During the Zoning hearing, Bigdow spoke first, and said he wasn't surprised at the crowd since "bulkheads and trailer rezoning," always draw them. The petition was made on the grounds that a trailer park "primarily would fill a need on Sanibellsland," and spoke of the "over-
