MOSQUITO MONEY CUT

The Board of Commissioners of the Lee County Mosquito Control District today authorized a reduction in the District's proposed budget for the fiscal year, October 1, 1967, through September 30, 1968.

After consideration of comments by some sixty citizens indicating a feeling that all government agencies should re-trench in an effort to hold the line on public spending -- the Board voted to reduce the proposed budget by \$52,000.00. Items reduced were Salaries \$13,800, Chevrolet \$32,000, Gas & Repairs \$6,000, and Contingencies \$200.

Chairman Leonhardt pointed out that this would necessarily result in some reduction of services -- but emphasized that the action resulted from the Board's wish to offer such mosquito control services as the people request and desire.

DON'T FORGET INSURANCE FOR EXPO 67

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. -- State Treasurer - Insurance Commissioner Edward Williams announced Florida citizens today they must carry proof of financial responsibility they visit Canada's Expo-67.

This proof, a pale yellow card called the Nonresident Interprovincial Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance Card, is available only through the policyholder's insurance company.

Commissioner Williams said the card certifies that the policyholder's insurance company agrees to abide by Canada's minimum financial responsibility limits.

He also said that many of the companies issue this card for a 60-day period with no increase in premium.

The card is not required for the provinces of Alberta, British Columbia, Ontario, and Manitoba, which specifically exempt U.S. visitors from this law.

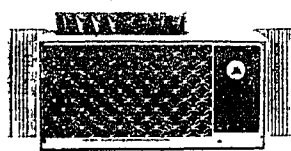
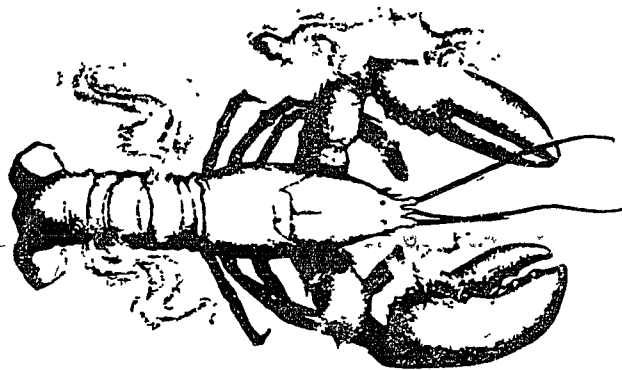

JULY 4th NEWS SERVICE

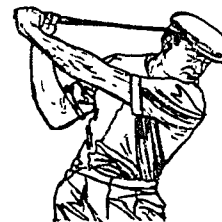
