# Council seeks new definition of live shell

A new definition of "live shell" will be in

\*Under the current ordinance, based on a five-year-old city, resolution, "all living incillusts and echinderms occurring in salt, water," excluding oysters, claims and whelks" are live abelis.





What if I were in the throes of a heart attack.

The 20 cent postage stamp is now so minute that it fails to cover the designated space. Utilities and charge card companies, exhort me to write a multi-digit account number on both my check and the envelope. I can't open anything that has been shrink wrapped or encased in plyofilm armor without the aid of a saw, and things that are supposed to be torn open along some dumb dotted line are invariably shredded beyond recognition in the

I always seem to be behind some terory who likes to chitty chat with the man at the Causeway toll booth, and welcome deposits at its infernal drive in machines. Withdrawels pose no problem; they plop down where I can teach them. But flimpy deposit alips go herserk in a vacuum and are frequently stuck (and inaccessible) at the top of the mechanical crawer. This sentiments were discussed by Dr. Bill Webb at the Sanibel-Captiva Convervation Foundation last week and gave an attentive audience food for some positive, constructive thought

Our greatest environmental problem today is too many people, and Southwest Floridians are in a perfect position to view the results of man's own proliferation. And because our region is a vacationland for hundreds of thousands of out of state visitors each winter, w residents also have a perfect opportunity to do something constructive toward encouraging conpervation of our precious environment

Given that man lives by example, it follows that every Florida visitor will learn from the precedents set before him. New Sanibel residents, for example, might balk at having to build their homes around vegetation;

But if they truly moved to Sanibel for the printing qualines the Island offers, these newcomers won't be bothered by our standards for long

Because the homeo we build replace native vegetation that once served as home and feeding grounds for hundreds of wildlife, we should be obliged to plant further with hopes of inducing many of those aninuals to return.

Conservation problems are everywhere, far away and close at hand. They are slways complex, and the solutions are mighty expensive. So why not keep our own little corner of the world "tidy?"

Better for this to be accomplished voluntarily as folks are finding out too late in Cape Coral, where the est ordinance requires landowners to compensate for damage already done to the land by mandating at least two mature trees on every Cape Coral lot.

Get involved in positive conservation. It's not too late for Sanibel and Captiva.





The Jewel box is a most curious beautifully marked well that ake so many other collectable shells i as in a very common amily of shells We are talking shout the Florida spin, lewel hox

although there are some four or five others found in North

There is some speculation as to where the jewel but con es from So ne say it a part of the cycler fam ly of shells while others say it a a distant cousir of the sael of group Fither way tax fine addition to any collection of whe is found on Sanibel and Captive Islands

The jewel hou is a round ship his to tra coinced shell it

might was in the size of a golf sail in a particularly arge adult. There is one do linet feature that fee shells have however. The yewel box has a set of spines. They are not dangerous to the four, but have nowned a to sund out a quarter to half an inch from the base of the shell. These particularly in the four in the base of the shell. These spines come in irregular rows. There might be from five

to seven rows of agines

Some of the most ornate of these shells are the Atlan to thorny cysters, which can reach a length of five inches or so and have spines two or three inches long! Shell experts say these are scallop relatives but they look quite gaudy

and are nothing like any scallop I we ever seen
That giant of a shed is supposed to be found around
these parts of Florida but I we never heard of any so far however find quite a few Jewel hoxes on the

You will see halves of these hi alves around the high water lines but you really want to find that perfect pair of sides that make up a jewel hox

This shell a hinge system is weak and often breaks as it is washed upon the heaches. One heach where I sometimes fird jewel hoxes part cularly after a strong westerly winter storm is on the southern tip of Cayo Costa
Islar d

They aren't all that rure in singles but to find a complete jewel hox might take some looking I ve never found a Lve jewel hox. They live in relatively shallow waters of the Gult of Mexico and are often attached to rocks

# Island landscaper makes noble attempt to rescue historic Gumbo Limbo

illusirsted by Ann Whiterkoham
Acting on a, the local landscape
authority Henry Nachtsheim moved
quickly a few weeks ago in an endeaver to
save a hinge legendary Gunbo Limbo.
The great landnark was being put to
death by chainsaw on West Gulf Drive.
The big tree had been transplanted once,

The ng tree sac oven transpanted once, without a city vegetation permit, and was upmoted a second time and butchered, the dying corpse left lying by the roadside awaiting transport to a distant "landfill" (current euphemistic bureaucratese for a plain old dump).

plain old dump).

Don Manchester, who developed Gulf
Ridge West in line with rigid standards of
native vegetation, preservation, was
contacted and quickly agreed to try to find a home for the dying giant. The tree trunk, incidentally, was considerably more than three feet in diameter.

Manchester and the manager of the

Manchester and the manager of the West Gulf Drive site paid for the moving. Nachtcheim donated his company's services for replanting and subsequent care, Bill - Moore, 'a' builder in southwest Fierida for mere than 25 years and a man who vigorously supports the native plant preservation ethic, suggested a Gulf Ridge in the control of the control of

preservation ebic, suggested a Guil Ridge East althy-and there the badly out up trush was replanted after the expenditure of nuch excrys and a goodly sum of money. Nachtsheim and all the others involved hope, the tiffs of the foreit giant will be awed even though it lay with its roots exposed for days while large branches and bearly, half of its trush, were amputated.

Nachtaheim says you might say the tree is in intensive care with a 50-50 chance to

It stands today with great dignity, newly planted, bare and butchered, starkly beautiful. If it lives, the residents of Gulf Ridge East will be the beneficiaries as will all of Sanibel's citizens.

It is pleasing to note that Sanibel still has people who really care about our trees and other important native plants. We sincerely hope that Nachtsheim and the other participants will have been successful in awing this magnificent specimen. Our hope is that it will live and once again be restored to its former majestic size and

beauty.

Ceruinly it is laudable that so many main cooperated in the rescue of this tree that was in extremis. But the question that troubles this writer is WISY did it ever

troubles this writer is WHY, did it ever happen in the first place?!

Alice Kyllo managed the Sandyler for a couple of years in 1989 and 1970 when the property was owned by Barkley, and Eleanor Reed. At that time the tree was already huge. The Reeds had known and loved it since the early 1850's.

When I wis a Palm Beach County high

school student in the late 1930's I visited school student in the late 1930's I visited Sanibel many times while on a study project sponsored by the New York Zeological Society and Mary Roberts Rinehart: Little human alteration had occurred here at that time. Even that long ago this great Gumbo Limbo was we long the road to becoming a sizable andmark on the beach dune ridge. When Barkley Reed died, Eleanor Reed

was triged to sell, which she did reluc-tandly and with concern that this great landmark, the playground of literally generations of youngaters, might suffer. She recently wrote, as did one of her relatives, asking after the well being of his most loved of troes. Now Eleanor Reed and her family will this most loved





# Think positive for conservation efforts

The novel concept of positive conservation was discussed by ecologist,
conservationist and forester Dr. William Weth at last week's Tresday at the Center program at the Sanihel-Captive Con Servation Foundation

For many years Webh was on the faculty of the state of New York College of Environmental Science and Forestry Syracuse. He has lived on Sanihel for the test seven years and is currently obsirman of the city's Vegetation Committee and of the SCCF Environmental Affairs

In his talk Webb emphasized that an abundance of conservation effort and writing is more negative than positive. He cited Ruchel Carson's Silent Spring, which was first published in 1962 -

revolutionary impetus filent Spring gave to the budding environmental movement and called the work a "catalyst" whose time had come. Fartier works such as

Fairfield Outnome's the Plundered Planet. which was published more than a decade before Silent Spring, were published in an era not conducive Tomarimum impact and are largely forgotten today.

Both Silent opelag and Our Plandered

Planet are examples of negative con-servation literature, Webh used the writings to introduce his subject. Instead of "Thou shalt not," his theme is "Can do - what can you do (or conservation?

After directing his sudience's thinking to the positive side. Webb proceeded to cite a number of interesting examples of what one person can do la promote con-

He related an experience that happened while he was SCCF chairman and was interested in providing bird bouses for cavity nesters. He called at the home of 8 Sanibel woman and gaid, "I have come to deliver your hird house." Surprised, the woman told Wehlr she had not ordered a

Webh agreed and then described the

loundation's hird house program, to which the woman replied, "Yes, I know, I am a foundation member,"

Webb, however, disagreed, "I checked, and you are not currently on the mem-hership ruster," he told her. He then hership roster," he told her. He then membership - life, \$1,000: sustaining, \$50; family, etc., and was interrupted at "life," whereupon the woman wrote a check for \$1,000. What a triumph for positive thinking and positive

strategy have not yet been as fruitful, be knowledged. But Wehh keeps on trying -in a positive way.

He suggested other positive approache to conservation. Select a species that needs help, i.e., "Bird" wested a deprey effort or Web's own harn owl project. Whatever the species, provide nesting sites for it, urge that prucetive legal measures he taken, plant proper vegetation to promote habitat restoration. planting appropriate vegetation

Furnish perching sites, A good materia to use for perches is the dried in stark perch is attractive to hawks and many other birds. The old atem is cut from the dving made (Agave rosette always or almost always die after inflorescing so no vegetation is sacrificed in this procedure) and planted in a nost hole

These perching sites will stand for several yeards and become a landmark resting site for many birds. A favorite hawk might become accustomed to such a site. If the area below the perch is restored habitat that is attractive to litards and mon red shouldered hawk than the provision of natural food will be assured and you can be confident that you are getting a grasp on positive conservation Letter writing in support of sound issue

He and his colleagues on the conmittee worked long and diligently and came up with a volume of what were considered good regulations that had the desired impact and enabled proper and inistration of the act

Enter the Reagan administration and Interior Secretary James Watt and the current philosophy of more permissive government, Watt, with his well publicized

portance hecause Armagedion might be just ever the bill, proceeded to emasculate the regulations so carefully developed by

Immediately more than 2,500 letters were sont to the administration. This was noten organized letter writing campaign but was a matter of 2,500 individuals protesting the relaxation of the act's ad-

niciatration.
Only 18 letters supported the changes. Realizing there was a problem, the adoriginal concepts were restored. So letter writing does have impact and can effect changes for the good - positive con-If your taste is different you might seek

other positive efforts -- more menial ones Webb avers that he has taken grea ction in picking up rubbish from the Islands' beaches. He walks certain segments of the Sanibel beaches and gathers cans, bottles, plastic junk, fish line and all manner of ahandoned detritus of

human origin. He is testing a theory that people pitch out tubbish more frequently on areas already "ared trushed"

He feels that there is a "what the beck" ittitude toward trashy places - that a little more won't hurt, so when it doubt nitch it out. But if the beach is clean of trash a certain reticence might be evident and littering might be aloued down. When the final results of this study are in I hope Webb shares them with us.

Webb ended his discussion by citing the





# Ponderous manatees begin winter migration

It a that time of year again.
