

S. C. A. SPARKS NEW IDEAS

The Sanibel Community Association held their first Board meeting last week to plan the agenda of activities for the coming year. New officers and Board members are: Francis Bailey, Pres., Dan Moore, Vice pres., Robert Dormer, Sec., Robert Aycock, Treas.; Board Members: Gerald T. Martin, Marty Holtz, Wm. Newman, Howard Schriner, Wallace Cousins, Dr. Curtis House, and Albert Walthers. Shell Fair business took priority in order to launch the biggest and best Fair ever. Gerald T. Martin, Chairman of the Brochure and Shell Table Committee reports that an entirely new shell table designed by Howard Schriner is already underway and is again being made by Charles LeBuff, Sr. of Naples. Specimen shells are being contributed by the Island Shops and individual collectors. Besides the new shell table, the Board approved a new idea this year of offering a chance to win any of three prizes for one ticket donation. A large Juno's volute (Scaphella junonia Shaw) under a glass domed bell for second prize and a Johnstones volute (Scaphella junonia Johnstoneae Clench) under a similar glass dome for a third prize.

A team of three able craftsmen started work last March to get pictures and stories for this years Brochure. They are Howard Schriner, creative Director; Jean Culpepper, copywriter; and Ewd. Lucas, photographer and owner of Thomsett Studio in Naples. Merchants on both Islands have been alerted of the importance of getting their copy in to meet the July 15th deadline for advertising in the Brochure.

Because the Community House is not air-conditioned the general monthly covered dish supper meetings have been suspended until Fall. Announcement will be made thru this paper when the meetings will be resumed. In the meantime any Community matters can be reported to anyone of the new Officers or Board Members who will be "on Island" thru the summer and will be keeping the wheels moving toward a big year for the Community in 1969.

FISH FRY HAS RECORD TURNOUT

Since the phones were out of service (off Islanders couldn't call anyone on the Islands) on our last deadline day, we weren't able to get this information last week. But here 'tis.

The American Legion July 4 fish fry given by Sanibel Captiva American Legion Post #123 was a greater success than any other one ever given. Not only were the fried mullet, hush puppies and cole slaw (as well as assorted beverages) absolutely delicious, they were all sold out by 4:30 in the afternoon...and about 600 persons braved the uncertain weather to share the feast.

The Legion home is being remodeled...a complete kitchen with facilities for preparing full suppers, etc., is being donated by the Auxiliary. The funds are coming from the proceeds of selling a shell picture donated by the late Mary Cunningham of Captiva. The kitchen will be completed in about a month, and the work on it is being done by members of the Legion.







While in Seward, they will en-


