SCOUTS VISIT ISLANDS

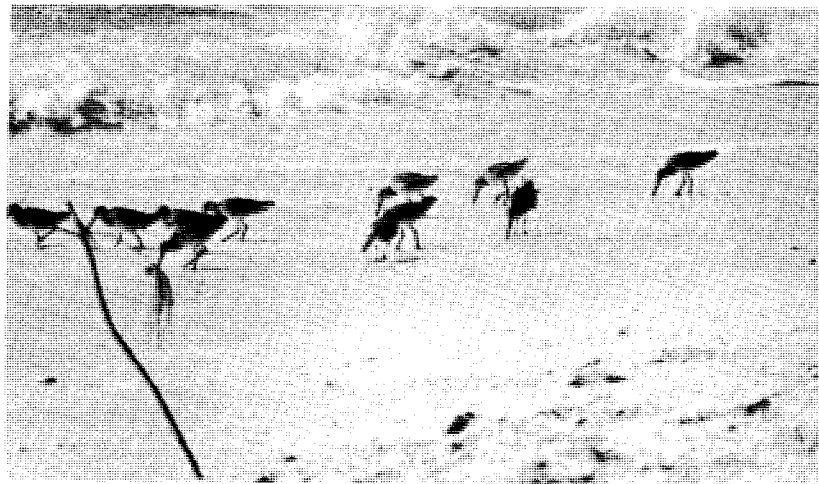

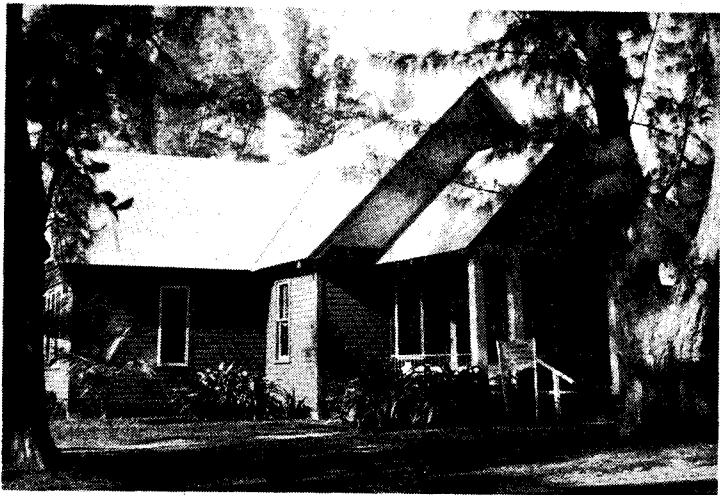

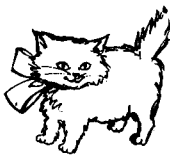

RIGHT OF WAY NEEDED

The following letter has been received on the Islands and we believe that all residents should be highly interested.

Board of County Commissioners
Lee County Court House
Fort Myers, Florida

Gentlemen:

In order to clarify misunderstandings regarding the right-of-way acquisition for the State Road project on Periwinkle Way, Sanibel Island, I would like to suggest the Board's approval of the following statement which may be used by the right-of-way agents of the State Road Department in acquiring the outstanding right-of-way by dedication:

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby declare that the State Road project for Periwinkle Way, Sanibel Island, can only become a reality if 100 percent of the property owners abutting this road dedicate the necessary right-of-way. However, if all right-of-way is not dedicated for this road project, it will be necessary for the Board of County Commissioners to seek alternate alignments for the major arterial road serving Sanibel Island.

2. The above statement applies to dedication of land only and the Board of County Commissioners is willing to authorize the use of secondary road funds to pay any and all damages resulting from re-location of signs, buildings and other improvements which may exist in the limits of the additional right-of-way.

GLEN ALLEN RHODES MEMORIAL AND SCHOLARSHIP FUND
