You will see several kinds of fish washed upon the beaches after a red tide starts. This causes a stench that is highly irritable to some beach walkers. There is a peculiar formation inside the catifsh a skull. After the fish is dead and the skull is bleached by the sun and picked (le in b) sea b rits collectors can find this unusual shape we call a crucifix it looks like a man on a cross

As you can guess collectors call it a crucifix shell to even though it comes from the head of a catfish

You usually stort to see them a week or so after the stort of a red tide because it takes that long for the fish that have gied to decompose and wash

If you do find one I suggest you give it a blench both for a few hours to brighten it and to take care of About three years ago this winter we had an in
