The Council has studied certain states, in which, during the first three months of 1934, there were \$8,410 drivers involved in non-fatal injury accidents, compared with 35,658 drivers in such accidents during the first three months of 1933. Is these accidents there were 691 "had been drinking" drivers in 1934, compared with 491 in 1933. But, with nearly 3,000 more drivers involved there were only 200 more in the "had been drinking" category. Intoxication was reported for 1,28 percent of-all drivers in 1933, as compared with 1,80 percent this year. Thus, the number who "had been drinking" increased 40 percent, but because the total number of drivers also increased, the advance in percentages amounted to only 20 percent.
