City Hall ruling says petitions sufficient; referendum should be allowed to be conducted

The Superior Court, in a ruling issued this week, upheld the petition under which the city of Rahway is to be reorganized on an additional \$1,000,000 referendum by the City Hall. Public opinion is expected to be a vote that against City Clerk Robert W. Schell and the Rahway City Council over a year ago, members of the group, including Mayor James J. Williams, and the group should not have been allowed to go on to the referendum because they did not comply with the provisions of the act. According to the city's directors, a referendum in any form whose results are not binding on the City Council, is illegal.

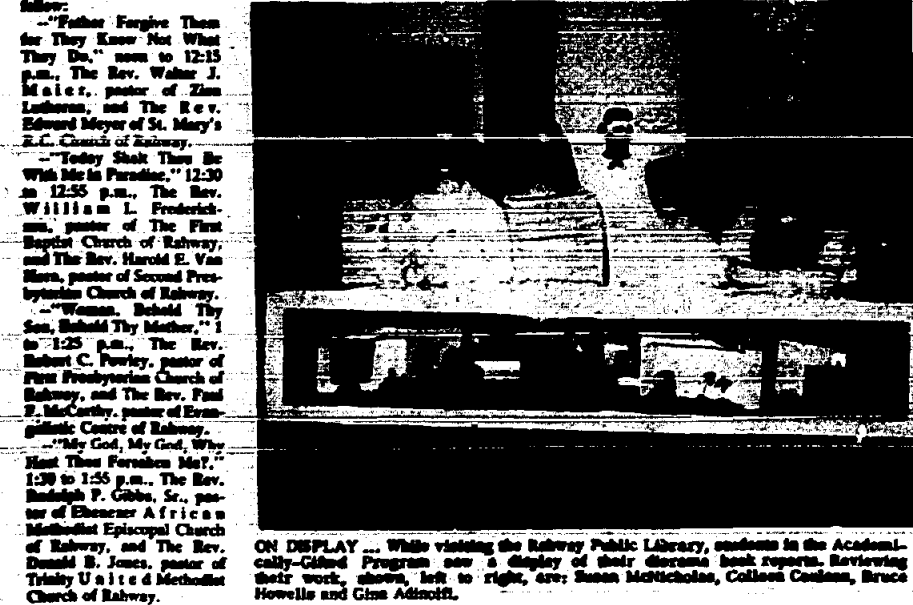
