GUTSY LADY RAMPS THE WORLD

One of the reasons Dietrich Christianesen — whose faith is doubtless and rock. Another — would "ramp the world" is because she wants it available to her. And she is unafraid to acquire it alone, as she has often had to do as a woman.

Recently returned from a flight to Arkansas where she visited friends for a week, Christianesen, with her vehicle and her suitcase and her organized approach to the use of them, thought the trip had gone "so smoothly" as to say, "It was a trip she had to make to make for her to feel she can go anywhere, she said.

As for working over top Fort Myers and over Dixie, she checks out more of each a hour than she does at any of the world's population who are still alive. This is true even though an enormous number of people are still alive and working. She does not intend to fail and she will not stop.

"I always will stand by the fact that they are equipped for my type of work," which means a ramp of an inch or two — though I can manage a slightly steeper angle, she says.

One of the first places Christianesen approached eight years ago were churches, many of which were cluttered with cars.

"For so often, the ramp would lead to a little step where people wouldn't even notice was there," she said. Of course, "that little step" would be the point for the electric-driven wheel chair, and she wouldn't be able to participate in the activities of that particular church, along with her own, including, she said, and all other churches, including the Episcopal Church, St. Paul's.

"When there was this matter of having a ramp for the church, some of the officers, ministers and people were skeptical," she explained.

There was a plan to place the chair where she would not have to be on the ramp eight years ago — after the diagnosis of hip surgery in her left leg, five operations culminated in the final amputation and the year of dry, shyness. It was then again in constant pain, uncertainty and danger at the M.D. Anderson Hospital in Houston, Texas, that she was sent to the hospital.

"At first I was just up and out," Christianesen said. "I was anxious and I had a lot to learn and I didn't even know what I had in store."

"I had to realize that from the moment you get up in the morning until you go to bed, you're doing things entirely different than you were at home — from using the bathroom and taking a shower to getting dressed and even preparing the evening coffee — take double the amount of time

and doing with that you have complete on a machine to work a day.

"Clear lady in terms of how I feel from all that's been through and this other time. In my case it was a year or more." She had had to wait for the ramp to be built, clean the wood and change the driveway.

"I had had times — the thought of the building that I was always going to live this way was hard — also what I had to give up — golf, dancing, walking on the beach — but then I started looking for alternatives and came across the Amiga wheel chair, manufactured in Michigan. It's powered in motion with seat, that is electrically run. The get-well battery is rechargeable on an airplane."

Her amenability with chair, machine and station wagon, enabling her to be fully aware about hospital and Cayuga undercurrents, in families. People are inclined to want to help but she generally declines the kind of help that is, after all, thinking of how to leave a day and how to live outside conventions. Not only that, she has a system as well as a chair.

"When I use the machine to walk from the chair's side to the back of the station wagon then I walk for the beach, turn and lift, place it

It is not just I always carry on the luggage and sit down while I look up the portable hydraulic lift to the chair, then swing the base of the chair to the ground from the back of the station wagon. Next, I put the handle and seat in position in steps into the chair, and then I'm ready to go.

STEPHENS: SHELL RENAISSANCE

Shells have been used for decoration throughout the ages, shell historian says

Whether to be artist or scientist is a problem confronting Sue Stephens, who like Botticelli's famous Venus posed on the shell has had a rebirth, of sorts, from her association with the home of the mollusk.

At the moment she is artist, having just completed 25 depictions of

shells on patterns to be used for her tiles for the Sanibel Cafe, whose owners, Jack and Lynda Moll, are in the process of remodeling.

On another day, she might be scientist, noting carefully the characteristics of some fossils she has newly discovered at the MacAsphalt pits in Sarasota.

Then again, she may be writing and drawing from a model for her column in "The Island Reporter," to begin again in September after a summer hiatus.

But all times, she is Sue Stephens, art historian on the use of the shell as a motif in art, architecture, sculpture and culture. Such interest

followed almost immediately her discovery of the shell about 18 years ago.

"I've lived in all the greatest shelling places of the world—except Australia," says Sue, daughter of a general, wife of a colonel and genuine "military brat," whose ancestors were serving their country since the inception of West Point, about 1785.

"Everybody has twenty-twenty hindsight," says Sue, who in those days as military wife could not see the shells for the orchids and the little tropical birds — "finches, parakeets and gorgeous little whatever's."

She might pick up a shell on the beaches of the Philippines, Guam, Hawaii and Panama, all places where her husband, Lt. Col. John M. Stephens, was stationed, "see something shiny come out of the shell and — yuck!"

When finally she picked up a nuxea to draw it in exquisite detail, for transfer to a tile she would fire on her own kiln, it was a bit like being overwhelmed by a tidal wave. She could not stop with the drawing nor the learning.

Eventually, she developed notes for a lecture which has entertained audiences in Fort Myers, Sarasota and Naples.

"Even the Archaean screw is based on the design of the turret shell," explains Stephens. "Or take Da Vinci's spiral staircase, based on what we know as the Wentletrap."

She cites too the Egyptians' and Minoans' use of shells in jewelry and the Roman engineers' borrowing of

the design of the scallop shell for niches in their temples or decorative touches on funeral busts.

"In Christian art, the scallop became a symbol of having completed a pilgrimage to the tomb of St. James at Compostela because the beach there was strewn with shells."

Historian Stephens says that with the coming of the Renaissance, shells appeared as common decoration and architectural motifs. "One finds a stylized scallop appearing as a canopy for St. Nicholas, both painting or in sculpture," Botticelli depicts Venus stepping from a floating shell, which Stephens finds interesting because "Venus in Greek is Aphrodite, meaning 'foam born'."

Shell collectors have abounded in the work of professional artists in Antwerp, Sue maintains, since they have painted subjects with the collections as backgrounds. "Rembrandt's engraving of a cone shell is a famous example though it is reversed from the way he etched it because of the printing."

"Even the word, rococo, means, in French, rocaille — rock and coquille — which is shell, and the period was the most elaborate and ornate of all time," she says. "Shells of every kind — some interpreted beyond recognition — decorated everything — walls, furniture, jewelboxes, dishes, snuff boxes."

In a reversal of the trend today, shiploads of shells found their way to England and the Continent with the discovery of the New World, Stephens says. "It became fashionable among the nobility in England and on the Continent to build shell-lined or decorated grottoes and artificial caves. By the end of the golden age in Bococo, all great houses in England had their own shell rooms, caves and even underground apartments."

paper, obvious "faint" by her late mother or someone in the family. She holds forth a flat diamond of mother of pearl; larger, certainly than one could buy today and points out a few orange-colored snail shells probably found in the Philippines. And the shell as motif in art to do? Stephens would have one look about the dining kitchen of her present home, a rug, tiles, needlepoint pillows, a ceramic clock and the mirror frames are all her rendering.

Then there is the wallpaper, same pewter and brass, plastic and glass

washbacked, the Dhurri rug, place mats, a Sterling silver tray, blown, molded and lead crystal glass, stoneware fabric, boxes, elaborately candle, even the phone book has a shell motif. Shells never go out of style, it seems.

She is rather more into murals than into art, with the exception of her recent tiles, these days. "And five more feet a glass paner," she says. She rarely goes to the beach, even on Sanibel and Captiva, without returning with a bag full of finds for artwork with the exception of her fossil frames.

She would much prefer to find out more about the Shell Oil Company,

which she says was literally founded on fire grease, especially shells, in Saker's Tower, London, which Marcus Samuel had bought from sailors, "when he died in 1870, his estate was worth about 60,000 pounds, and the family decided to move into the monopoly held by Rockefeller and Standard Oil — oil having replaced shells as cargo on the ships."

"All the factories were named after shells, the first being the S.S. Murex," but what does this have to do with art now? "The stylized pattern, the separation of logos recognized the world over."

There are all the other, examples of shell as a motif in art, which

Stephens points out in her lecture, Crossed's "mother of pearl, an excellent for ivory, which can be painted, cut and polished, for furniture, jewelry, paper mache and jewelry."

For her lecture, Stephens is accustomed to starting in the podium example of the shell as motif in art rather than leave the subject to the imagination.
