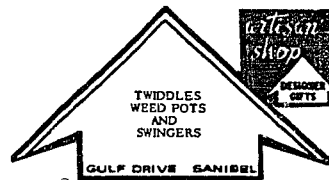

## ABOUT THE WEATHER

Well, it's there. Last Thursday, while we were delivering the Islanders, a little cloud chased us up and down the Islands, starting to rain every time we had to get out of the car — but that's just about the only rainfall we've had in the past week in any fairly measurable amount.

Outside of that, it's been warm (in the mid to high 80s during the day and low to mid 70s at night) and pleasant — especially if you have an air-conditioner.

MARK MCCLINTOCK of Tradewinds Motel on Sanibel lent us a clipping from "The Middletown Journal" of Ohio with a story of Mrs. JOHN RACE, who, with her family, has been wintering on Sanibel for the past seven or so years.

Mrs. Race was the lucky winner of the shell table given away during the 1967 Shell Fair, which is the reason for the story.

When she first came to Sanibel, said the Journal, she didn't know one shell from another — and was warned not to pick up the first shell unless she wanted to become a collector. The people who warned her were right — she now has over 30 boxes of arranged shells which she collected, plus the shell table. She also found one of the first, if not the first, lavender olive shell on the Islands, which she later donated to the Cincinnati Museum of Natural History, after displaying it at our Shell Fair.

Seems as if Sanibel and Captiva Islands just get publicity all over the place — isn't it wonderful?

## THE THINGS ONE FINDS OUT...

When one cleans out a basket on a newspaper desk are amazing (and sometimes embarrassing). We happened to clean off our desk this week and found a letter which had been sent to us by Will Combs of Sanibel — which we should have commented on months ago.

Mr. Combs and his wife, as many Islanders are aware, own property at the far end of Gulf Drive. They have created a "Botany Tour" — actually, God created it and they have preserved and labeled it — which is an enjoyment for any who see it. They have taken their land, left some jungle as it was, and landscaped other parts so that visitors may see the many hundreds of plants and trees which are native to our Islands. The tour is a delight shared by many, as the following letter (just one of the many the Combs have received) shows.

## MONEY FOR BEACH EROSION

Local governments would be able to obtain matching funds from the State Board of Conservation to combat beach erosion under a Senate bill now before the Appropriations Committee. The measure already has been voted favorably by the Water Conservation, Salt Water and Natural Resources Committee headed by Senator Elmer O. Friday.

Introduced by Senator Richard B. Stone of Dade County, the bill calls for an appropriation of \$11,125,000 from the State's general revenue fund to the Board of Conservation.

Priorities for acquisition of matching funds by local sources would be established by the Board.

Senator Friday, supporting the bill, noted that "Palm Beach County, especially, and Lee County, to a lesser extent generally, are faced with critical beach erosion problems."

This bill, from Senator Stone, would "go far in the battle to alleviate conditions," said Senator Friday.
