Today (Thursday) we will be picking up the last of the color ads for our Christmas color edition, which will be published on Thursday, December 19.

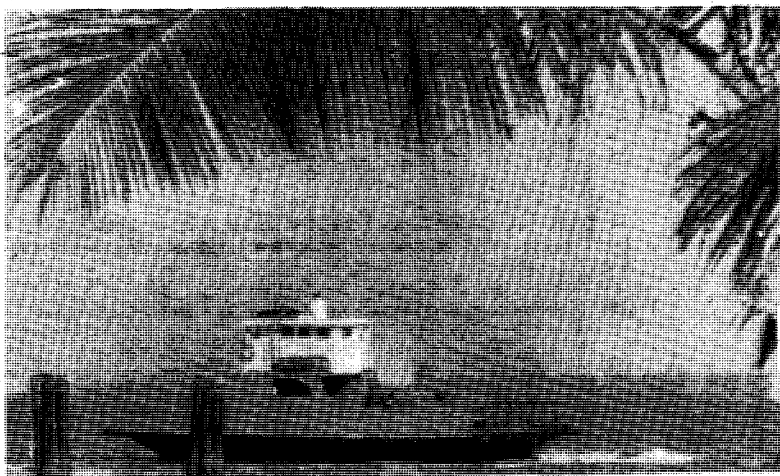
