### LIVE EXHIBIT



Aiready there are four tanks of bivalves, and univalves happily disporting themselves while awaiting the big event, The bivalves are busily enjoying the pleasure of gastronomic delights from the fresh Gulf water that is regularly added while the univalves partake of donacs with the exception of the horse conche which seem to prefer devouring the tulips and leaving their empty shells in the sand!

Our mild little "(lighting conche" (Strombus alatus) are grazers and enjoy munching grasses that grow on other shells along with green aligae.


