SANCTUARY EXPANDED

According to the Department of the Interior in Washington, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved a plan to enlarge the J.N. (Ding) Darling Bird Sanctuary on Sanibel Island by buying another 234 acres, making the total acreage 1,590.

While this announcement was made last weekend in Washington, as yet no official confirmation has been received on Sanibel. The purchase price of the additional acreage was not announced anywhere.

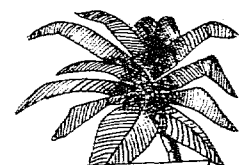

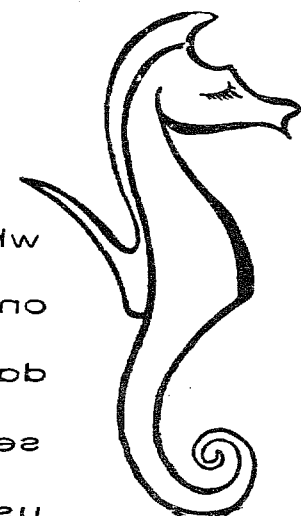



BEACH CAR DRIVING PROHIBITED

Residents and transients are reminded that a ban against car or bike driving on all Sanibel and Captiva beaches is in effect and being enforced. Only exception is in the case of U.S. Wildlife Service vehicles, that have to patrol the Gulf beaches nightly, to gather data on loggerhead turtles that at this time of year come ashore to lay their eggs in the sand, and must also be protected against poachers.

"TOO LATE TO CLASSIFY" by russell kay

It is beginning to look like our neighborhood supermarkets will eventually be replaced by gigantic area markets designed to serve several counties.

Just a few short years ago we could hardly believe our eyes when sizable shopping centers invaded our neighborhoods serving larger areas and providing one-step shopping service that just about met every shopping need imaginable.

But merchandizers now vision bigger and better marketing complexes. And such a regional merchandizing center is now being planned for the Florida Gold Coast designed to serve Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties.

City Planned Communities, one of South Florida's leading land developers, recently announced plans for the new center. It is planning a "super-regional" mall with access from Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties. The firm's chief executive officer Herbert Sadkin, has already begun negotiations with four major department stores and two specialty department stores for locations in the space-age shopping center.

Tri-County Mall has already been keyed as one of the largest to be developed in the Southeastern United States, and one that will include every up-to-date innovation ever used or planned on being used in a shopping center in this country.

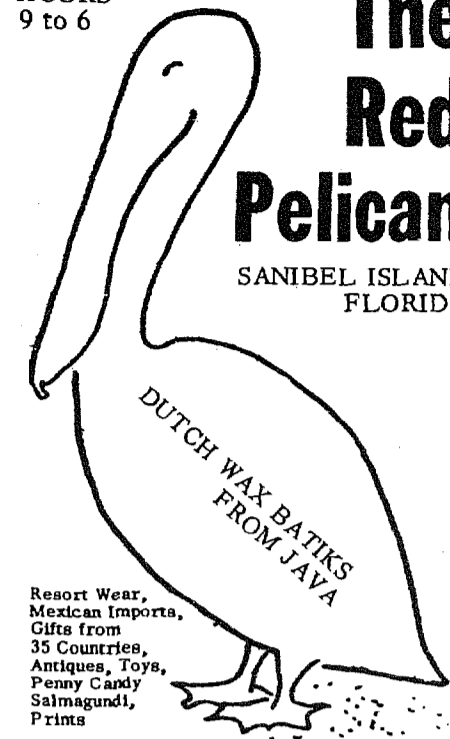
Some of these innovations stagger the imagination, such as moving sidewalks, the entire project completely air conditioned and covered, vertical construction and others still unrevealed. Everything is being planned for the comfort and convenience of the shopper. The retail area will include an enclosed mall area of over a million square feet.

The Mall location will be on Commercial Blvd., one of the main east-west intersections of Ft. Lauderdale running from the ocean westward, and on University Drive, which, when the State Road Dept. finishes its program, will run from NW 27 Ave., in Miami northward to Plantation, Lauderhill, Tamarac Lakes, Coral Springs, and Boca Raton right into and along side Florida Atlantic University in Palm Beach County. In other words, the center's location will be a direct route from Miami to the Palm Beaches.

Sadkin, who does not select shopping center locations by chance, apparently knew what he was doing when he selected the Tri-County Mall site. In the immediate area Haft-Gaines, a leading South Florida developer, recently announced a \$500 million apartment and townhouse community, and Ken Behring and Jackie Gleason also have new real estate developments ready to go directly south of the Tri-County Mall site.

One thing is certain our shopping centers of the future are destined to become bigger and better. Imaginative Floridians are leading the way.
