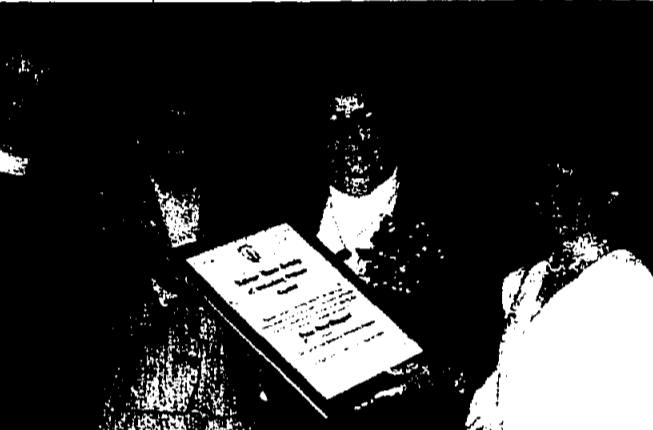

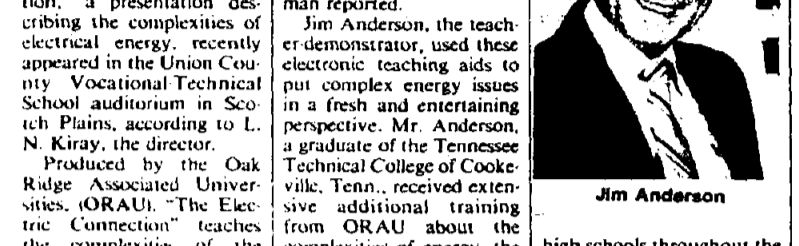
Clevelanders make 'pals' of seniors
