## ANNUAL CHAMBER MEETING

The Sanibel-Captiva Chamber of Commerce held their annual meeting for all members, Monday, April 21, 1969, at the Chamber building. There were 46 members and their wives present.

The meeting was called to order by President Snook at 8 p.m. The secretary read the previous yearly meeting minutes and they were approved as read. The Treasurer gave his financial report for the year, and the budget for the coming year. Dan Moore, Treasurer was congratulated as having the best set of books and treasurer's reports that the Chamber has ever had. Bill Newman gave his report of the number of brochures he had sent out and over the counter at the Chamber office, and that there had been approximately 48,000 persons that have signed the guest book, and this does not include when there were several persons in one car. He also pointed out that very few of our old guests ever sign the book, so these should be considered newcomers.

Mr. Snook pointed out that we would appreciate any donations to help pay attorney fees for the proposed sign ordinance.

The members discussed the new booklet that is being prepared which will be sent to new advertising lists in hopes of increasing our advertising radius.

There was the election of officers, and the new Board Members are President, Jack Rushworth, Vice President, Larry Bruno, Treasurer, Dan Moore, Secretary, Mary Funk, Mark McClintock, Floyd Snook and Jerry Martin.

#### 55TH NATIONAL BE KIND TO ANIMAL WEEK

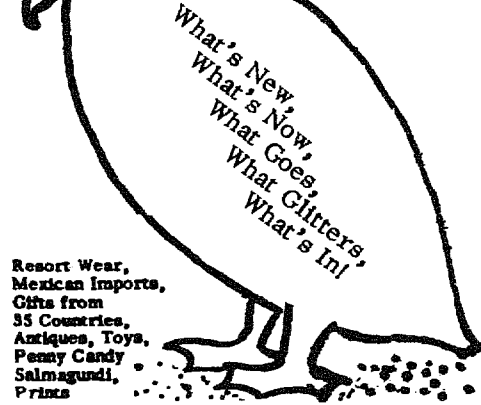
