CAUSEWAY PROPERTY REZONED

In what may be the longest zoning resolution on record, according to Commissioner P. A. Geraci, the Lee County Commissioners accepted a five-page rezoning plan last week for the property surrounding the Sanibel causeway entrance to the Islands.

The resolution was drawn up by Steve Helgemo, who represented Jamestown-Beachview Inc., and Mike Jackson, representing Islanders who wanted to have the entrance kept as attractive as possible. The long resolution was the result of a number of earlier meetings and hearings.

The land on the right (the same side as the Chamber of Commerce building) was zoned top business, with all curb service businesses prohibited. There will be a 15 foot planting strip along the road, and each business will have its own service road leading back to the business building, which are limited to a 35 foot height and are subject to a 100 foot setback from the road. Another 15 foot planting strip will separate the back of the business property from Bailey Road, and the buildings will be subject to a 50 foot setback from the same road.

The Commissioners are to approve all plans.

The opposite side of the entrance road is zoned for multifamily residential, with similar setback, height and planting restrictions, except

that the setback from the road is 65 feet.

The bay frontage will probably be used for apartment type condominiums, and a planned 100 foot canal will probably be bordered by motels on the causeway side. The land on Periwinkle Way is zoned for R-1, single family residences.



NEW DOCTOR ON ISLANDS

For many months the Sanibel Community Association and an informal group of other residents have been attempting to attract a competent physician to undertake residence and medical service to Sanibel and Captiva.

Mordecai Haber, M.D., an unusually qualified and experienced physician, presently practicing in Fort Lauderdale, is considering permanent residence on Sanibel and undertaking medical service as a general practitioner for persons living on the islands. Dr. and Mrs. Haber have vacationed at Casa Ybel for many years, and are familiar with the islands and their communities.

Dr. Haber was graduated from Tufts University Medical School in 1933. Following graduation he served a rotating internship in medicine and surgery at Bronx Memorial Hospital in New York. From 1935 until March of 1941 he was a general practice in New York.

During the five year war period he served in the U.S. Army Medical Corps, doing mostly surgery and urological surgery.

After the war, he was a general practitioner in Elmira, New York, for a period of five years. He was an original member of the American Academy of General Practice at that time. Dr. Haber then took a three year residency at the Palo Alto Veterans Hospital, practicing medicine and psychiatry, with a two year post graduate course in clinical psychology at Stanford University. Thereafter he was staff psychiatrist, and later chief of that department, at the East Orange Veterans Hospital in New Jersey.

He has since been director of all professional services, including medicine and surgery, at South Florida State Hospital in Hollywood, Fla., a 1000 bed hospital, and has more recently practiced psychiatry in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla.


Dr. Haber is a Diplomate, certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology; a Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association; formerly Asst. Professor at the University of Miami Medical School; a





member of the American Rehabilitation Association of the Florida Medical Association and the American Medical Association.

He is licensed to practice medicine in Florida, New York, California and New Jersey. He will transfer his membership from the Broward County Medical Society to the Lee County Medical Society.

Through investigation and conversations with Dr. Haber and others, a program of procedure has been developed to facilitate acceptance of medical responsibility by Dr. Haber, and to inform persons interested in obtaining the services of a physician of the plan presently proposed. This is as follows:

Dr. Haber is considering beginning residence on Sanibel about October 15. He is considering building a residence and office, and hopes that it may be completed by that time.

Dr. Haber has had conversations with authorities at the Lee Memorial Hospital and with medical specialists in Fort Myers. These persons have assured him of their cooperation in cases where hospitalization or the services of specialists are required.

Dr. Haber would be returning to general practice after some years of specialization and administrative work. It would be necessary for him to build and equip an office suitable for general practice. As an inducement for Dr. Haber to establish medical service on the Islands it is proposed that the community subscribe to a building and equipment fund, estimated to require \$8,000.00. This means that persons who may require a resident physician are being asked to subscribe or advance funds. All subscriptions would be returned in the form of medical services.

Subscriptions of \$100 or more should be made out to "Islands Medical" and mailed to Islands Medical, P. O. Box 99, Sanibel, Florida, 33957. Checks received will be deposited in an account in the name of Islands Medical in a Fort Myers bank.

Checks drawn on the account to pay for the office and equipment will be signed by Dr. Haber and co-signed by an authorized member of the Islands Medical Committee. Checks will be drawn as equipment, etc., is received, and bills approved. If money in excess of that required is subscribed, the excess will be refunded on a pro-rata basis. If Dr. Haber does not establish medical service, the funds subscribed will be returned.

Medical services would be rendered on a check or cash basis, solely to reduce bookkeeping. Fees generally would conform with the standard practices prevailing in the medical community of Lee County.

For good order and service, Dr. Haber will schedule regular office hours according to the needs of the community, and these hours will be announced and adjusted to assure adequate coverage of community need. To minimize waiting and loss of time, appointments may be made by telephone for these regular office hours. When Dr. Haber is on the island he will be available for any sudden or unexpected services which he can reasonably cover. The Fort Myers fee schedule of \$8.00 for a normal office visit would be observed.


Emergency and house calls available when necessary. Fees begin at \$10 and would range higher depending on the time of day and the distance involved.

Fees for physical examinations would depend on the extent of the examination and the time required.

The member of this committee have had extensive conversations with Dr. Haber, and have had most excellent reports on his professional ability. We believe that Sanibel and Captiva will be very fortunate if he comes here to practice.

We urge you to support this effort, and to contribute your subscription for your own need and that of the Islands. You have nothing to lose, and much to gain.

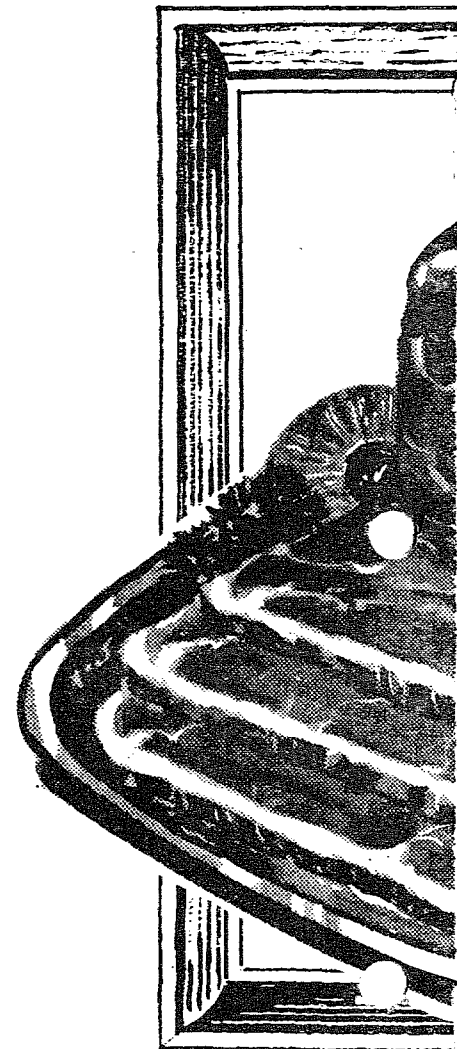

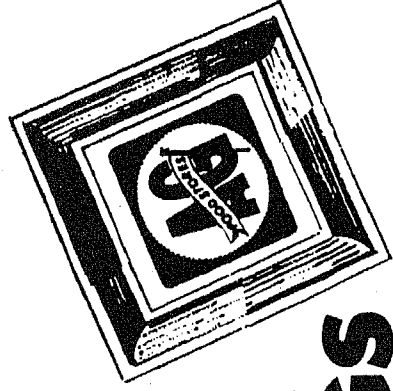

Hookworms are common in dogs and are capable of infecting human beings, quite commonly by going barefoot where dog excreta is present, i.e., the beach.

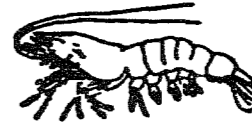

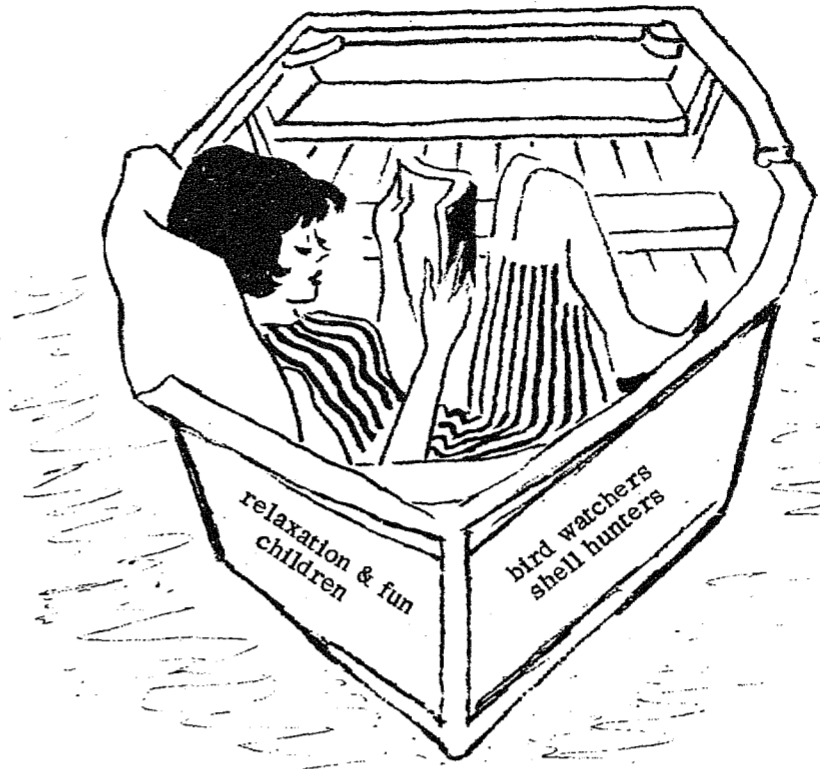
