PLANNING ALANDSCAPE IS IMPERATIVE

So you have a new home in Florida---where you look across a treeless street to bare front yards, and from your window to a plot of barren land adjoining three neighbors. You feel as the you have taken up living in a goldfish bowl, with your neighbors to the front, back and on two sides able to watch your every move. Well, don't panic, now! It is the time for some real thought and plan-

Few homeowners are able. according to President Richard C. Johnson of Florida Nurserymen and Growers Association, to look ahead and visualize the total picture they wish to create. The immediate program seems to be planting of grass, trees and hed-

It is far more important, when planning, to choose your trees thoughtfully, and to select an attractive, quick growing screen material that will add to the beauty of not only your own yard but to those bordering yours. As a matter of fact, in new areas it is quite prevalent for neighbors to collaborate in planting screens so that they all may enjoy privacy and yet cement friendships.

One factor of great importance when planning your plantings is maintenance. If you have a green thumb and enjoy working in gardens regularly, you can really have a beautiful garden with special collections of shrubs. Or perhaps you are one of those folks who just wish to enjoy the privacy of your back yard as you loll in

a hammock on your patio on Saturday and Sunday afternoons and watch or listen to ball games! In designing a garden it is important that you consider this. If you do not like to mow grass, perhaps ground covers or pebbles are the answer. If you personally like to weed flower beds, that is fine. If you had rather do something else, then just mulch your plants with pine straw or shredded bark, or perhaps with black plastic.

A well planned garden usually requires a minimum of maintenance and can stand some neglect. This means that plants that are not tempermental must be used, and a simple arrangement in a natural manner will add to the loveliness of the planting.

One word of caution---do not try to plant one of everything you have ever seen, nor do you want to take every plant that is offered. Repetition in the use of plants makes a landscape planting more attractive. A plant collection, while of horticultural interest, is not particularly attractive for a landscape planting, so don't let your love for plants lead you astray and make your garden a hodgepodge rather than organized beauty.


