

ZONING MEETING

On May 26th the Lee County Zoning Board recommended by a vote of 4 to 2, that Jamestown-Beachview, Inc., be granted rezoning of certain Sanibel property in approaches and environs of the Sanibel Causeway -- 22 acres for business and approximately 90 acres of high density multifamily zoning.

The County Commissioners will either approve or reject this zoning recommendation on JULY 2. All Island residents are encouraged to be present at the hearing because now is the time to voice your opinion as to how the islands should develop.






"ALL YOUR NEEDS FROM FOOD TO FILM"

Delta Air Lines, in recognizing more than 22 years of outstanding service to the airline industry, has commissioned Howard Schriner, Jr. (retired) a Delta Flying Colonel. Schriner lives on Sanibel Island, from where he is leading expeditions into remote areas of Florida, Georgia and surrounding waters. 



GOODWILL-SUNCOAST NEWS

Repair and upholstering of used furniture and the reconditioning of household appliances are major training programs for handicapped persons at Goodwill Rehabilitation Centers serving 29 West Florida counties.

Goodwill urgently needs donations of used or unwanted furniture and appliances at this time in order to sustain the training of workers in these skills. After the items are repaired, they are sold through 24 Goodwill bargain stores, providing income to pay the wages of handicapped men and women.

Goodwill operates a home pickup service for materials too large for the familiar Goodwill deposit boxes at supermarkets. This pickup service is presently available in Pinellas, Hillsborough, Manatee and Sarasota counties. Also at Tallahassee, the Ft. Myers area including Naples, Punta Gorda and Port Charlotte and in the Lakeland region including Winter Haven, Bartow, Lake Wales, Ocala, Auburndale, Plant City and Haines

Residents in these counties and cities are asked to call their local Goodwill phone number for furniture and aplliance pickup. Their generosity in donating used and unwanted items will help train handicapped persons for employment in private business.





TRAILERS MEAN "HITCHING UP" TO EXTRA DUTIES

Drivers who tow a trailer on their summer outings are "hitching up" to added responsibilities the Florida Highway Patrol said

Col. H. N. Kirkman, Director of the Department of Public Safety said, "Increasing numbers of Florida families will be taking along something extra on their summer outings. That 'some-thing' will be a trailer and the added responsibilities of driving safely while towing it."

Kirkman emphasized safety

checking taillights, brake lights and turn signals before leaving and at intervals during the trip.

A strong axle or frame mounted hitch is recommended by the Patrol chief and he reminded drivers that Florida statutes require a safety chain from the trailer to the towing vehicle to restrain the trailer if the hitch should fail.

"Remember your extra length and allow more room for turning, changing lanes and passing. Increase following distances to allow for stopping because of the added weight," said Kirkman.

Kirkman concluded by saying other drivers should remember that motorists pulling trailers have these extra responsibilities and should display a little extra courtesy toward them.




"The response to the pleas for student mowers has been excellent," Mrs. South stated. "But what we need now is more effort on the part of the property owners to get the mowing done.




