The U. S. Coast Guard Auxiliary of Fort Myers, assisted by members of the San Carlos Bay Power Squadron, will conduct a FREE courtesy boat inspection at the Beach Marina, Fort Myers Beach, Saturday, June 29, 1974 starting at 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

This inspection coincides with "Safe Boating Week-June 30 to July 6, 1974" and all boat owners are urged to take advantage of this free inspection and receive their inspection decal. With this inspection decal pasted on your boat's windshield, the U. S. Coast Guard will know that your boat has been approved for safe boating.

The U. S. Coast Guard has the right to stop and board any boat not having the approved inspection sticker on its windshield. So, take advantage of this free inspection and be sure that your boat is safe. The life you save may be your own.

When it Rains - it Pours!

Well, lovely people, this is the week it rained ... and, in raining, knocked out the telephones, the power lines and other such minor essentials to the newspaper business.

So, without a phone, we can't really give you full reports on some of the bigger news stories ... we can just tell you that the County Commission is still dilly-dallying on the density question; the gentleman at the toll booth said the stickers were not going to be used; the County Commission is considering a plan whereby one might be able to buy 20 tickets for \$10 (although Mr. Sayers allegedly is worried that there are some people who couldn't afford that ... couldn't confirm, no phones, hmmm); after listening to and reading reports of what's to be done with the causeway monies, we can't make head or tail of it at all; the County Commission also made motions and noises about the Island Water Association having broken its franchise, what with calling the hookup moratorium; the WATER Assoc. wouldn't make a statement because it was now a "legal matter" and besides which, we could only talk to one board member before the phones went out (we did gather, extremely UNofficially, that the County Commission might have a bit of trouble taking over a \$3,000,000 working plant, what with their rather apparent lack of funds); the Children's Center did open (oh yes, we had that last week); and the last report we had from

Captiva was that the road was out again. That last we were also unable to confirm.

Now, we CAN tell you about the rain. It started around 12:30 a.m. Monday and was still raining and blowing Tuesday afternoon. It was caused by two low pressure systems joining over Florida, egged on by a high (which kept the low stationary) over the Carolinas, and everyone was looking apprehensively over their shoulders at a tropical depression in the southwest Gulf near southern Mexico. It rained all day and night Monday (the weather bureau, according to our transistor radio, forecast a 60 per cent chance of rain Monday, and 30 per cent Tuesday and 20 per cent for Wednesday.) It was, as we think we said before, still raining steadily Tuesday afternoon. What's happening tomorrow, nobody knows. Various and sundry wind gages reported five or six 60 mph wind gusts, and while we don't know how much rain has fallen officially, we do know that it's quite enough. A few signs are down, palm fronds and sea grapes are down, and the water is ALL over the place. (We were only able to leave our home at low tide on Tuesday.)

Next week, we assume, there will be mosquitoes, since we're sure there will be all sorts of flooded marshes that have been dry for years.

And maybe we'll at least be able to phone someone, somewhere, again. Ciow.

SANIBEL POWER CUT

Residents in several areas on Sanibel reported a power failure from late Wednesday afternoon to 3 a.m. Thursday of last week.

A dispatcher for the Lee County Electric Co-operative Inc., said loss of power was due to lightning during a thunderstorm.

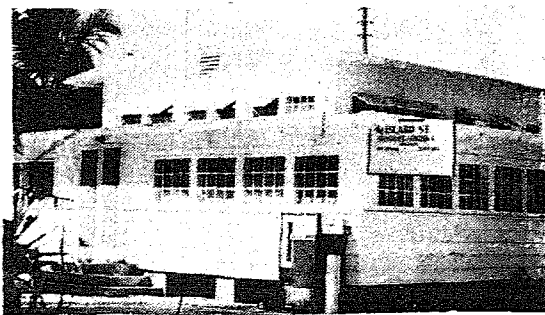

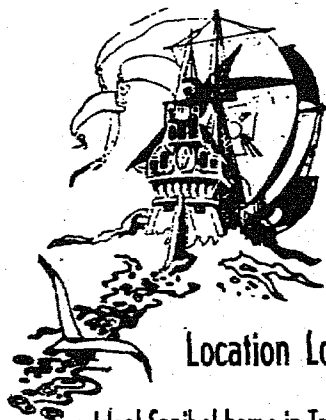

THIS WEEK AT THE SANIBEL LIBRARY by Hal Harrison

One of the Sanibel Library's great benefactors is the Rev. James Hubbs, and one of the fine things about his gifts is that he gives us new and outstanding books. Not long ago he gave us "The Kappilian of Malta," and now he has donated "The Oath" by Elie Wiesel. This is a story of two places in two points in time: Koevillag in Eastern Europe in the 1920's, and a modern metropolis in the 1970s. It is about Jews and their enemies, friendship and hate, bigotry and WAR, TESTIMONY AND SILENCE. And above all --- silence. The author is a survivor of two Nazi concentration camps who is well known for earlier novels dealing with holocaust.

The story of high drama that almost caused the downfall of a government is alarmingly relevant in "Prisoners of Honor, the Dreyfuss Affair" by David L. Lewis. It tells how high government officials, eager to enhance their own political ambitions, framed Alfred Dreyfuss as a traitor, and, in so doing, raised anti-Semitism to a national passion. They then offered "national security" as their reason for covering up the crime they had committed.

Helen Bevington, professor of English at Duke University, has written "Beautiful Lofly People," a collection of light and lively essays and verse about all sorts of people. It is a kind of inside story of present and past greats - things and quirks about them that will surprise and amuse you.

The story of seabirds, most dramatic of all winged creatures, is told in text and pictures in "The Sea Has Wings." The author is Franklin Russell, who also wrote "The Secret Islands" and "Watchers at the Pond." The photographer is Les Line, editor of Audubon Magazine, who contributes 100 pictures of seabirds along the northeastern coast of North America.

Another great picture book, this one in color, is "Wild River" with both text and photographs by Laurence Pringle. The book describes the scores of clear-running rivers and streams that flow through the American wilderness --- their beginnings, their journey to the sea, their effects on the countryside, and life in and near their flowing waters. I have not read the text yet, but I find the 67 color photographs breath-taking.

Sanibel folks with all their bikes should find "Anybody's Bike Book" by Tom Cuthbertson a blessing. Here is an original manual of bicycle repairs. The author claims that with this book, anybody, including YOU, can restore, repair and maintain anything from a unicycle to an exotic racing bicycle or tandem 4-seater --- and you can do it without sweat or swearing. The moral here is: "If you can ride it, you can fix it."

Another that should hit home on Sanibel: "No Island Is an Island, the Ordeal of Martha's Vineyard" by Anne W. Simon. This book pinpoints the conflict on Martha's Vineyard Island in Massachusetts where the lifestyle of centuries has changed within a decade. Despite concerted opposition, developers continue to carve up the island and time is running out --- not only on Martha's Vineyard, but for all of us. It poses a pressing question facing Sanibel too --- what shall we make of our land? This one lands in our own backyard.

Sheila Burnford, author of "The Incredible Journey" now brings us "One Woman's Arctic," a record of two idyllic summers spent close to the North Pole in an Eskimo community. It is also a sympathetic study of the Eskimos themselves.

Postscript: We try to neglect no one. Are you a coin collector? We now have "Standard Catalog of World Coins." It is the 1974 edition and includes coins of 273 countries with 17,000 photographs and over 35,000 coins listed by date. The book has 864 pages.
