A colorful new Sanibel-Captiva map chock full of information has just been

The map was constructed by Cana dia" John Scott who owns a Sambel condom.n.um and has vacationed on



I did this one totally on my own he says about the Sanibel map adding he usually employs a series of draft smen to do the cartography for his company s maps It's been great

The detailed work began with the cl ty of Sambel's 1983 survey and section maps. Scott collected the data while on vacation and then took it back to Canada for drafting

The colorful map provides much data it marks all of the preserved land of the J.N Dung Darling National Wildlife Refuge and the Sanibel Centiva Conservation Foundation and others in green 'll shopping com plexes are marked in red. - We no longer list every new guest who checks in to the Islands' motels every week
- Nor do we note the arrival of every property owner who returns for the winter ready to remove hurricane shutters and settle in for a season of pot luck dinners community dances and sing alongs at Scotty 8
- We haven t run advertisements on page one in years. And no one in our of fice can remember the last time an Island restaurant advertised a full course dunner for \$3
- Subscriptions now cost \$15 instead of \$3 for off Islanders and even Island res dents have to pay for the paper now (they received it free for the first cou ple of years)
- The first Islander was produced by a staff of two These days a staff of 10 plus a contingent of dedicated contributors play a vital role in producing the paper every week (And even with a team like that, some weeks it seems a minor miracle that we hit the

By the end of its first year of publication tion The Islander had grown to eight pages a week. In 1985 the average paper has 60 pages at least 24 of which are devoted to news stories and photographs — that s more news about Sambel and Captiva than you can find anywhere else



monus

First reds under the bushes only hit at one
time maximum high tide A tide chart will sho
you that every day two or possibly only one high tide occurs That s the time you want to look for reds in the woods Mangrove woods that is You will also notice that the tide is technically high for a total of one minute — not much time for fishing if that s the only time they bite right?

Well reds move to the shallows of the well reds move to the snaulows of the mangrove islands an hour or so before the official high And they feed for an hour or so after the high That gives you at least two hours to fish for reds The best part is if you know your tides you will be the company to the source of the control of the state of the will notice it s never high at two places at the same time For instance if it s high tide at the Sar ibel Lighthouse fishing pier at 11 40 a m then the high at Redfish Pass a duzen or so miles northwest will be at 2 22 pm Up around Boca Grande Pass high tide will be at 2 05 p m And over at Pineland on Pine Island Sound the high w ll be close to 3 p m This is just an example from actual tide charts but you can see that short

runs with a boat will keep you in high tides for the better part of a morning or afternoon.

Redfish only move into the shallows under the

mangrove limbs at the highest tide because it allows them to forage way back to the shallows for mud crabs shrimp and small fish
As the tide starts to fall the reds become

understandably nervous at the thought of being caught in tudal pools back in the woods with no way out Hawks like to hunt fish in this predica ment Osprey often work the low tides for nulle' trout and reds caught in low tide pools

So as the tide starts out the reds are less inclin ed to feed and are ready to move into the deeper waters of the passes or sound Flshing for reds basically involves a lot of pok

ing around casting to every single spot where a red might be resting or waiting for food My charter customers can't quite believe it when I tell them there are literally thousands of places to fish for reds Think of it! A thousand places to fish But the trouble is no one spot ever pays off every time Redfish often school and one day they could easily be 30 feet to the right of where they were the day before If you don't try every likely looking spot you won t find that stray

Reds of approximately the same size gather in

the rame school. If your first fish is a big one chances are you've bit a school in which they all are about that size

Remember the state law now says reds must measure more than 13 inches to thate and only one over 37 inches can be kept. The other day we hauled in half a dozen 16-17 inchers! Six weeks ago that would have been a good catch of legal ish Not now

Some of the very best fishing for reds is in the Ding Darling National Wildlife Refuge IN Ding Darling National wildlide Heilige.
This is shallow water so you won t get in there with a deep draft boat A Lat bottomed skill is the best boat you can own for the task Most out boards can get in there—the problem is getting out When the reds start their retreat you better get out too Or spend the night in the woods. It

Some of the best woods fish ng these days is from the nort ern power lines on east into Hard working Bayou Holloway Bayou and Sambel Bayou These lovely areas have hundreds of birds some otters and perhaps a great catch of reds You can fish in these protected waters when the worst winds are blowing about.

The main thing abou fishing for reds is to get

Balley Tract and traveling the Sanibel Slough. Sightings of ot-ters were not restricted to any specific water system, and areas of observation were divided about equally between fresh and saltwater situstions. Several family groups were observed with egularity from the nature drive dike of the Darl-

The 1970 report states: "Observations of otters throughout the refuge in 1970 delighted members if the refuge staff and residents of the Sanibel-Captiva communities. Sightings of these animals were widespread and seem to be more frequent than in past years. Persons unfamiliar with these water mammals often visited head-quarters and related having sighted a seal. When informed what they had actually observed, they were definitely happier than if they had seen a

There were no observations or reports of otter kills on the roads during the year, One family group was seen with some regularity as it cross-ed Tarpon Bay Road from the east and used a well-evidenced trail through or to the Bailey

1971 showed an apparent increase with many widespread sightings. Then in 1972 the last report states, "Observations of otters this year seem to be more widespread than in previous years. Several visitors reported seeing ofters crossing the nature drive, and one was observed in the boat basin near the residences on Tarpon Bay. There were no observations or remorts of obbeing killed on the roads during the year."

In 1974 several reports of otter sightings were filed. The sightings ranged from the freshwater side of the "Ding" Darling dike to the sairwater side of the same dike, the Bailey Tract, Sanibel-Captiva Road and the Sanibel River.

The otter seems to be moderately successful bere on Sanibel, but I don't believe it could exist rithout the central freshwater system, in spite of the comment earlier in these notes that it does appear to hunt and fish in the saltwater I it must return to freshwate

the blocking and silting of the mosquito canals and ditches and the resultant reduction in otter habitat. The species, although present in 1985, is less prominent. Perhaps silting limits range and hence limits population.
The otter is found in two principal habitats:

freshwaters of the slough system and the "Ding".
Darling mangrove forests. It is not uncommon to find them in the gulf.

Breeding takes place in late winter and early spring. Dens usually are excavated in the banks of mosquito ditches and along the edges of salt marshes, and sometimes in hollow logs or piles of vegetation in the entrybes

might swim three to 10 miles during a few days

in both salt and freshwater and can range 50 to 100 miles in the course of a year. It peems apparent that blocking the mosquito canals, which fered such good otter habitat when first dug. limits the linear range of 1985 and as a consequence, limits the population.

Menhitis menhitis, the striped chunk, known to have occurred on Sanibel - Tracks were reported on Aug. 21 and 25, 1973. As there have been no recent sightings, we conclude that this

species is no longer present.

Mustala frenata peninaulæ, the Florida long-tailed weesel — There are no abolute records of this species on Sanibel. This animal, never common in South Florida, ranged in the past to Florida Bay and ridges along the gulf shore. It is probably a past resident and might possibly be a rare member of the present mammal communi-

rare memoer or me present mamma communi-ty on Sanibel.



Felis consolor early — The Florida or southeastern panther — Cougars are known to visit Sanibel when passing around a luge 40 to 60-square-mile range, which I believe is a "donut" surrounding Fort Myers. I do not believe the Florida cougar or panther population. today is pure subspecies coryi. Far too many western animals have been released in Florida for there to be subspecies integrity today. One student at the Florida State Museum believes that there should not be subspecific hybridize tion in the wild. Many others do not agree with this and believe that such breeding occurs.

This is a known breeding resident of Sambel.

Felis ratus - The Fertal domestic cat? - Many currently live on Sanibel and are causing serious

wildlife problems. Saniber is the "in" place for Lee Countians to dispose of unwanted cats.

Odocolleus virginianus seemiolus, the white-tailed deer — This species is now extinct on Samble except for occasional strays (three known in 10 years). It was well-known here in the past. Clarence Rutland told me of a herd of 18 near the Lighthouse about 60 years ago, About 10 years ago Willis Combs showed me an old skull at Woodmere Preserve.

There are 30 described subspecies or races of the white-tailed deer in North America: Florida has three: (1) the little Key deer, subspecies clavium which is quite small, (2) the one cited above, and (3) another form that ranges from the panhandle to Texas Gulf coast. Northern North American races are substantially larger than ours. Even smaller races can be found in Central America, where I once had one no larger than a sheltie pup.

Suidae — The pig family.

Sus scrola — the feral domestic swine. — This antifal was known in the past on Sanibel but is no longer present. It can be a serious problem on barrier islands. Nearby Cayo Costa lost several species, including the gopher tortoise, to swine. Forest understory was severely damaged and altered. Yet in some places this feral exotic is "managed" by state authorities as a "game' animal.

This ends my 10-year review of certain vertebrate animal groups on Sanibel. The review began some weeks ago with the amphibians. Then followed the reptiles: crocodillans, turtles, lizards and snakes. The birds are left to others.

This study was started about 10 years age with the invaluable help of Charles LeBuff, Sanibel's senior naturalist. Ten years hence — don't hold. your breath - I shall revert to and update these






