County cultural 'palace' can live in your backyard

EDITOR'S NOTE: The following story was submitted to The Rahway News-Record and The Clark Patriot by Daniel M. Costigan, the publicity coordinator of Rahway Landmarks, Inc., the group seeking to purchase the Rahway Theatre so it can be turned into a Union County Cultural Center.

Some say it is Rahway's great misfortune to be identified mainly with a correctional institution that is actually located in an adjoining municipality. If that is, in fact, its image, first-time visitors are likely to be pleasantly surprised by the many picture-postcard faces this city displays: The beautiful old homes on quiet, tree-lined streets, the tastefully-modern City Hall, the many churches and historic landmarks, the friendly people, the restful parks and festive annual events.

Even if the name "Rahway Prison" were to change efforts in that direction have so far failed, the stigma would disappear.

overnight. So it is something Rahway has learned to live with while taking the positive approach of improving its image in other ways.

A short time ago, when the fate of another local institution—one that is within city limits—became cause for concern, some local and nearby residents sensed an opportunity to further enhance the positive side of Rahway's self-image.

That institution is the Rahway Theatre (often called the "Old Rahway"), which was last used as a showplace for X-rated films.

Built in 1928 as a combined vaudeville/movie facility, the Irving St. landmark began life as something that had by then become commonplace in cities throughout the country: Whether the prefix was "film," "movie," "picture" or "entertainment," the suffix was invariably "palace"—and for good reason.

These were the closest to a monarch's residence one was likely to find in America. Interior walls and ceiling abounded with delicately-sculptured friezes. Thick carpeting absorbed the more mischievous echoes. Expensive brocade curtains were framed within a triumphal proscenium arch and a huge crystal chandelier hung from the center of a towering arched ceiling.

Patrons were served by a platoon of uniformed ushers, and, while anticipating the "features" awaiting them behind closed curtains, were entertained by an adept musician at the console of a magnificent built-in pipe organ.

The managers of these lofty enterprises were regarded with special reverence within the local business community.

Beginning in the 1950's with television increasingly dominating the entertainment scene, the glamour of

the picture palace rapidly diminished and these marvelous structures, some having already begun to decay with age, increasingly became victims of the wrecker's ball. Today, only a few remain relatively intact. The Rahway, though tarnished physically and in reputation, is one of them.

As for its perceived fate and the positive vision it has inspired, we have to venture back for a moment to the 1960's when a small group of volunteers received permission to restore the theatre's neglected pipe organ. With that accomplished and the instrument now playable at intermissions and in concert by volunteer musicians, the Old Rahway had regained a dimension that had been lacking for some years.

Robert Balfour, the Plainfield radio broadcast engineer who led this initial restoration effort, has both a sentimental affinity for

movie palaces and a pragmatic perception of the potential they still have as entertainment centers.

When it became evident in the late 1970's that the Old Rahway was a probable candidate for "twinning" (conversion to multiple cinemas), demolition or some other cruel fate, Mr. Balfour and nine others who shared his sentimental and prophetic views formed Rahway Landmarks.

The sole purpose of this non-profit entity was to preserve the Old Rahway as a local landmark by acquiring and restoring it for operation as a non-profit arts center.

Gradually local citizens of various persuasions and interests joined with the original nucleus group to build an organization that today consists of nine directors, four of whom officiate; three trustees from the city's professional community and 200 dues-paying members.

What exactly does Rahway Landmarks have in mind in the way of an arts center?

According to the tentative operating plan the theatre will function primarily as a rental facility for professional and semi-professional performers and performing groups including symphony orchestras, dance and light opera companies, lecturers, student recitals, touring road companies, business meetings and fund-raising events.

In addition it could be the home base for a symphony orchestra, repertory company and other performing groups.

Part of the plan is also eventually to integrate the store front and main lobby areas into an exhibition facility for local painters, sculptors and other artists and craftspeople. Rahway Landmarks anticipates running its own film series and occasionally presenting live events.

The antique Wurlitzer organ will continue to make its presence known from time to time as a reminder of what started it all.

The big obstacle to all of this is money!

So far, Rahway Landmarks, with all of its impressive backing, has been able to raise only about a third of the \$175,000 purchase cost, and, under present agreements, has only until Sunday, March 4, of this year to raise the rest.

(Its officers and board members remain confident of achieving this formidable goal.) Beyond that, an estimated additional \$200,000 will be needed to re-open the theatre for limited operation.

If the group does succeed in gaining title to the facility, fund-raising will remain a continuing task for the next two to three years. It is hoped that, by then, the operation will have become self-sustaining.

The hoped-for benefit for the city of Rahway is it will become known more as a cultural center and less as the presumed home of the infamous Rahway Prison.

There is also the belief of some local business people that, as a "people magnet," the arts center would revitalize the downtown business area. (It has worked in other cities.)

A lot depends on local citizens' perceptions of their city's image and whether it

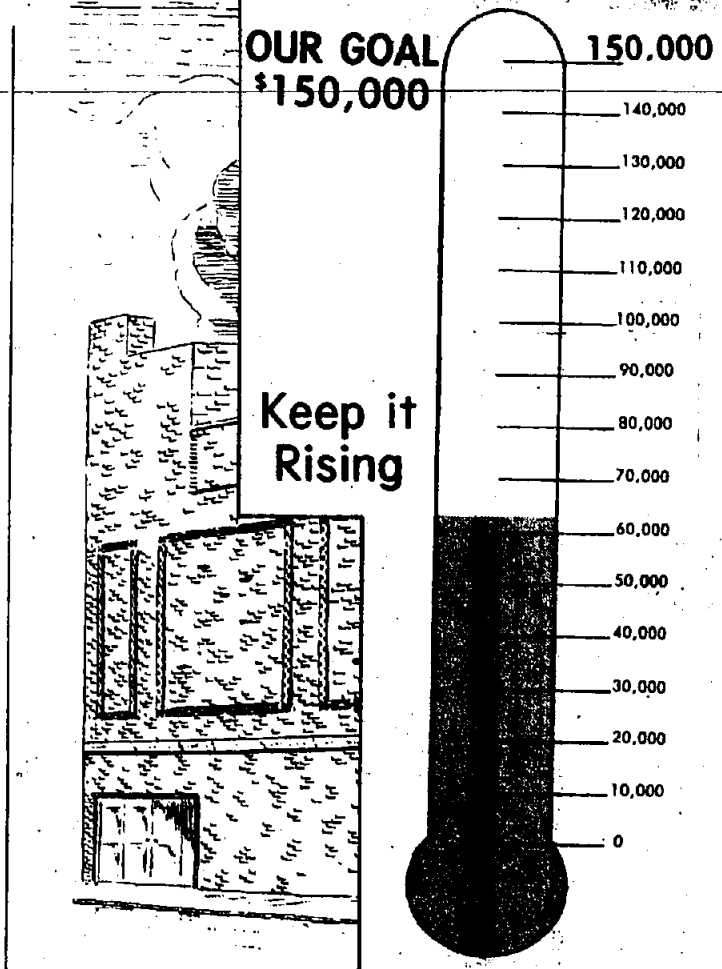

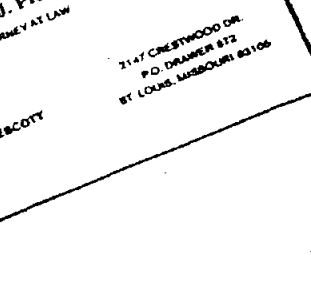

Rinaldo bill guards AT&T pensions

Justice department to open
the pension rights of telepho-
ne workers in the aftermath
of the breakup of the Ameri-
can Telephone and Tele-
graph Co. (AT&T) was in-
troduced in the House by
Republican Rep. Matthew
J. Rinaldo, whose district
includes Clark.

Rep. Rinaldo said the bill
would guarantee workers
transferred from one com-
pany to another as the re-
sult of the AT&T re-or-
ganization would be per-
mitted to carry their pen-
sions with them.

"In the absence of leg-
islative action thousands of
employees would be denied
the right to carry their pen-
sions with them," Rinaldo
said. "The bill would cor-
rect this and ensure fair
pay for all the workers af-
fected by the re-organiza-
tion. Under no circumstan-
ces should the men and
women who made our tele-
phone system the best in the
world be made the victims
of a corporate re-organiza-
tion."

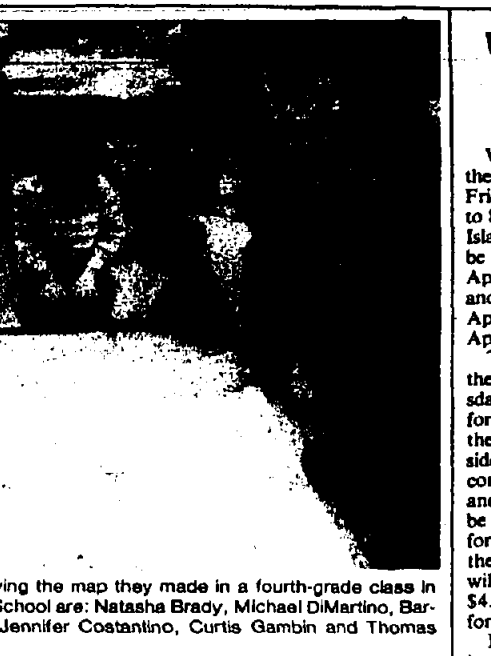

Mrs. Ogden backs bridge, road plan

She added road-and-bridge-repair projects have been accumulating for a quarter century.

"Delay will only increase the cost and deny us the option to repair rather than replace many of the state's aging roads and bridges," Mrs. Ogden noted.

Job-Related Study May Be Deductible

Expenses for education relevant to your current employment may be deductible, the Internal Revenue Service says.

To qualify, the expenses must meet at least one of two specific guidelines. Taking the course of study must be mandatory for continuing in your current employment, or improving skills which are required in your present employment—for instance, a television repairman taking a course to keep up with the latest changes.

However, the cost of certain educational expenses are not deductible. Expenses for education that prepare you for a new trade or business—such as a journalist studying law—may not be deducted, even if the education is required or beneficial in your present employment. Similarly, the expense for study to help you meet the minimum educational requirements for your current position is not an allowable deduction; for example, a full-time engineering student who has a part-time job in a minor engineering capacity. Educational expenses include amounts spent on tuition, books,

Jail name change proposed again

A bill which would change the names of all state maximum-security prisons, including Rahway State Prison, so they would not reflect the communities in which they are located, has been introduced in the New Jersey Assembly by Assemblyman Thomas J. Devlin, who represents Rahway.

According to Councilman Shield the measure, A-967, was introduced early in this legislative session so it could be acted on soon and signed into law by Gov. Thomas H. Kean, who "pocket vetoed" a similar bill in the last session because he had been given too many bills to act on at the very end of the session.

The bill would delegate Rahway State Prison, which is actually located in Avenel, as the "New Jersey State Prison North."

Other reasons released by the governor's office for the veto of the bill in the last session were the cost factors involved in changing the patches on the uniforms of the state prison guards and changing the prison signs and stationery.

According to Councilman Shield the cost of the above items would be a very small part of the state's budget and the argument by prison officials that they didn't have the time to prepare for the name changes was not true because they had known about the proposal for two years and the previously-proposed bill had given them an extra year to prepare for the changeover.

He added he intends to sponsor a resolution before the Rahway City Council to urge the governor to sign the new bill because it is of benefit to the city and it is non-political and non-controversial.

Public Service completes sale of stock

The Public Service Electric and Gas Co. completed negotiations for the sale of 4,000,000 shares of common stock to Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner and Smith Inc. and Kidder, Peabody and Co. at a price of \$21.98 per share.

The underwriters began offering the shares to the public on Jan. 24 at a price of \$22.50 per share. The proceeds from the sale of the shares will be added to the general fund of the company and will be used for the purpose of financing a portion of the cost of its current construction program, reports a spokesman.

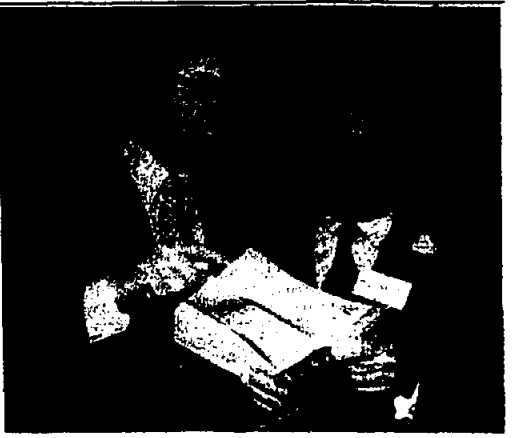
Sears gives county college \$4,100

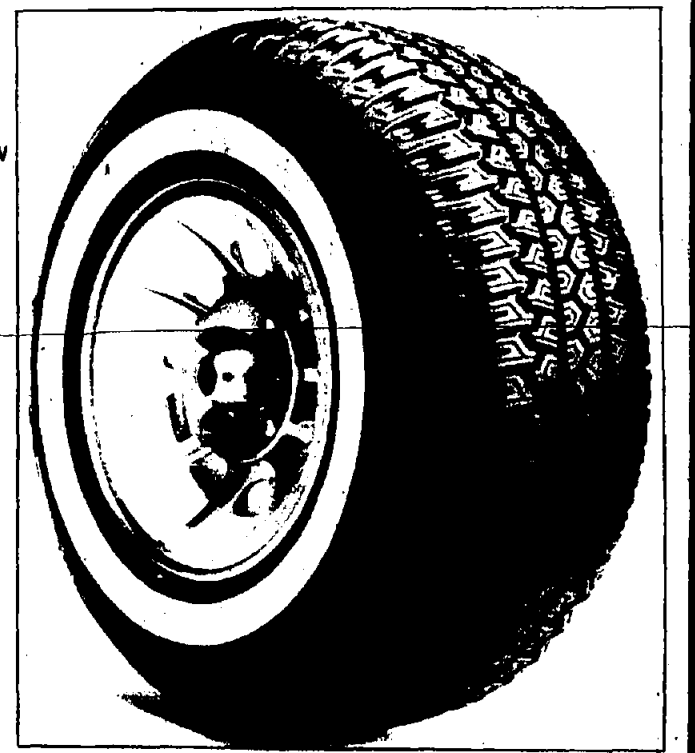
