How much are we suing for?

Perhaps one of the most frequent questions that our clients ask is "How much are we sump for?" You can im : agine how disappointed they are when they are told that n New Jersey no amount of money is specifically requested in the lawsuit and no sum of money can be pecifically asked for from a jury. New Jersey is one of the few states that forbids plain iffs' counsel in personal injury cases from requesting a sum of money in the court papers and from the jury itself Hus has not always been the law. The New Jersey preme Court, in the 1958 case of Botta v. Brunner, d that it was improper for plaintiffs' counsel to suggest. the jury in closing argument a sum of money which hould be awarded to the victim. How then would you as a juror know how much ioney to award to an injured victim if the victim's atney is not permitted to suppest a sum of money that he or she was seeking for a client? In most other states, the lawyer would tell the jury, that in his opinion, a fair compensation for his client's injuries is (for example) \$100,000. The jury then, in those states, is free to accept-

the number, reject the number or return any other

amount of money that they feel would adequately com-

pensate the victim. You may remember the foreman of

the jury in Paul Newman's movie The Verdict asked, "Can we return more money than the plaintiffs have requested?" That cannot happen in New Jersey since the plaintiffs' lawyer may not suppost any amount of money. The jury is given certain guidelines by the judge at the end of the case. They are called jury charges. In these charges the judge tries to explain to the jury how to arrive. a verdict and reads them the following language: The measure of damages is what a reasonable person ould consider to be adequate and just under all the cirunistances to compensate the plaintiff, no more and no less. The law does not provide you with any table, schedule or formula by which a person's pain and suffer. mg may be measured in terms of money. The amount is left to your sound discretion. It is not an arbitrary power. it to you, but rather the mechanism by which you are to tempt to make the plaintiff whole, so far as money can o so, based upon reason and sound judgement, without any passion, prejudice, bias or sympathy. You each know from your common experience the nature of pain and suffering, and you also know the nature and function of money. The task of equating the two so as to arrive at a just and fair award of damages is one which requires a what to do with 200 gas.

If you ever served on a jury, you know how difficult ie task was to try to determine how much to award a vic tim without having any idea of what would be fair and reasonable compensation and without knowing how much was being sought. A recent change in the law now permits the victim's awyer to make a "time unit argument" to help the jury in what the long-range plans turning a fair verdict. For example, the lawyer may sug gest that the victim has 150,000 hours to live based on court approved life expectancy tables. He therefore may suggest to the jury that they may attach a monetary unit to each of those hours. 
