FIVE NEW BOOKS

Five new books, two novels and three non-fiction, have been added to the available volumes at the Sanibel Public Library.

"Look at Us, Let's See, Here We Are, etc., etc.," is a book of pictures by Arthur Rothstein, a photographer for Look, with comment by William Saroyan. The black and white photographs cover a wide range of American life and the Saroyan text, as might be expected, weeps a little for human frailties.

"Using Wayside Plants," by Nelson Coon, is a book of instruction for those who enjoy camping, hiking and outdoor activities in general. It tells how to identify and use wild plants for food, medicine and nature craft.

"Drinkers of the Wind," by Carl Raswan, is a true story of high adventure which the author experienced in the Arabian desert. He lived with the wandering tribesmen, and found the horse of his dreams. He now lives in Mexico where he breeds and raises fine Arabian horses.

"Katie Mulholland," by Catherine Cookson, is a novel of English life which spans three generations from the 1860s to World War II. The book is said to have the emotional power that will remind many readers of "How Green Was My Valley."

"The Final Diagnosis," by Arthur Hailey, is the novel of a doctor who struggled to pull his declining hospital back to its former standards, and out of the control of an aging, once-brilliant pathologist.



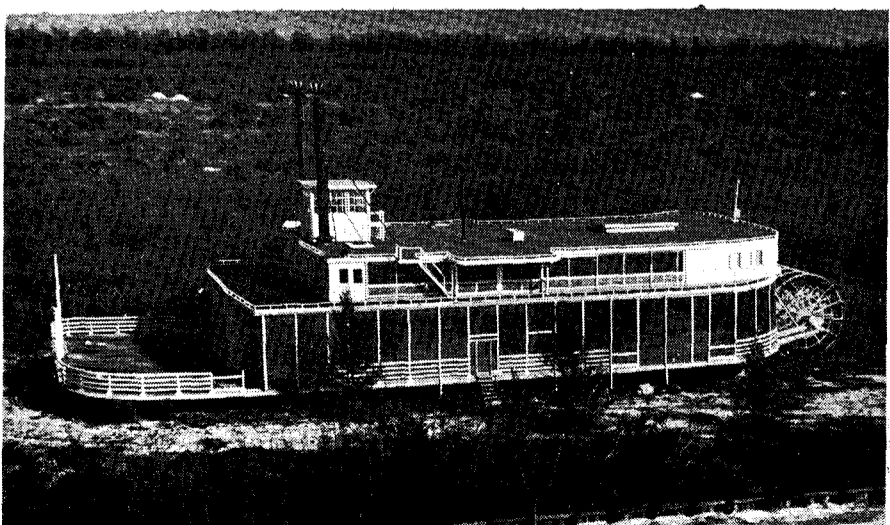

We crossed the country with the wagon trains, (here my heart was a little sad as Darryl sang Shenandoah, as my mind wandered back to the state of my birth, Virginia, and the winding Shenandoah River). We visited New Orleans, the birthplace of the Blues, California, Jamaica, with its Calypso beat, and then found our way to present day music. We could use a few more of these cultural evenings.

TO THE ISLANDER:

Your editorial on the water conditions is splendid, your question about solutions is naive. There is not a person in Florida who does not know what is needed. The trouble is that there are so many interests which consider getting rich quick for themselves vastly more important than the ultimate benefit of the community. Everybody knows that the ground water has been ruthlessly drained and forest ruthlessly destroyed. In the midst of the crisis it goes on just as before. The community will, in the long run, pay hundredfold for its greed and selfishness.

The solution of the water problem will be found when the duck farmers and the real estate interests no longer dominate the politics and economy of the state, when Floridians strictly limit their operations. This will result in the Army engineers no longer playing along with the political power of destructive interests but those of conservation interests, which are those of the community.

Everybody has long known that everything and everybody (with some notable and splendid exceptions---but a minority) could be bought and sold in the state. The average citizen has been helpless in the face of the massive and misleading propaganda for the interests. Take a look at Gulf American's operations and you will know the solution of the water problem. As long as this sort of rapacity is permitted (and this is only one instance) mere ingenuity is worthless. If the population were once sufficiently frightened something useful might happen. That is the way to a solution.

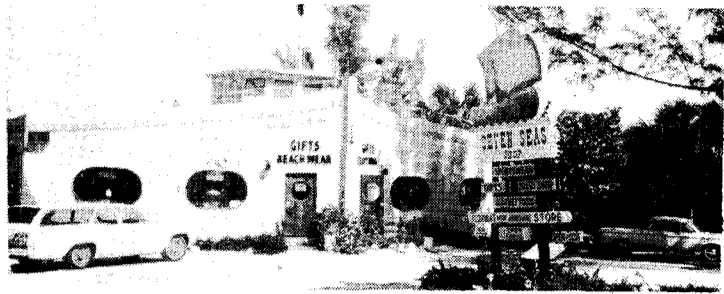

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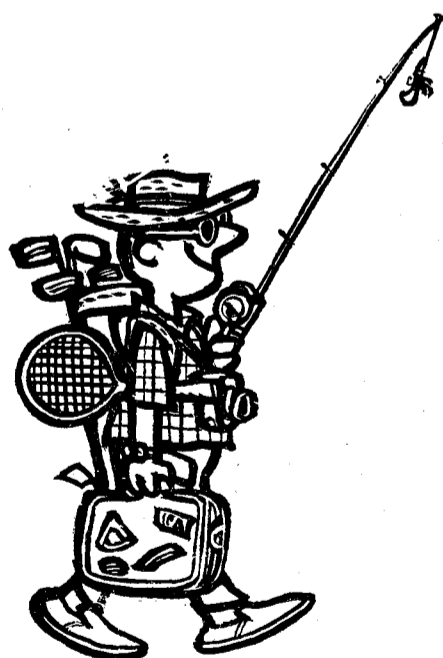


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
