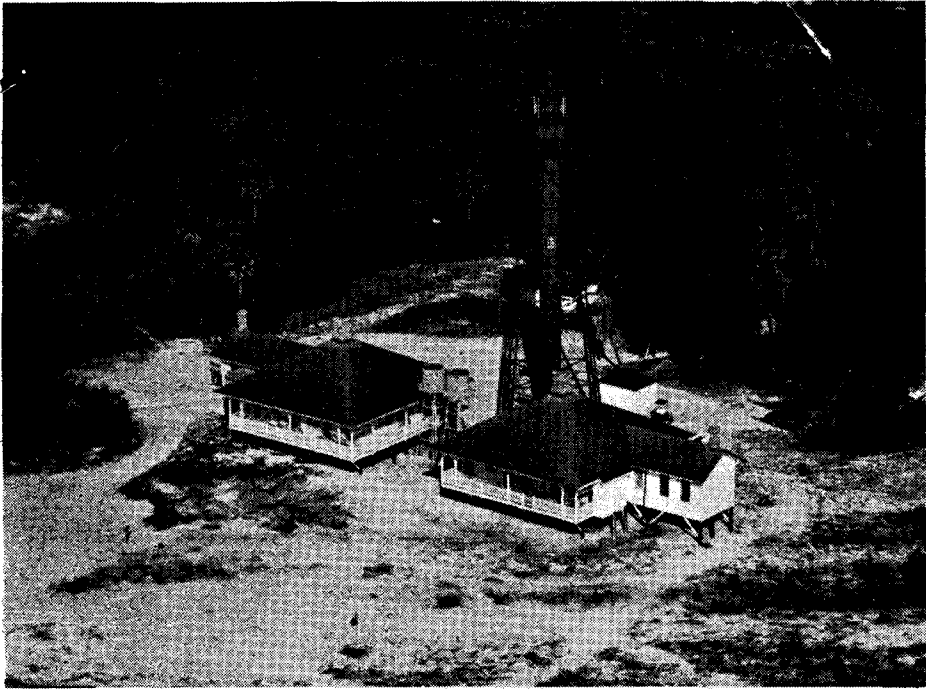

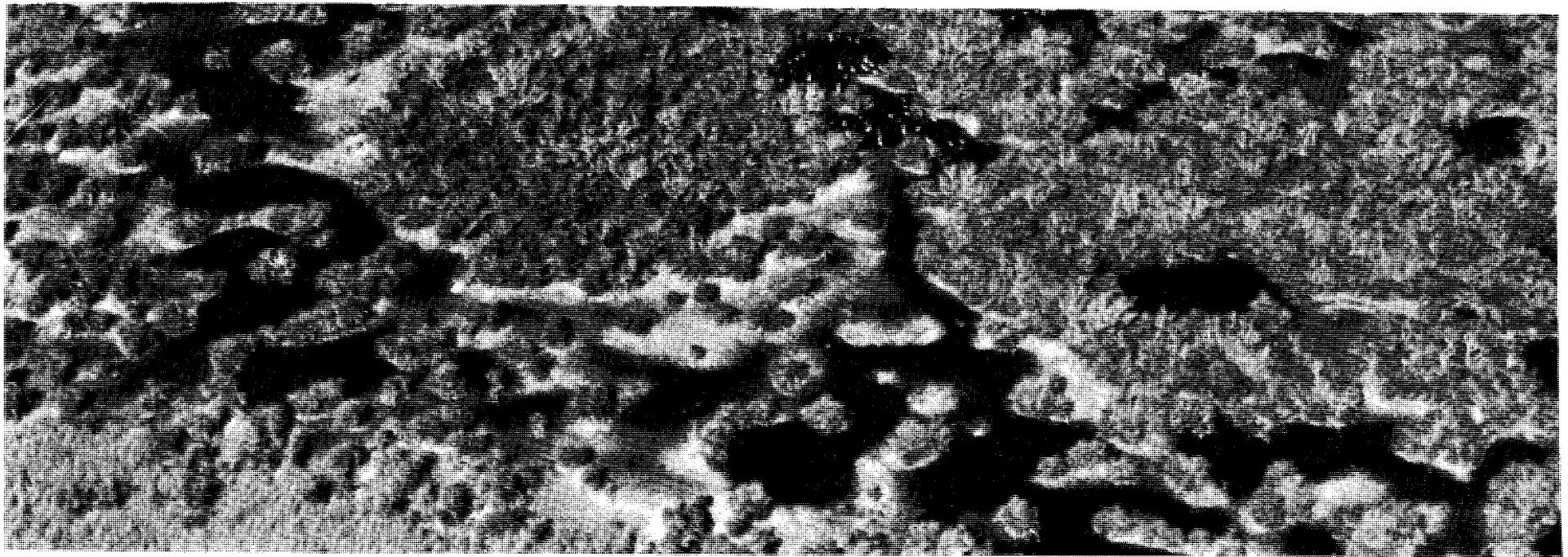

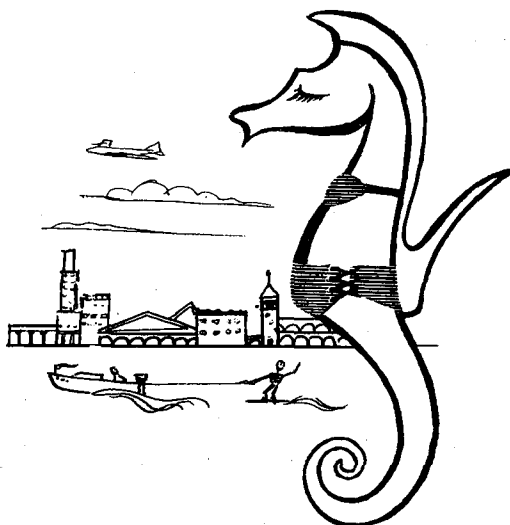

SANIBEL-CAPTIVA AUDUBON SOCIETY

THE SANIBEL-CAPTIVA AUDUBON SOCIETY WILL HOLD ITS FINAL MEETING OF THE SEASON AT THE SANIBEL COMMUNITY CENTER THURSDAY, APRIL 25. THE MEETING, TO WHICH THE PUBLIC IS WELCOME, WILL START AT 8 O'CLOCK.

THE PROGRAM WILL INCLUDE TWO COLOR FILMS, "PAINTED REEFS OF HONDURAS" AND "TWILIGHT REEF," AND THE ANNUAL ELECTION OF SOCIETY OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS.

IN "PAINTED REEFS OF HONDURAS" SCUBA-DIVERS AL AND MARIAN GIDDINGS EXPLORE ONE OF THE LARGEST BARRIER REEFS IN THE WORLD, OFF THE COAST OF HONDURAS. THE FILM FEATURES HAMMERHEAD SHARKS, GIANT MORAY EELS, AND HUGE GROUPERS. "TWILIGHT REEF" BRINGS THE REEFS ALONG THE YUCATAN COAST INTO VIVID REALISM. IT TAKES THE AUDIENCE ON AN 80-FOOT MIDNIGHT DIVE TO SEE AN OCTOPUS FEED, AND SHOWS THE EXCITING SPEARING OF A SIX-FOOT BARRACUDA.

THE AUDUBON SOCIETY IS CONCLUDING ONE OF ITS MOST SUCCESSFUL YEARS. DURING THE WINTER IT DOUBLED ITS MEMBERSHIP, ESTABLISHED AN ALLIGATOR PROTECTION FUND TO PAY REWARDS FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ALLIGATOR POACHERS, AND HELPED ESTABLISH AN EAGLE AND SEVERAL REGULAR BIRD SANCTUARIES. SEVERAL OF ITS PROGRAMS DREW STANDING-ROOM-ONLY CROWDS, EVEN THOUGH 50 EXTRA CHAIRS WERE BORROWED.

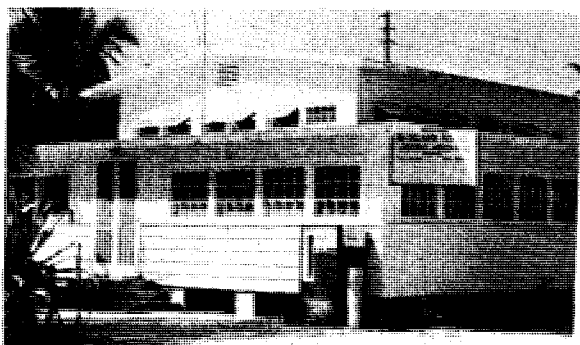

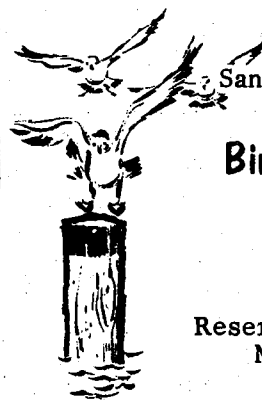

LIBRARY VOLUNTEERS PICNIC AT HAYNIE'S

THIRTY SIX LIBRARY WORKERS, THEIR WIVES, HUSBANDS AND A FEW CHILDREN, ATTENDED A BEACH PICNIC AT THE GULF FRONT HOME OF MR. AND MRS. ROBERT HAYNIE LAST SATURDAY AFTERNOON. AT THE CLOSE OF OPEN HOURS ON SATURDAY NOON ALL WORKERS FOR THE SANIBEL PUBLIC LIBRARY AND THEIR FAMILIES GATHERED AROUND THE BEACH HOUSE, BROILED HOT DOGS, ATE POTATO SALAD, AND WASHED IT ALL DOWN WITH SOFT DRINKS AND BEER. THE NATURE CENTERS TEAM, HEADED BY JOSEPH J. SHOMON, DIRECTOR, WILL BE ON SANIBEL AGAIN IN JUNE TO DO THE FIELD WORK FOR THE PLAN.

DR. HANLEY BOSS, HEAD OF THE BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT AT FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY, BOCA RATON, AND DR. ANDREW J. MEYERIECKS, DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY, UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA, TAMPA, HAVE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD PROPOSALS FOR RESEARCH AND EDUCATIONAL PROJECTS ON SANIBEL USING FACILITIES AVAILABLE FROM THE FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE, OUR FOUNDATION, AND OTHER SOURCES. DETAILS WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS.

PRESERVING THE SANIBEL SLOUGH SYSTEM, BROUGHT INTO SHARP FOCUS AT THE CONFERENCE AS A VITAL FACTOR IN THE ISLAND ECOLOGY, IS THE GOAL OF A SPECIAL COMMITTEE OF OUR BOARD. UNDER CONSERVATION EASEMENT AGREEMENTS. THIS WILL ALLOW TIME FOR FINDING METHODS TO PRESERVE THE SYSTEM AND PROVIDE FOR ITS ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT TO YIELD MAXIMUM PROFIT TO THE OWNERS WITH MINIMUM LOSS OF THE SLOUGH SYSTEM ITSELF.

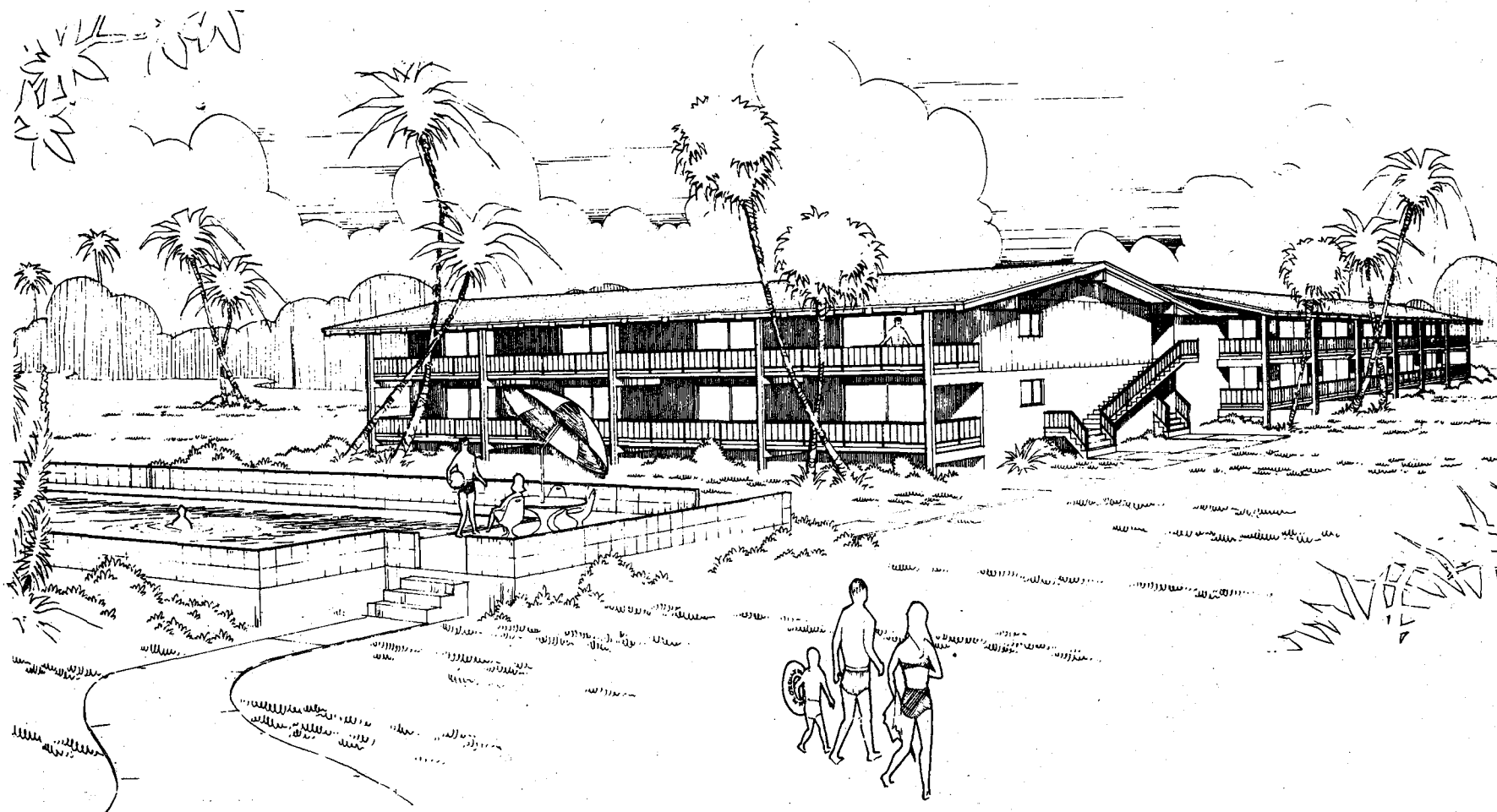

FLORIDA, WHOSE LARGEST NATURAL RESOURCE IS WATER, IS NOW IN A STATE OF DROUGHT WHICH THREATENS ALL WILD LIFE AND ULTIMATELY, MAN HIMSELF.

REPRESENTATIVE TED RANDELL, CHAIRMAN OF THE FLORIDA LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MET WITH 12 SENATORS AND REPRESENTATIVES AT THE EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK TO FIND OUT SOME OF THE PROBLEMS FACING THEM.

THE WATER SUPPLY FOR THE SOUTHERN HALF OF FLORIDA COMES FROM THE KISSIMMEE AREA WHICH EMPTIES INTO LAKE OKEECHOBEE. FROM THIS VAST BODY OF WATER ARE MANY CANALS WHICH DIRECT THE WATER TO AGRICULTURE AND TO CITIES (SUCH AS THE RECENT DEVELOPMENT OF THE LEE COUNTY TIE-IN TO THE CALOOSAHATCHEE RIVER ABOVE FORT MYERS).

ANY WATER LEFT OVER GOES ON DOWN TO THE EVERGLADES. AND THE EVERGLADES TAKES IN A VAST AREA OF SOUTH FLORIDA.

THIS SMALL AMOUNT OF WATER HAS EVEN BEEN TURNED OFF COMPLETELY AT TIMES AND FLUSHED OUT THROUGH THE CALOOSAHATCHEE ON THE WEST COAST AND THE CANALS OF THE EAST COAST.

WHEN YOU COUPLE THIS WITH A NATURAL DROUGHT, THE VERY EXISTENCE OF THE WILD LIFE IN THE EVERGLADES IS IN DANGER.

WITHOUT ENOUGH WATER THE ALLIGATORS HAVE CROWDED INTO THE MUCKY POT-HOLES FOR SURVIVAL. THIS IS THE WAY IT ALWAYS WORKED UNTIL MAN, INCLUDING POACHERS, GOT INTO THE ACT. IT IS QUITE EASY FOR A POACHER TO SHOOT OR KILL THE ENTIRE POPULATION OF AN AREA IN A NIGHT OR TWO. THE HIDES, WHICH ARE ONLY THE BELLY SKIN, BRING ABOUT \$6.00 PER FOOT. AND, AS EASY AS IT IS FOR THE POACHERS, REGRETFULLY, IT IS EQUALLY AS HARD TO DO ANYTHING ABOUT THEM.

WHEN THE GATOR IS GONE FROM A HOLE, IT FILLS WITH AQUATIC WEEDS WHICH, IN A SHORT TIME, COMPLETELY FILL THE DEEP HOLES WHICH THEN CANNOT EVEN HARBOR THE TINY FISH WHICH ARE THE NEXT LINK IN THE CHAIN OF SURVIVAL.

WHEN THE HOLES ARE GONE AND WITH THEM THE FISH AND THE FROGS AND THE SNAKES AND SNAILS AND THE INSECTS, THEN THE BIRDS DIE OFF BECAUSE THERE IS NO FOOD FOR THEM.

IN THAT END, IF AN ANSWER IS NOT DEVELOPED IMMEDIATELY, MAN WILL RULE OVER THE FISH IN THE SEA, THE FOWL OF THE AIR, AND OVER EVERY CREEPING THING THAT CREEPETH UPON THE EARTH---BUT ONLY ON PAPER. AN EXTINCT ANIMAL OR PLANT CANNOT BE RECREATED BY MERE MAN.

THE SHARK RIVER SLOUGH IN THE EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK IS PROBABLY THE AMERICAN ALLIGATOR'S LAST CHANCE FOR SURVIVAL. AND THE SLOUGH'S OWN CHANCE FOR SURVIVAL IS NOW IN DANGER.

WHAT IS THE ANSWER? 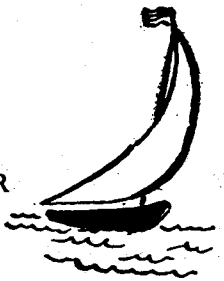

Following is the Foundation's STATEMENT of PURPOSES

THE SANIBEL-CAPTIVA CONSERVATION FOUNDATION IS DEDICATED TO THE BELIEF THAT PEOPLE, IF THEY HAVE THE WILL TO PRESERVE IT, CAN ENJOY RATHER THAN DESTROY THE WORLD AROUND THEM. WE HERE HAVE A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO DEMONSTRATE THIS BY CONSERVING THE NATURAL QUALITIES OF OUR ISLANDS WHICH SET THEM ASIDE AS A DISTINCTIVE WAY OF LIFE FOR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS ALIKE.

SANIBEL, CAPTIVA AND THE CHAIN OF ISLANDS OF WHICH THEY FORM A PART ARE STILL RELATIVELY UNDEVELOPED. THEY OFFER ONE OF THE LAST OPPORTUNITIES TO PRESERVE THE RICH TREASURY OF WILDLIFE AND VEGETATION WHICH FLOURISH IN A SEMI-TROPICAL WILDERNESS.

TIME IS SHORT, AS BITTER LESSONS LEARNED TOO LATE IN OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY HAVE SHOWN. BUT THE FOUNDATION BELIEVES THESE ASSETS CAN BE PRESERVED BY ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT RATHER THAN EXPLOITATION. TO THIS END THE FOUNDATION, WORKING CLOSELY WITH OTHER CONSERVATION GROUPS AND CONTINUALLY SOLICITING THE OPINIONS OF OTHERS, SETS FORTH THE FOLLOWING GOALS. THEIR ACHIEVEMENT WILL REQUIRE THE SUPPORT OF ALL INTERESTED PEOPLE.

1. **LAND ACQUISITION.** THE FOUNDATION, AS SUCCESSOR TO THE DING DARLING MEMORIAL COMMITTEE, IS PROUD TO HAVE TAKEN THE LEAD IN THE CREATION OF THE DING DARLING SANCTUARY. WE BELIEVE OTHER AREAS CAN SIMILARLY BE SET ASIDE. AND WE FEEL LAND DEVELOPERS CAN BE SHOWN THE FINANCIAL REWARDS FOR PRESERVING PORTIONS OF THEIR HOLDINGS IN A NATURAL STATE.

2. **WILDLIFE PROTECTION.** WILDLIFE CANNOT FLOURISH ISOLATED EVEN IN A SANCTUARY. SURROUNDING ESTUARINE AREAS WITH THE BASIC NOURISHMENT FOR BIRDS, FISH, SHELLFISH AND OTHER LIFE MUST BE PRESERVED, UNPOLLUTED. AND THERE MUST BE AREAS FOR UNMOLESTED FEEDING AND BREEDING. THIS REQUIRES ETERNAL VIGILANCE AGAINST THE MARCH OF INDUSTRIALIZATION AND OF CAMPERS, PICNICKERS AND OTHER INVADERS. OUR ISLANDS ARE AS RICH IN PLANT AS IN ANIMAL LIFE AND THIS, TOO, CAN BE PRESERVED. MUCH CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED BY ENCOURAGING THE RETENTION AND PLANTING OF NATIVE VEGETATION.

3. **ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT.** IN ALL CASES WE WILL SEEK TO COOPERATE WITH DEVELOPERS AND TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC STUDIES WHICH MAY POINT THE WAY TO THE TYPES OF DEVELOPMENT THAT CAN BENEFIT BOTH THE DEVELOPER AND THE CONSERVATIONIST. AS ONE POINT, THERE SHOULD BE ACCESS ROADS TO UPPER CAPTIVA AND LECOSTA ISLANDS BUT THIS SHOULD NOT INCLUDE A HIGHWAY RUNNING DIRECTLY THROUGH THE ISLAND CHAIN.

4. **EDUCATION.** CHILDREN AND ADULTS, LAYMEN AND EXPERTS ALL HAVE MUCH TO LEARN ABOUT THE OTHER FORMS OF LIFE WHICH SHARE THIS PLANET WITH US. THE FOUNDATION WILL SPONSOR GENERAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AS WELL AS SPECIAL ECOLOGICAL RESEARCH. FROM THIS WE EXPECT TO GAIN KNOWLEDGE TO PROVIDE THE BASIS FOR FURTHER STEPS TO CONSERVE THE ENVIRONMENT CHERISHED BY US ALL.
