



Efforts now are being made to find a qualified person to take Mrs. Remus' place as Sanibel librarian.


THANK YOU KKP 5247

TWO OF THE MANY FACETS OF OUR WONDERFUL ISLANDS



SPRING FLOWERING SHRUBS FOR COLOR MAGIC

Gardens in Florida need not be monotonous, according to President Richard G. Johnson of Florida Nurserymen and Growers Association. There are so many varieties of hardy and tropical plants that thrive in our Florida climate that color is available all seasons with a little planning.

Oleanders used to be considered a leggy, unattractive shrub

when it became old-but no longer. Now Oleanders are trimmed to grow into formal trees and are doing yeoman duty as small trees for patios, in parking areas, and in avenues along walks. Oleanders come in white, pink, red and yellow-cream, and the trees are most spectacular in bloom. Gardeners have found that if you clip off old blooms, feed the plants and water them, you will get repeat flowers!

Crepe Myrtle has become another small tree...and it, too, can be trimmed into tree form. When old flowers are removed and the tree is fed and watered, you get repeat bloom there..and the Crepe Myrtle Hybrids are about as near lilacs as Floridians can grow!

Other summer flowering shrubs include Tibouchina, with the royal purple flowers; Gardenias and Tabernaemontanas, both with beautiful white flowers; Duranta, with lavender flowers and bright yellow berries; Ixora, now in red, yellow and orange, as well as white, that blooms all summer long; Jasmines come in many varieties, and produce yellow or white blossoms in abundance most of the summer months. Certainly no Floridian could have a garden without Hibiscus in variety...and how many varieties there are now has not been determined. Hemerocallis-commonly called Davillies---used to be yellow or orange. Now they are available in pastels and jewel tones from neat white to almost black..with pinks, rose, lavender, purple, and many unusual shades.

If you are moving to a new area..or have already moved..you

will want to note the plants that seem to be doing well in the area in which you live. Just because your lilacs were the best in the county back home does not help here..you have to grow plants that thrive under the soil and climatic conditions. You should discuss this with your local FNGA discuss this with your local FNGA nurseryman.he can recommend how you can plant your grounds so you will have color all year by selecting for the planting some summer blooming, some fall flowering and some winter blooming varieties, as

ting some summer blooming, some fall flowering and some winter blooming varieties, as well as those that "bloom in the spring!" Check your county agent ..he has bulletins from the Department of Agriculture and Agricultural Extension Service that will prove most helpful.

TAXPAYERS ASK IRS

Q- I planted some flowering shrubs around my house this spring. Can I treat this landscaping cost as a capital investment for tax purposes?

A- Yes, expenditures for landscaping can be added to the cost of your property. However, this would not include normal maintenance and care of the shrubs and lawn.

Q- My daughter opened her first bank account and was asked for her social security number. How can she get one; she's only 13? A- A person can obtain a social security number regardless of age by filling out Form SS-5 available at local Social Security or IRS offices. Banks and other savings institutions are required by law to identify annual interest payments of \$10 or more by the social security number of the recipient.

Q- I filed my return in April. What could be holding up my refund?

A- Many refunds are delayed beyond the usual 5 to 6 week processing period because the returns were incomplete or contained errors. Missing or inaccurate Social Security numbers, missing signatures, missing W-2 statements and other required supporting documents were common causes for delays.
