Council repeals 'noxious' melaleuca designation

By Rarbara Brundage
in n surprise move Tuesday the City Council
called a truce in its war to eradicate melaieuca trees

from the Island in five years.

By a 3-2 vote the council backed off from its previous strong position and agreed to repeal a resolution designating melaleuca quinquenervia a "noxious" plant the resolution was adopted last

July.
Councilmen Mike Klein and Louise Johnson cast the dissenting votes Tuesday.

The action came during a discussion of the wor-

ding of a petition submitted by five Sambel voters that asked the council to consider adopting an or-dinance removing the norious label from

rrielaieuen.
Trat label makes the fast growing trees a target
for inandatory eradication under an existing ordinance that regulates dangerous buildings and
hazardous lands on the Sauliot. The ordinance

prohibits the planting of and requires removal of all plants designated as noxloss. In nutl-November the council acknowledged the public outery from melaleuca lovers who apposed the city's plan to cradicate the tree. The plan gave latanders five years in which to voluntarily allow city crews to remove the trees at no cost to the

city crews to remove the trees at no cost to the property owners. By 1988, however, removal would be mardatory. In the face of a petition signed by 272 residents, however, the council reaffirmed its resolve to cradicate the trees considered by some experts as extremely distrimental to native vegetation and a

extremely destributed to have vegetation and a threat to public health and safety.

On Dec. 20 the petitioners filed an affudavit an-nouncing their intention to circulate an initiative petition to force the council to put an ordinance repealing the noxious pixel tabel to a referendum of

Sanibel voters.

But Tuesday's council decison makes this action

mood The simplest way to settle the question is to repeal the resolution now, Councilman Bill Hagerup suggested. The move will have no effect on the city's program for voluntary removal of melaleuces, he solid, and the council can address the issue of mandatory removal "after we have a little history

under our bett."

Johnson called the action a change in the direction of the eradication plan that "implies a bowing down to pressure and special interest groups."

Klein agreed that the council should "bite the builet and let the controsty takes its course."

But the other three councilmen prevailed in the

view that it was a good idea to wait and see how the voluntary program works.

The council voted 3-2 to direct City Attorney David

The council voted 3-2 to direct city Attories David La Croix to prepare a resolution repealing the noxious resolution. That resolution will be ready for council action at the Jan. 17 council meeting.





About 90 years ago there was a fine papaya industry in Florida, and large football-size papayas were available in many food shops. Today, local pruduction is rare except when undertaken by caring home-owners or skilled horiculturists.

One friend wraps the growing fruit to cotton muslin to prevent bird damage and parasitizing by insects. Another ties paper bags around each fruit. Recently, at Englewood, we saw some fine fruits that dan't seem to have any protection at all. Perhaps it was a resistant strain?

The osprey tripod was designed by Al Lloyd and funded through the Sanibel-Capilva Conservation Foundation.

This shell, incidentally, is in the same family with the helmet shell that collectors of larger specimens

Pars, Redital Plan or Captive Pass are greater.
