P. G. A. TOURNAMENT

Twelve professionals and thirty-six amateurs competed in a professional-amateur golf tournament sponsored by the Southwest Florida P. G. A. held at South Seas Plantation golf links last Thursday. Once again, the rugged par of this outstanding seaside layout that has successfully resisted the efforts of some of the best golfers in Florida remained unbroken. The best individual score of the day was by professional Pete Murray, the Blonde Bomber representing the Sebring Golf Club. Murray, who was one over par coming to the 18 hole, hit a beautiful second shot to within ten feet of the pin and made the difficult downhill putt for a birdie three. This brought him back to 72, par for the course, and won him first money in the professional division of the event. Second place went to young Jeff Wood, assistant professional at The Country Club Of Naples. Third place was shared by Ed Caldwell and Pat Rouse with 75's. Caldwell, the personable "Pro" from The Cape Coral Country Club, had a good day. He and his partners H. Myers, J. Brasfield and J. Smart won the Pro-Am division with an outstanding team effort of 58, which was best-ball for the foursome. Another of these increasingly popular events will be played at Cypress Lake Country Club next week.

UNSAFE SUNGLASSES FOUND

Tampa, Fla., Sept. 20 -- A
warning has been issued by the
Florida Optometric Association
to persons who might have pur-
chased blue lensed pairs of sun-
glasses during recent months
from racks in variety, depart-
ment and sundry store outlets.

The particular blue lens
spectacle in question completely
filters out all red and presents
a critical and immediate safety
hazard to the wearer, particu-
larly with regard to automobile
and motorcycle driving.

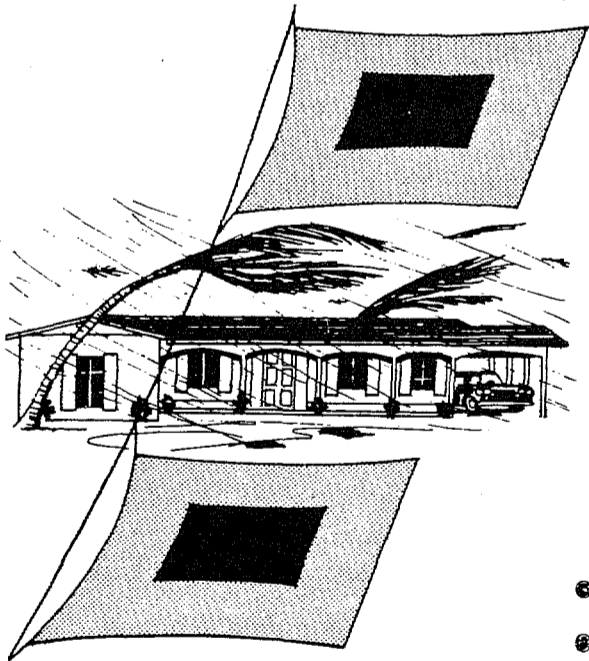
Since this lens is a complete
filter, the red tail, brake lights
and directional signals on the
rear of automobiles, as well
as traffic lights and certain
highway signs cannot be seen.
The glasses also have a tenden-
cy to make amber lights appear
as green.

The blue sunglasses are be-
ing sold from racks containing
sunglasses of other color tints
which have not been judged to
be similarly dangerous.

Owners of blue tinted glass-
es, most of which are perfectly
safe, are urged by the FOA to
carefully test their glasses by
focusing them on any red let-
tering, object or auto tail light
in order to detect the filtering
out of that color. Prospective
purchasers of sunglasses are
also warned to observe red
filtering while choosing sun-
glasses.
