CENSUS BUREAU'S DEATH STATISTICS

Summary of Chief Causes of Deaths for Year 1917 in United States

Washington, D. C., July 1. The Census Bureau today announced the death statistics for the year 1917, showing a total of 1,141,000 deaths, or 23.1 per 1,000 population. The rate for 1916 was 22.1 per 1,000, and for 1915, 21.1 per 1,000. The rate for 1917 was 23.1 per 1,000, or 1.0 per 1,000 more than for 1916, and .9 per 1,000 more than for 1915. The rate for 1917 was 23.1 per 1,000, or 1.0 per 1,000 more than for 1916, and .9 per 1,000 more than for 1915.
