EUG BITES AND BREATHING

Summer means cook-outs at
the shore. Picnics in grassy
parks. And plenty of pests. Bees
ants, and yellow jackets.

Insects can be a pain, liter-
ally. Their bites can cause
wheezing, nausea, dizziness,
even comas. Sometimes their
stings are fatal.

Treatment for reactions to
insect bites should be prompt.
Especially when severe reactions
develop hours after the sting.
That can spell serious trouble.

At a meeting of the American
Academy of Allergy, Dr. James
H. Barnard said that delayed re-
actions are more likely to go un-
treated. In his study of 50 fatali-
ties from insect bites, more than
half received no treatment at all.
And as many as 14 percent show-
ed no reaction to the sting until
24 hours later -- or more.

Severe reactions to insect
stings often involve the respir-
atory tract. Some obstruction
occurs, and breathing is imped-
ed. Fluids -- in excessive
amounts -- fill tissue spaces. And
blood vessels can collapse.
Severe reactions can hit people
who have been stung earlier by
the same insects with no ill
effects. But not all severe re-
actions result in death, by any
means.

If people know they are sen-
sitive to certain insects, they
should consult their doctor. Doc-
tors should be called, immedi-
ately, when severe reactions do
happen.

In some cases, doctors train
insect-sensitive patients to give
themselves injections, usually
epinephrine, in anticipation of
emergencies. In the study con-
ducted by Dr. Barnard, for ex-
ample, several persons actually
died during the long wait for an
ambulance. An immediate injec-
tion might have averted the ca-
tastrophe.
