Ask the many urban transit authorities that have

raised their price per rule only to see their parce per ride only to see their patronage—and total revenue— drop Better yet ask the public who have been using the bridge A quick survey should reveal what they p an to do if the county s proposal is

#### Sanibel will not take part in impact fee program

The City Council has decided not to participate in Lee County's program to impose impact fees on all new construction to bely pay for roads and parks seeded to service the increased growth

To officially opt out the council on Sept. 3 will adop, an ordinarie prohibiling the imposition or collection of impact fees within the city of Sanibal by

any city or county agency
At the first reading of the ordinance last Tuesday City Attorney David Le Croxx emphasized that this action will not preciude the city a imposing its own mpact fees anytime in the future

The county's impact fee would add about \$1 000 to the cost of construction of a home in Sambel The council could not find any benefit to the city from improvements to roads and parks that are to be

#### New designation will reduce garbage rates for condos

Final adoption last Tuesday of ou ordinance redefining commercial and residential for the purpose of setting equitable rates for mandatory gargbage collection won kudos from Mike Zakarian representative of the Cordominium Associations

#### Christmas lights ordinance discussion continued

# Mosquito control update

George Campbell mirated by Ann Winterbothum (totatused by Ann Wuterbotham Recently we were welcomed at the bead-quarters of Lee County Mosquito Control by the organization's director, Wayne Miller, Our pur-pose in visiting was to learn of research progress. Sure enough, we instodiately lacked out. Miller had paced the departure of a distinguished. since and paret in elegators of a distinguished visitor to enable us to meet fir-Toel Margalit, an entomologist and director of Ben-Gurion University of the Negev's Center for Biological Control. This Israeli scientis, discovered and initially developed. Bacillus thuringeniensis. Israeleasis (Bti for short), a bacterium found in soil samples in mosquito breeding habitat in Israel. But today is registered by our government and many others as an accepted, successful biological mosquito rol agent,

Margalit, who made the discovery in 1977, is to mosquito control what Fleming is to antibiotics. We enjoyed a pleasant conversation with this skilled scientist. We told him of our work in South skined scientist, we not turn of our work in South America with Brazilian pepper, Though not a botanist, Margalit promised to seek out data on the species' status in the Middle East and share

the species status in the middle cast and share information with us.

Brazilian pepper is a pan-tropical problem nowadays, and its introduction to some three dozen countries in the forrid zone is of much significance.

We later met with and discussed the work of several of the scientific members of Miller's stall. Among them was Dr. Ben Hertlein, who is involved with bacterial most of Spatral and whose work will be discussed in 1935 series at a

A lot is going on in the world of mosquito control around here. We shall attempt to summarize it

Mosquito control here in Lee County is still largely chemically orientated. Larviciding is ac-complished by means of Abate distributed from

Abate is an organophosphate larvicide that, even though it is a cholinesterase (i.e. nerve ac-tion) inhibitor, is believed less harmful to the ennent than malathion and Baytex (fenthion). These last two are adulticides fogged from the ancient DC3s:

cient DGS.

Ten years ago in Lee County, by this time of year DC3 fogging of either Baytex or malathion would have taken place a half dozen times by now. This year fixed wing aircraft have fogged

only twice, on Aug. 4 and again Aug. 10.

The first application was of Baytex. The target species were saltmarsh mosquitos, Aedes teeniorhynchus, a form that is usually a major nuisance (not a health concern) around these


parts.

The second application was of malathion. The switch in toxic substances was made because of a large and unusually early brood of another meaquite, Cute. nigripalpies. This one can be of significance as a vector of St. Louis Encephalitis.

Lee County Mosquito Control District does a good job in monitoring for SLE. James Burgers is in charge. He has a dozen or so sentinels around the county, one of which is here on Sanibel in the the county, one or which is here on saming in the Wulfert area. Sentinels are chickens that are ex-posed to mosquitoes and bitten by many kinds there are two dozen kinds of mosquitos on Sambel, twice those in the rest of the county). Blood is drawn from the birds and processed to reveal if the SLE virus is present. Only roosters are employed because the varying cyclical hor-monal condition of females can mask the results.

Until a couple of years ago Lee County had to end blood samples to the state's Epidemiology Research Center in Tamps to be studied. Trouble was, it took far too long to get results — always at least a week, sometimes longer — and then the

Birds other than chickens also are in the SLE picture. In Texas the house sparrow is important. Here there are so many migrants that checking avian species is difficult. Blood from 49 avian species — ranging from hummingbirds to great herons — has shown SLE antibodies.

A few years ago researchers turned to mam-mals to ascertain their involvement in the SLE picture. They found a number of species, in cluding raccoons and opossums, were involved.

So Burgess traps mammals, puts them down with an animal anaesthetic; bleeds them, tags the animals against the hope of recapture sometime, and releases them all, after which they are none

and roceases them all, after which they are none.

Special care must be exercised when bleeding raccounts because of the prevalence of rables in our local subspecies. Readers of this series will already be familiar with the details of this significant public health problem

cant public health problem.

So far, this year, no blood samples have been positive for SLE extrem. This is perbaga, a title surprising. To explain why, we must look at mosquito population statistics.

As a said earlier, the big roaring DCs have fog ged Samibel this year entry twice to date (Aug. 18) as follows:

Episode 1 — Sunday morning, Aug. 4 — sp-

plication of Baytex fog

Episode 2 — Saturday morning, Aug. 10 — application of melathion fog.

On Sanibel there are three mosquito sampling 'truck roules," each three miles long. The front of the mosquito catching truck has a sort of funnel or the missignite catening truck has a sort of lumbel that scoops up all flying insects (and sometimes other animals, even bats). The captured mosquitos are taken to the laboratory, identified, sorted by species and counted. This work is done by a skilled technician, Ardie Pidus. Her counts are tabulated by truck route, and mesquito species and are ready for use usually before noon. The three three-mile Sanibel routes are:

A. Captiva Bridge to Jamaica Drive

B. Rabbit Road (by the Timbers) to West
Gull Drive to the start of Casa Ybel Road at Tar-

C. Bailey's shopping center to the Causeway. Let's look at the counts of mosquitos just before and just after the two adulticide fogging episodes on Aug. 4 and Aug. 10. For simplicity, we will only consider female (biting) mosquitos in the short analysis represented in the charts on page 14B.

## A child's view of art



## Elementary school teacher sees it that way for her charges

anibel Elementary School art teacher
Jaye Boswell thinks youngsters enjoy
what they draw a whole lot more if the
subject is something they can relate to

So when her students took for something to draw, she suggests they comb the vast seaches of their bedroom closets for ideas. Drawing a pair of tattered sneakers is highly preferable to an old bottle or plastic grapes. Boswell believes.

And while she's at it, she lets her students hang on to their Crayolas. "We put an emphasis on the importance of the crayon. Each medium has its importance," she

Boswell remembers taking the children out behind the school one afternoon last year to gather leaves for a still life drawing. e only criterion was that "they had to be old and wrinkled," she says.

Using a pile of !caves as a somewhat

unusual model, the children did continuous line drawings that were later exhibited at the Edison Mall in Fort Myers, "They were lutely beautiful," Boswell says.

broughout the school year students are introduced to a whole range of sub-jects, ranging from weaving and pottery to art history and art appreciation. Of course, says Boswell, some subjects are

more popular than others.
"Printmaking has always been a hit, even

if it's cut vegetables you're starting with," she says. "Children are fascinated with be-

ing able to reproduce something." She says that at first boys wave off weav-ing as being a "girls' subject." But after they learn that men originated the craft, the

"Boys always have been my most fantastic weavers. They are so good with rhythm and color," Boswell says.

While art history and art appreciation probably make few students, "favorite classes" list, Boswell says every effort is made to make the subjects more palalable.

"Art history and art appreciation have to be done with looking, talking and then do-ing," Buswell maintains. "Children cannot sit through one-half hour of stides and get

that much out of it."

Far from being a frivolous class, Buswell thinks art has an important place in school.
"Art is a very positive subject," she says,
explaining, "Even for someone who's not" tremendously skilled, successes are to be had in the art room. There's no end to the direction art can take

"It's a building block for them. You see lot of little personalities develop. Boswell offers a variety of art projects so

Boswell offers a variety of art projects so that those who might not be particularly good at one craft can "show their stuff" at something else, she says.

This year, in addition to ber Wednesday afternoon class at Sanibel Elementary, Boswell will teach Mondays at Sunshine Elementary in Lehigh Acres, She also runs a cummercial art business in Sanibel and estructs a private art course for students in

Most important of all, though, also says, is the job she has raising her two boys, Channing, 14, and Duncan, 12.

Art has always been a part of Boswell's

life. When I was little my grandmother us-

Growing up in Rumson, N.J., Boswell aspired to be an anthropologist, but her family recognized her talent and hoped she'd follow other avenues. "My mother told everybody I was going to be a fashion illustrator," she says.

She earned a degree in art from Stephens
College in Columbia, Mo., and her teaching
certificate from the University of Miami, where she also met her luture husband. Bob, who was then a graduate student at

Between colleges, Boswell lived for a time in New York City, St. Thomas in the Virgin Islands and San Francisco. "You know when people joke about the artist sitting on a streetcorner selling his artwork -- well I

did that."
Her work, she says, evolved "from

creative painting to commercial art."
Reswell taught art in Coconut Grove, Fla.
for 10 years before moving to Sambel with her family four years ago. Unfortunately, she mays, she no longer has time to do her own artwork.







Dr. Collucci strongly believes in preventative or contact strongly between a preventative medicine, which runs right along with the philosophy of an osteopathic doctor, which is what Collucci does here on Sanibel.

pages, Dr. Collucci will write a regular column litled "Sports Medicine" that will focus on preventative medicine, nutrition, and sport-related

injuries.

Readers are encouraged to write in questions about injuries and medicine that are sports or outdoors related. Dr. Collucci will research the issue and report the answers. Questions could run the gamut from whether or not Gatorade is really good for an athlete, to the pros and cons of steroid

Use.

Dr. Collucci has a background that seems to have always linked sports and medicine.

He grew up with sports in a small Kansus town, carning a letter for four years of high school football.

"In a small farm community, that's just what you did—play football and bale hay." Dr. Colluc-ci laughed.

After high school, Dr. Collucti picked up a degree in nursing and was sent to Vietnam, where he worked in a MASH-like unit just 50 miles from the Demilitarized Zone

Back in the states at the end of 1964, he wound up dividing the next few years between work and school. Colorado and the mid-west.

In Colorado he worked at a hospital in Denver,

and later in 11,000-foot high Leadville, where "I skied just about every day." No wonder — Leadville lies right between Aspen and Vail on the Continental Divide

mental Divide. But he was also studying, attending anesthesia school at Weseley Medical Center in Wichita.
Kans., and night classes at the University of
Missouri. Then, on the GI Bill, Dr. Collucti finished up his pre-medical undergraduate work at Pitt-sburgh State University in 1973

He then decided to accept the challenge of a four-year osteopathic school.




