

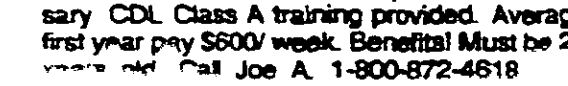

Innovations planned for library

The Rahway Public Library board of trustees have discussed several improvements for the new facility, according to interim Library Director Ed Beckerman.

The new library is set to be located behind City Hall, after the old facility on Central Avenue was heavily flooded by Tropical Storm Floyd and shut down.

According to Beckerman, the most important aspect of this new library will be about 27 stations wired to the Internet, with desktop computers at those stations. Patrons will be able to bring in their laptop computers and hook them up to the Internet as well, Beckerman said.

"The potential is for a great many additional computers, as they are needed," Beckerman said. "We're looking forward to the future. As time passes, you will see more and more of these stations develop. It's designed to be a flexible arrangement."

The architects from the Biber Partnership in Summit reviewed what they were doing with the design. There will be three levels to the building: two building levels and ground level for parking. The first level, about 32,000 square feet, will be the library.

There will be another level on top of the library, the office level which SDI will rent out. Beckerman did not know the exact square footage, but it will be a little smaller than the library.

"There is an intent to develop a plaza and some civic space in front of the library," Beckerman said. "There'll be an entranceway to the building. The site will face inward, so the entrance will face the parking area."

There will be a suitable lobby space up on the second level. Off to the right, there is going to be a meeting room the public can use. That will be approximately 1,600 square feet and will seat about 150 people.

"As you go directly into the building, straight ahead there is a central charging desk where you borrow and discharge books," Beckerman said. "As you go forward, a bulk of the library is really on the main level there. And that will include a child's room on the first level. A reference area will be in the back."

Another feature the first floor will have is a small cafe. This is not as uncommon as it might think. The Portland, Oregon library has a Starbucks cafe inside and an adjacent area for parking. The main

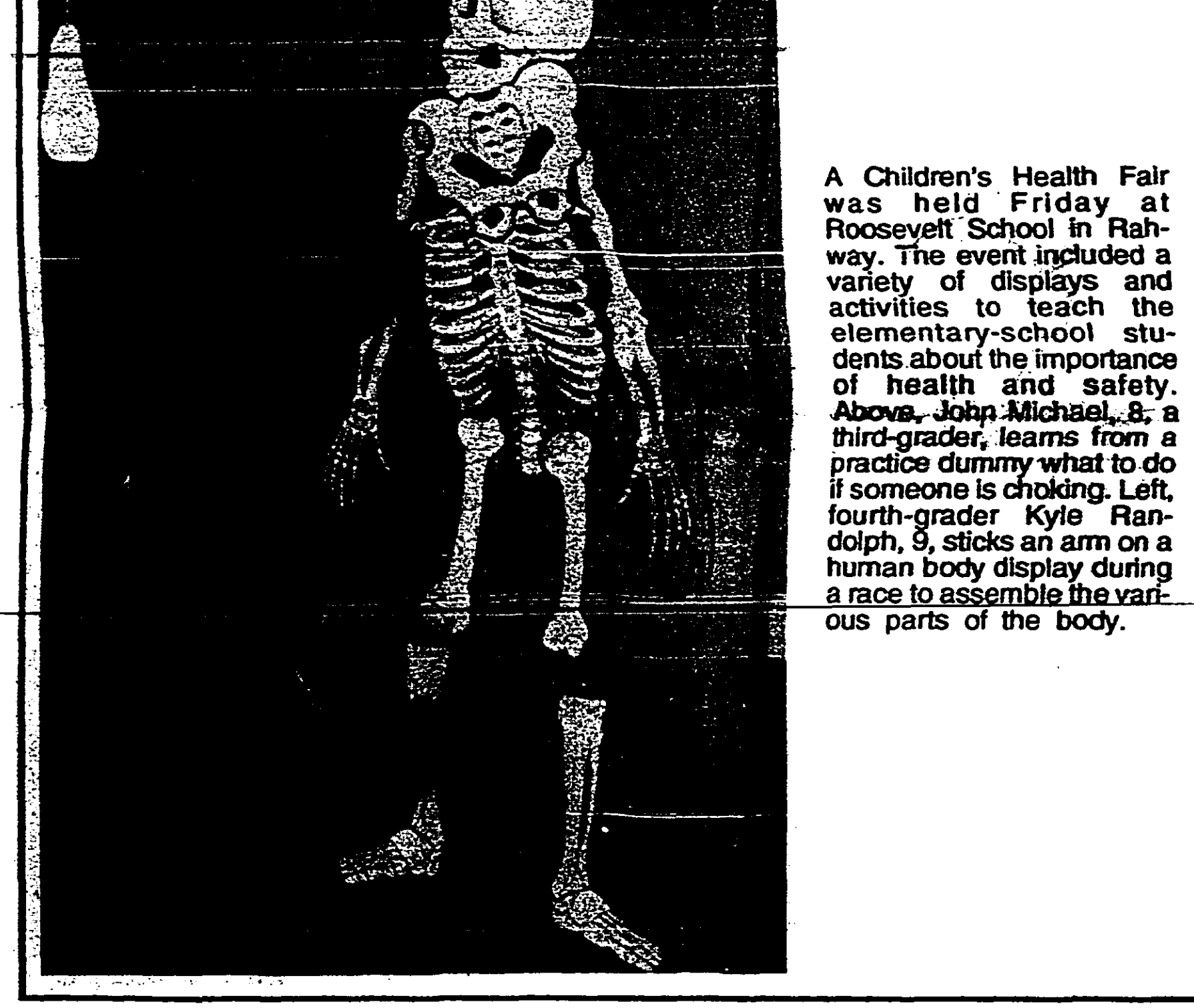

But people have wondered since the center opened if the building is paying for itself, or is an unnecessary burden on the city and taxpayers. These concerns have been brought up at Rahway City Council meetings by members of the public.

"There's a figure that said the center cost \$250,000 a year to run. That's the recreation budget. There's a little confusion over that, how much it costs to operate this building."

"Rahway Recreation had a building and had employees. They all just moved here. Now obviously because of the availability of more things, we've added more."

As far as the building paying for itself, Diege said people would have to look at what the building is costing in

Memorial to firefighters restored

Efforts are under way to restore a monument dedicated to the deceased members of the Rahway Fire Department.

The Fire Department, the Rahway Exempt Firemen's Association and a downtown Rahway business are joining forces to accomplish this goal.

The monument, created in 1913, was originally scheduled to be placed in the firemen's plot of the Rahway Cemetery. The statue never made it to the cemetery, and for the most part resided in the spot behind the train station where the Martin Luther King Jr. memorial now is located. The monument was then moved to its current location on Main Street beside of the Fire Department.

The original monument portrays the figure of a turn-of-the-century fireman holding a fire hose and looking vigilantly over the community. The life-size statue of the fireman sits on a six-foot pedestal of Quincy granite. The statue itself was sculpted in Italy out of stone that was a unique blend of Carrera marble and sandstone.

The elements have taken their toll on the statue's heroic figure over the years. The helmet lost most of its crisp line and the hands and facial features had eroded. The statue of the rescuer needed to be rescued.

Under the guidance of the local Exempt Firemen's Association chapter, the statue was removed from its pedestal last summer. The statue was then moved to the Cherry Street studio of Royal Treasures Antiques,

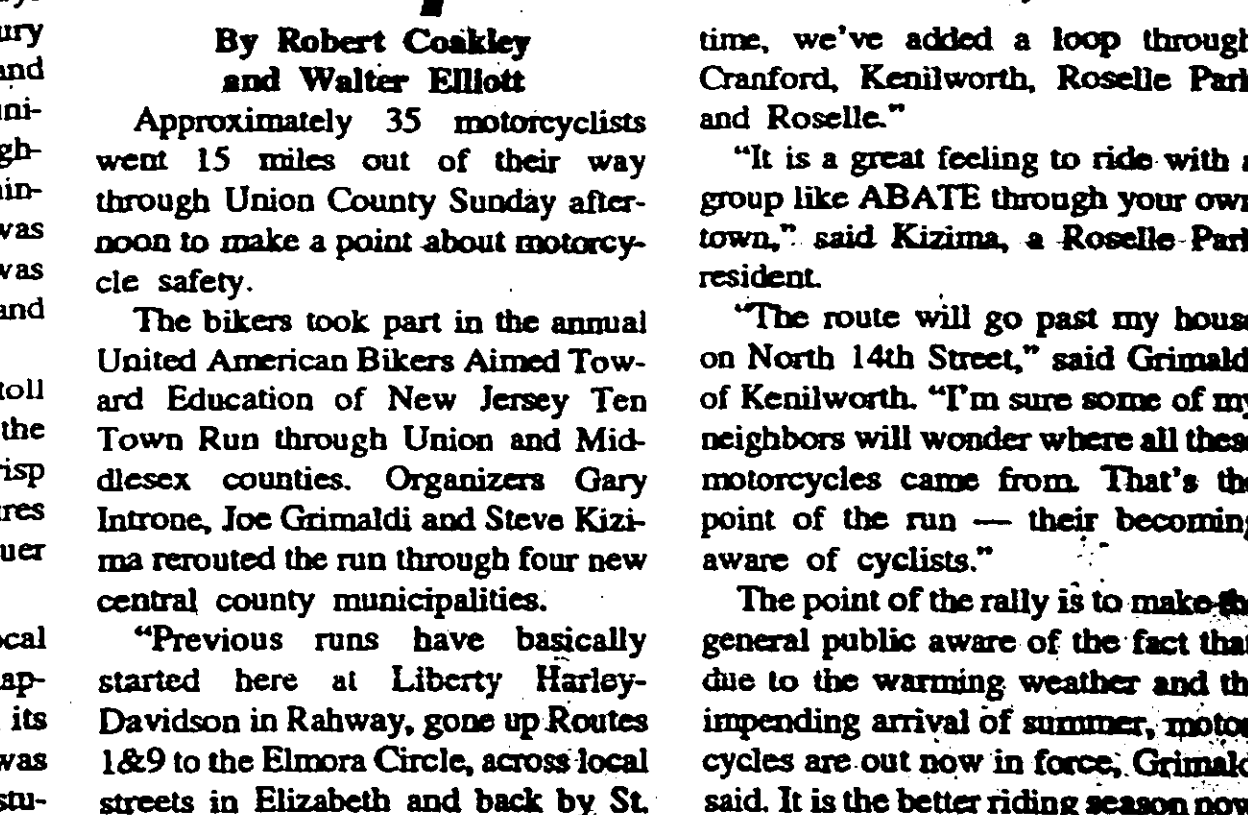
