AUDUBON CONFERENCE

The Florida Audubon Society Fall Conference will be held on Sanibel from Thursday November 14 through Sunday 18. One of the most important annual events in the field of conservation and wildlife, the gathering will bring together more than 150 leaders of most Audubon Chapters from all over Florida. Many additional participants will attend from Ft. Myers, Naples, Sanibel and Captiva Islands, as the Conference is open to the public. Daily and evening sessions will be held in the Auditorium of Casa Ybel Resort. Thursday morning will be devoted to registration of participants. A Field Trip by chartered busses will take place from 2:30 to 5 p.m., followed by a Welcome Party and Reception jointly sponsored by the Sanibel-Captiva Audubon and the local Conservation Foundation. The same evening Dr. Maurice W. Provost, of the Florida Board of Health will be the speaker. On Friday, beginning at 9 a.m., there will be an all day Workshop, with the participation of noted personalities, such as Lyman Rogers, Chairman, Governor's Natural Resources Committee, Sydney Howe, and John Paul Jones. Evening speaker will be Nathaniel Reed, Administrative Assistant of the Governor. Saturday

afternoon there will be several programs of special interest, including a report on the activities of the Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation, a talk on shelling by Mrs. John P. Glass, and an hour-long "Photo-Verse" presentation by Mario F. Hutton, President of the local Audubon. Sunday events will include a comprehensive Field Trip of the Islands in the morning, and the presentation of awards, movies and reports in the afternoon.

ADDITIONAL PRIZES OFFERED

Here they are...the three beautiful prizes to be given away at the coming 1969 Shell Fair sponsored by the Sanibel Community Association. Shown for the first time at the initial meeting of SCA last week they now start their Island Tour November 15 beginning with the Artisan Shop on Gulf Drive. All are invited to stop by and see them.

The traditional first prize is a shell table newly designed by Howard Schriener, Jr. and executed by Charles LeBuff, Sr. It is handsomely hand-crafted of walnut with heavy plate glass top, 41 inches long by 22 inches wide and stands 18 inches high. 148 specimen shells are attractively arranged in the table, all Sanibel-Captiva shells with six species from the Florida Keys. The shells represent contributions from 32 individuals and businesses on the Islands; very much in the spirit of the early Fairs in being a real community effort.

New this year is a second and third prize. Each a perfect junonia mounted in a handsome walnut based glass dome with an engraved brass plate carrying the identifying name. For everyone who has ever shelled on Sanibel or Captiva the grand find has always been a perfect junonia so what more fitting prize could be offered than these fine specimens. Second prize is a 5 1/4 inch Scaphella junonia Shaw donated by Edie Mugridge of Glory of the Sea. Third prize is a 3 7/8 inch Scaphella johnstoneae Clench donated by Delmar Reynolds of the Reynolds Shop. Edie donated both pieces of coral for mounting these shells. These two junonias along with the butleri and keineri volutes which are in the table comprise the four species most readily found in deep waters in this area.

Any of these prizes will be a long remembered treasure for three lucky ticket holders when the drawing is held at the Fair in March. Again this year it is not necessary to be present to win and delivery is guaranteed the winner. Last year's winner, Jean McGrail, of New York, proudly sent us a picture of her table set up in her apartment. When she bought her ticket from Elsie Malone last January she never dreamed the table would be delivered in April.

Maybe this is your year to be LUCKY! Tickets will be available this week at Island Shops and Motels. Ask for yours, and some for your friends and don't forget to go by the Artisan Shop on Gulf Drive to see for yourself just how beautiful these prizes are.



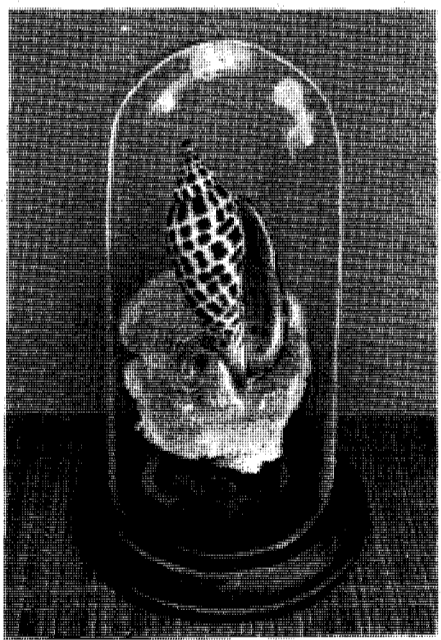
Stingley of LaBelle, one of the better known shellers in Florida. He has a very extensive library of old and new shell books and literature--probably one of the best in the country.

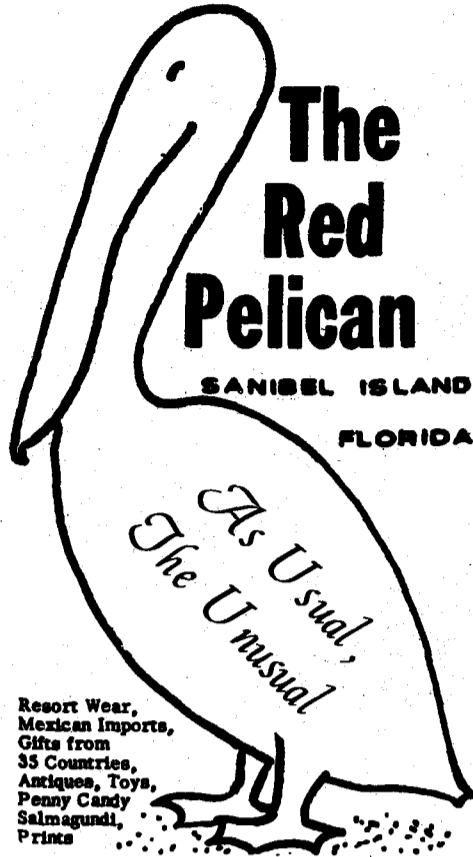


Jean McGrail, 1967-1968 winner, displays her shell table in her New York apartment.

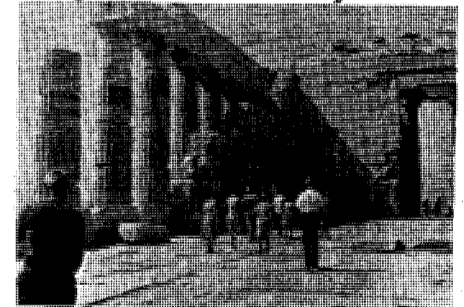
