These waren't kids from Larchmont, N.Y. These were the kids of South Brows and Harlem. What a wonderful,

generous gesture theirs was.

Then along came "We are the World," a huge success, Lots of rock stars got into the act and made many millions of dollars for aid to the starving people of the

and to the starving people of the Sahel countries And finally, on July 13 this year the greatest TV extravaganza in history, "Live Aid," took place nistry, Live Aid, took place, of Synchronized rock concerts were, broadcast from Wembley Stadium in England and from Philadelphia. Images were bounced off five com

Images were bounced off five com-munications satellites. This program, by lest estimate, was seen by 14 billion people. One group performed early at Wembley and then get aboard the Concorde, shot across the Alianite and wound up the same concert the same day in Tabilidatable. Philadelphia.
While this remarkable concert cost about \$4

while this remarkable discrete cost about 37 million to produce, it netted somewhere around \$70 million for hunger relief. All of this will be used to feed the starving people along that band of sub-Saharan African countries known as the Sahet. Saharan African countries known as the Sahet. Mit-chell's attitude today is upbeat and hopeful, and rather than shew only the hopeless famine and rather than snew only the hoperess tamine and doubt scenes that became so familiar during the first half of this year, he speaks of action to alleviate the problem by feeding and saving the hungry children.

But .:: and there is, perhaps, a substantial "but." Until this point in this discussion we have hardly mentlened Ethiopia. We have simply referred to the Sahel, that second tier of sub-Saharan countries which stretches from the Indian Ocean to the Atlantic and includes Ethiopia, Sudan, Chad, Niger, Somalia, Mail, Mauritania and others. Some autherities do not include the Horn of African countries. Somalia and Ethiopia, in the

Some authorises, Somalia and Ethiopia, in the Sahei, but for our purposes we do.

Although some 20 countries are involved and a total of some 35 million people face famine, Ethiopia is the worst. As everyone is by now aware. Ethiopia has a communist government, a client of the Kremlin, that is uncooperative and

heartless in its attitudes heartless in its attitudes toward the starving Ethiopian peo-ple. Instead of meving grain from the docks to the starving areas by employing the limited inadequate transport available, the govern-front moves people from their home areas to areas where they bome areas to areas where they are strangers. Meanwhile, grain abipments rot on the docks. Food, when it is distributed, is done so in accordance with the recipients politics rather than their hunger. All this heartless, inhumane political activity has caused many hundreds of thousands of Ethio-

bundeeds of thousands of Ethio-plans to migrate westward into the Sudan, taking their overwhelming problems to another. Schol nation stready over-stressed with its own-bunger and starvation problems. Recently the only rallroad in the Sudan, an ancient single track road built by the British in 1906, a road that could have moved grain to feed hungry millions, washed: a away at nine sites. in Ethiopia wie grain finat is distributed of hungry people goes largely to the Communist par-ty supporters of dictator Mengistu's government. Mengistu uses starvation as a political weapon. This menstrous Kremlin client seeks to profit trom western jamine relief efforts. Mengistu actually. charges western relief agencies huge taxes and handling fees; which for each ton of grain add up to more than 175 U.S. dollars. Even as the govern ment profits in this barbaric way, the grain still does not inove and the government does not pro-vide the transport that is supposedly guaranteed by payment of these huge sums.
"Live Aid" has recognized some of these

political and distribution problems and has provided to trucks and 60 trailers to move grain. But this too, might prove futile if the roads are rendered impassable by excess rain. Air drops might be the answer even though they are very costly. But they get the grain to the people who



The lon parature of an average lake in Michigan rarely rises above 65- 0 degrees. Outboards run cooler in these waters and everyone knows heat is a big factor in eventual engine failure

But look at the water we run boats in down here First it is sailwater And second the water often reaches 88 degrees or even higher

There are no north or south engines they are all set up to run on cold water. So our southern engines are trying to cool themselves on warm water filled with salt.

And third our waters contain silt and suspended sand Taking that warm, sand filed water it to an eng ne to water cool it is I ke having a sand blaster at work on the inside of the outboard. When you think of it it s a wonder the engines last as long as

Some inboard engine users claim that putting a freshwater hose into the cooling system once they return to the dock will flush out the salt. But the founder of the well known Shamrock boat, manufacturing firm in Cape Coral told me vace he

Can you heat the sait corrosion problem? Pro bably not at this time. Engines are getting much better interior parts that resist salt heat and sand but a hard worked engine has a short life span

One thing you can do is religiously spray under the outboard cover with CRC or WD-40 spray oils These keep exterior saltwates rusting down a great deal Remember to check and change the lower un t oil often -- it keeps the gears running smooth v and lets you or your mechanic check for saltwater leakage into the unit. Once I hit an underwater rock broke open the lower unit hous ing and ran the engli e for the next whole day on straight seawater instead of oil. Then the lower unit gave up the ghost

No long ago a youngster ran up to me as we walked the beach took ng for shells. He had what h thought was a rare find - a right handed

That probably deen t sound too exciting to you but it e odds of finding a right-handed lightning whele are about 10 000 to I against you. The trouble was that this voung lad had found a right handed whelk all right - but it was a pear whelk

and all pear wheiks are right handed

There are several members of the whelk family in our local waters and each is a prized find if the

color is still vivid and the shell is no damaged The pear whelk often is confused with another shell called the paper fig. These shells have a similar howeish color and both stand about four inches tall at maturity But they come from dif

ferent families of sheals.
The paper fig is one of my favorite shells it is the only shell I can think of that has a crisscrossed pattern on its exterior. As the name would imply it has very thin walls and can be castly crushed in your hand

Paper figs we sand dwellers that work the san dy bars along the beaches. Only rarely have I seen living pear fig on the inside flats of Pine Laland

I believe one of the most interesting aspects of the pear v helk is its dire, which consists mainly of sea urchina and sand dollars

Only a few shears are predators of these two echanoderms. With so many sand collars and urchans around the Islands, you would think there cuths around the gaines you would think there would also be lots of paper figs—but finding perfect figs is still no casy task And there is another shell that feeds on dollars

and urchins. The Scotch bonnet, a very prized col-lector shell turns up occasionally along the Leaches.

The pear whelk has a more sturdy shell and is primarily a sand or mud bar dweller These pretty plantar y a said or most our vertice. These pretty shells are light tan or even yellow on the outside. But the pear whell the young rian mentioned above had found was special. It was alive and was ealing a small prickly cockle abell Even when the boy picked it up the whelk held tightly to the
