AUDUBON ELECTION

At the closing meeting of the 1967-68 season, held on April 25, the Sanibel-Captiva Audubon elected unanimously the following officers for 1968: Mario F. Hutton, president; Griffing Bancroft, vice president; Louise Goodwin, secretary-treasurer. The following were appointed directors for a three year term: Edmund Carnahan, Clarence R. Conklin, Gladys Reese, Hervey Roberts. The Board will also include Roy Bazire, President of the Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation, and the following directors held over from 1967: Margaret Buschman, Elmer L. Severinghaus and George S. Winterbotham.

In submitting his annual report, President Mario Hutton stated that 1967 saw the activities, achievements and scope of the local Audubon increase to a most encouraging extent. Among other outstanding results, he listed the coming Florida Audubon Society Leaders' Conference, to be held on Sanibel from November 14 to 18; the establishment of a Bald Eagle Sanctuary on Captiva, and a 40 acre Wildlife Sanctuary on Sanibel; pledges in excess of one thousand dollars for the Alligator Protection Fund; highly successful interventions before the County Commissioners and Zoning Board; close cooperation with several Audubon Chapters visiting Sanibel; the increase in the quality and number of programs conducted, at which attendance has tripled;

improvement in the financial situation, with assets almost doubled; and the doubling of the membership from 112 to 225, highest in the annals of the Society. Mr. Hutton gave credit to the teamwork and enthusiasm of his associates, and pledged the continuance of the same successful policies on the part of the new administration.

LIBRARY HAS NEW NON-FICTION

Five new non-fiction books have just been made available at the Sanibel Public Library, ranging from history to instruction in wood-working.

"Wood Carving," by Freda Skinner, offers instruction in capturing artistic forms in wood. Covered are such subjects as the selection of wood for carving, the workshop, tools, and instruction in carving specific figures. The 160 pages of text are well illustrated to help the beginner.

Another book on woodworking is "Fine Furniture for the Amateur Cabinetmaker." This book by A.W. Marlow contains 14 projects illustrated by 435 drawings and pictures to take the beginner through each step in the creation of fine furniture.

"The Presence of Spain," a monumental book with text by James Morris and 123 pages of photographs (18 pages in full color) by Evelyn Hofer, presents the grandeur and magnetism of Spain. The book is a portrait of the country, presenting her proud, brooding and romantic aspects.

Another book on Spain presents her history as seen, remembered and recorded by her artists. "Spain---A History in Art," by Bradley Smith, contains 245 works of art newly photographed in color. The scope ranges from the cave paintings of Altamira to Goya and Picasso.

"Seas, Maps and Men," is an imposing and well illustrated book on man's exploration and conquest of the seas of the world. The book is divided into six sections: The Earth and its Oceans; Men Against the Sea; Life in the Sea; Sunken Cities and Forgotten Wrecks; New Attacks on the Sea; and the Future of the Sea. Each section is written by experts in their fields and brought together and edited by G.E.R. Deacon, director of the National Institute of Oceanography, England.

HISTORY AND PRESENT OCCUPY KINDS OF UDC

MEMBERS OF THE LAETITIA ASHMORE NUTT CHAPTER, UNITED DAUGHTERS OF THE CONFEDERACY SPENT A BUSY TUESDAY, APRIL 16, AT THE HOME OF MR. AND MRS. W.B. COMBS, WOODMERE PRESERVE, SANIBEL ISLAND. PLANS WERE FORMED FOR PLACING FLOWERS ON THE 23 CONFEDERATE GRAVES IN FORT MYERS CEMETERIES ON SOUTHERN MEMOR-

IAL DAY, APRIL 26.

THE GROUP MET WITH A LUNCHEON OF CHINESE FOOD SERVED BY MRS. COMBS WITH TWELVE MEMBERS AND GUESTS IN ATTENDANCE. AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MEETING MRS. VIRGINIA MILLER, HISTORIAN, CONDUCTED A QUIZ ON THE UDC WHICH WILL BE CONTINUED WITH EACH MEETING.

MR. COMBS ENTERTAINED THE WOMEN WITH THE STORY OF HIS FLAG RAISING DAY

IN JUNE, 1954, WHEN FOUR FLAGS WERE RAISED WITH FITTING CEREMONIES ON THE PLACE. THESE FLAGS, MADE BY MR. AND MRS. COMBS, ARE REPLICAS OF THE DIFFERENT FLAGS WHICH WERE FLOWN IN THE PAST OVER THE ISLAND. THEY WERE: A PIRATE FLAG, SPANISH, ENGLISH AND CONFEDERATE. MR. COMBS RELATED TO THE WOMEN THAT IT IS BELIEVED THE PIRATES CONTROLLED THE ISLAND AT ONE TIME BUT NOT TOO MUCH

FACTUAL HISTORY CAN BE FOUND. THE SPANISH FLAG DID FLY OVER THE ISLAND FOR OVER 300 YEARS EXCEPTING THE 19 YEARS WHEN IT WAS UNDER ENGLISH CONTROL. UNITED STATES BOUGHT THE ISLAND IN 1819 AND HAS CONTINUED TO BE THE OWNER. THE CONFEDERATE FLAG WAS FLOWN OVER THE ISLAND FOR FOUR YEARS, DURING THE BATTLE BETWEEN THE STATES.

A NEW FLAG WAS PRESENTED TO THE CHAPTER BY MRS. V. F. SENSEMAN AND HER HUSBAND. MRS.
