Rules and Regulations

This show is open to the members of the Rake and Hoe Garden Club only.

An exhibitor may have only one entry in a class or subdivision. Entries may be made from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on April 10, 1968 and must be removed promptly after the close of the program of the day.

Only required personnel may be present during judging which will begin at 10:30 p.m.

All decisions of the judges will be final.

The standard system of awarding will be used. Ribbons will be awarded 1st blue, 2nd red, 3rd yellow, Honorable Mention, white.

No artificial flowers or foliage may be used in the show.

Horticulture Division

All entries must be grown by the exhibitor.

Houseplants must have been in exhibitors possession for three months prior to the date of the show.

Exhibits must be labeled. Give varital name if possible.

No foliage is shown except that attached to the stem of the specimen. The Plant Society scale of points (see handbook) indicates if foliage is required.

All exhibits must be passed by the Classifications Committee and receive an exhibitors card before being placed by the committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any class or to subdivide classes by variety or color. Containers for horticulture specimens will be provided by the committee.

Artistic Design Division

Advance entries are requested before April 1, 1968. Phone consultant for information.

A substitute must be provided if unable to fill class.

On arrival April 10, 1968, all entries must be passed by the consultant and receive an exhibitors card. Exhibitor will then place her own exhibit.

There are no restrictions on the use of accessories or bases. Conservation material (nature plants) may be used when grown by the exhibitor or acquired in any lawful manner. These should be labeled with name and how acquired.
