

WHY WATERING IS SO IMPORTANT

Dry weather has probably taken more of a toll of grass and plants than anyone quite realizes, and the importance of watering can be emphasized too much, according to President Richard C. Johnson of Florida Nurserymen and Growers Association. It is a bit difficult for some folks to understand, but inches and inches of water applied with a sprinkler does not do the good that a shower of rain brings forth. Why? Because the rain water contains nitrogen, generated when the lightning flashes in thunderstorms. The nitrogen on the foliage and on the roots makes the plants and grass grow off better and gives them a better color.

The problem with dry weather is that most folks do not know how to water to do the most good. For example, most people like to get out with a water hose with a nozzle on it and spray water on the plants and on the ground around them for a while and then they feel they have watered. They do this every day--and wonder why when they go on vacation their lawn and plants burn up! Actually, light watering done often encourages the roots of the plant to locate near the surface and when it dries out, the roots are so close to the top that the sun just dries and parches them. If you will set your sprinklers and leave them running for several hours until you have put on two to four inches of water twice each week, the roots will be deeper, and they can survive longer without water.

One caution, since we have been told we should get rain in June: If you applied fertilizer to your plants and grass in April and have not watered profusely, better be a bit careful about applying another application until you check and see how much undissolved fertilizer might still be under the plants and shrubs. Often if we have dry weather and do not water sufficiently to dissolve and make the plant food accessible to the plant roots, if we put on another application and with rainy weather it all becomes available at once and burns your plants or grass. Note your plants cautiously and if the leaves are a rich, deep green, but are burned around the edges, you'd better soak around the plant heavily and quickly to get some of the plant food out of root reach to prevent damage. This is one advantage of application of food in liquid form--it is made available at time of application and does not lay on the ground to complicate growth when we do get rain!





YELLOW JACK AND FOMITES

It was a known fact in 1890 that yellow jack, also known as yellow fever, could be spread by "fomites." These were strange, disease-producing agents usually found in mail bags, inadequately disinfected trunks and personal clothing. They could be found in disinfected houses and carried by travelers from one place to another.

Because yellow fever was usually present in Havana and periodically introduced by fomites into Florida ports by ships which had visited Cuba or other Central and South American countries, these invisible agents were objects of great fear.

Ships seeking entry into Florida were sent to a quarantine station where they were fumigated. Travelers who were not certified as "acclimated" to the disease were detained. A person was said to be "acclimated" if he had the disease or had built up a tolerance to it. But it was known that Acclimation certificates could be purchased for a price in Florida and Cuba and the reliability of this concept was questioned by some medical men in Florida. A few public health officials believed that an attack of yellow fever conferred an immunity upon an individual and he need not be quarantined.


