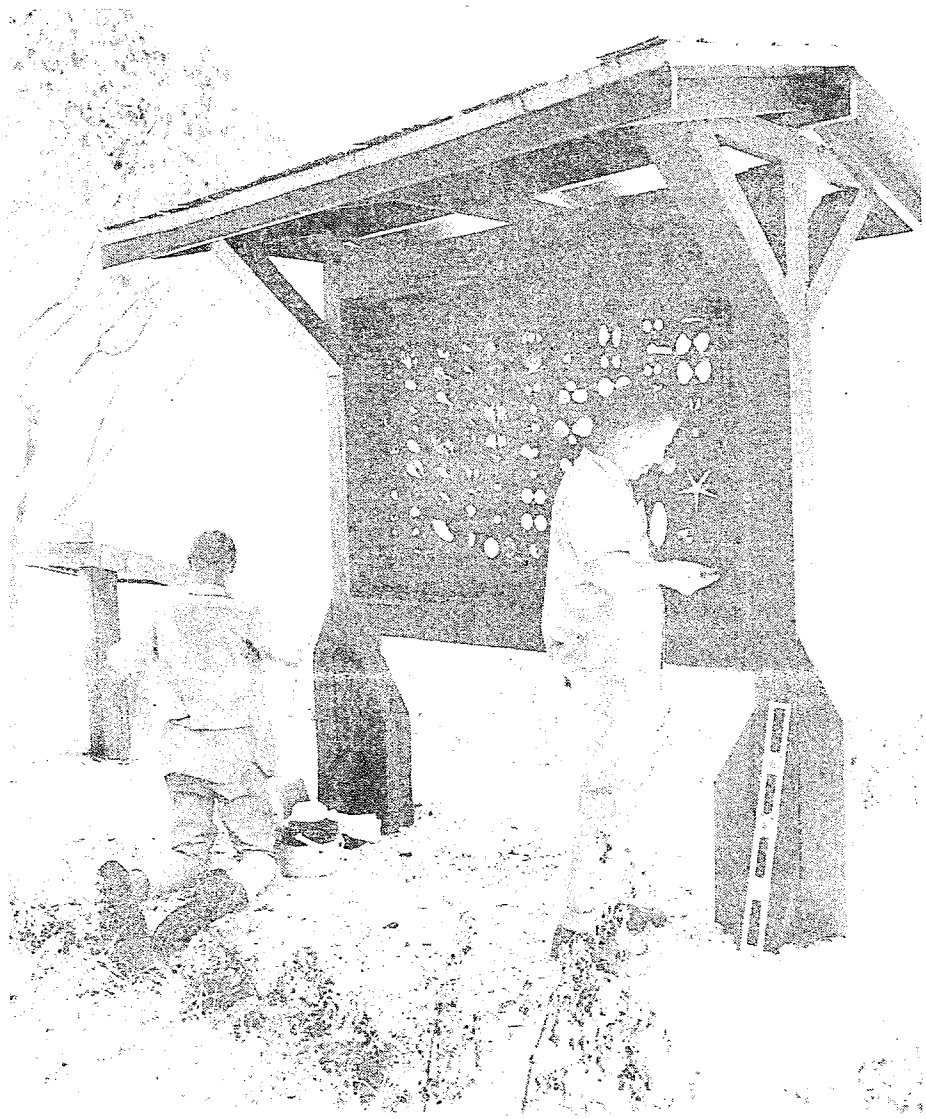


Just as many others in this area and indeed, the whole state of Florida are doing what they can for the victims of Hurricane Camille; so is Sanibel.

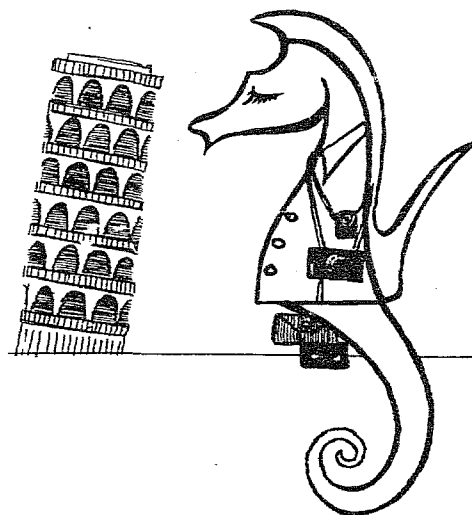

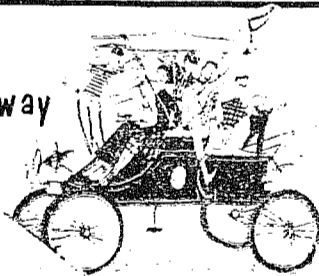

and what their name is.

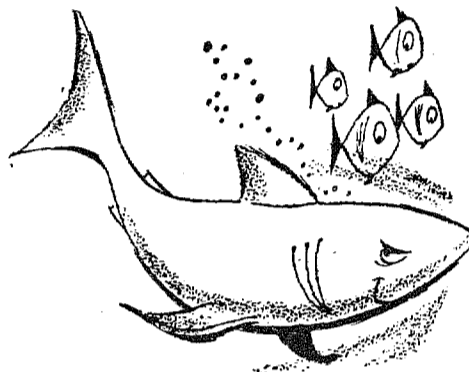
I have tried to identify them

E.J.C. FALL SESSION BEGINS

All Edison Junior College personnel were greeted by president, David G. Robinson and board chairman Travis A. Gresham, Jr. in the college auditorium last Tuesday morning to mark the beginning of the new fall session.

The guest speaker was Dr. William Graham, president of Hillsborough Junior College in Tampa, who discussed "New ideas for New Times." Dr. Graham came to the Florida junior college system in 1968 to organize the Hillsborough college, from the Junior College District

of St. Louis where he was vice president from 1964 to 1968. He was formerly president of Palo Verde College in Blythe, Calif.

Nursing Class: The second class of Associate Degree Nursing students will begin in the fall session with an enrollment of 32. The first class, which began in January of 1969, will be graduated in the spring of 1971, the culmination of many months of planning.

Speakers available: If your club program chairman needs help, the Student Government Association of EJC is ready and willing to assist by providing

speakers from their newly-formed Speakers Bureau. Mark Adams, SGA president and some of his officers created the bureau and have met with gratifying success.

Formal Convocation: It is the custom of the college to have a formal fall convocation which this year will be held on the campus green on Sept. 4 at 11 a.m. Our featured speaker will be Dr. Travis A. Gresham, Jr., chairman of the Board of Trustees. Dr. Gresham, who has served with the board and the advisory committee since the beginning of the college, has been reelected board chairman for this year. It is a special occasion for him since his son, Travis Gresham,

III, will be among the 600 entering freshmen this fall, and makes it most appropriate for the chairman to offer advice to the new students.

Early admission: A policy on early admittance to Edison Junior College was adopted by the Trustees at the July meeting. The stipulations are that the applicant must have completed the junior year of high school, must have recommendations from his high school principal and counselor. It is expected that there will be few candidates for this program due to the high selectivity but it will provide unusually-talented students with the opportunity to accelerate their college career.

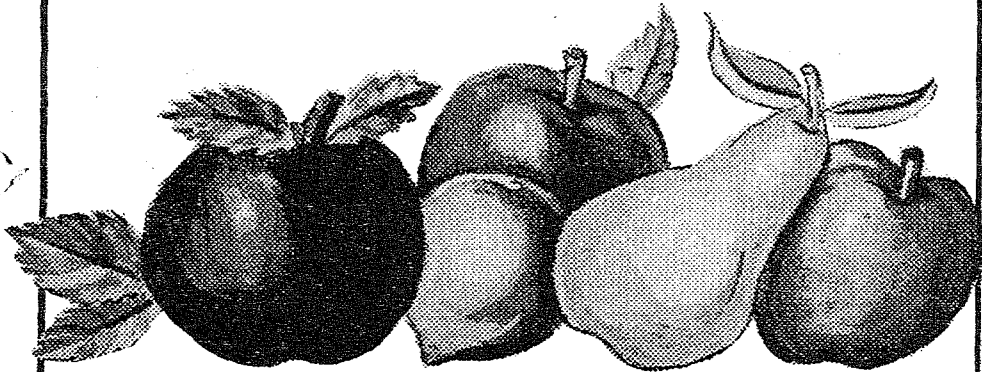

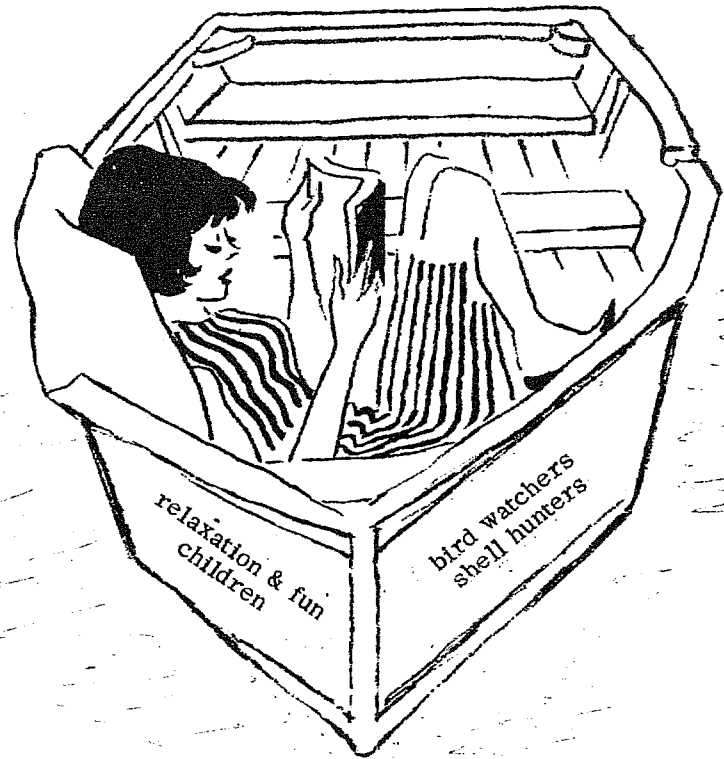

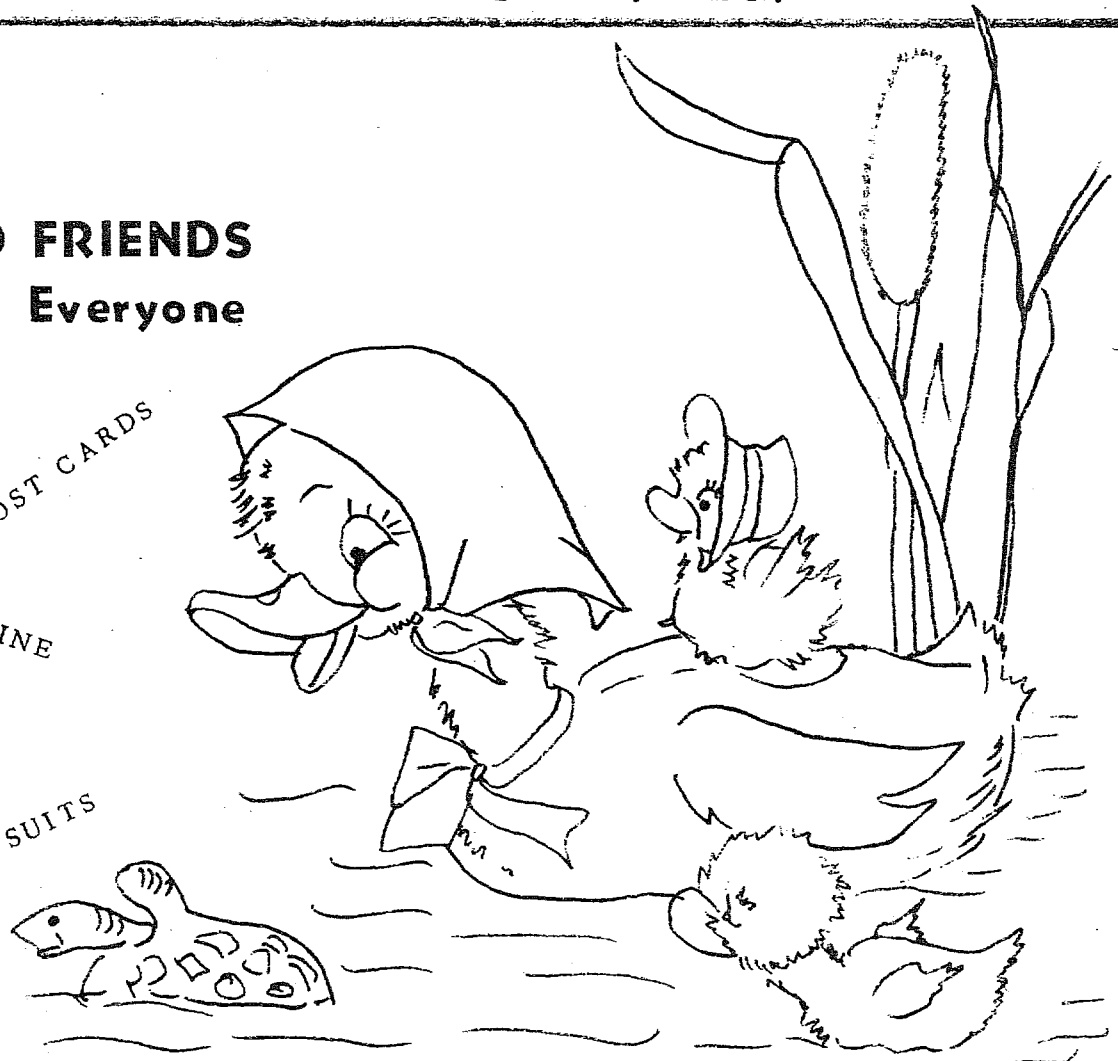
