Through the efforts of concerned members, this year's student Council got off to a quick start with an examination of the school and the Council itself. In fact, the five executive officers began planning much of the work accomplished this year last May. Throughout the summer these officers met with each other and their new advisor, Mr. Joseph Pirrello to discuss their ideas and plans.

The Board of Education first felt the efforts of the new Council back in June, when either our President or Board Representative attended each meeting. Suggestions were always given at the meetings, and the Council began to earn the respect of the community and the Board. The Council is currently working on an "Out to Lunch" proposal with the Board, but the program for seniors will be run differently this year, as have been most things.

The entire Council, its functions and its duties, have been restructured. A "code of ethics" is now enforced and so is a "code of impeachment." Even the Constitution is being revised along with the "working ways" of the Council. But the old goals have not died out.

The Council recognizes its objective to serve the student body and has done everything in its power to do so. When smoking in the lavatories became a problem, the Council worked out a deal to negate permission slips for the smoking lounge. The Council even installed smoke alarms in the bathrooms. Then school spirit and pride were found to be lacking, so the Council instituted the spirit chain and the St. Valentine's Day carnation sale. Both were under the direction of the Social/Pep Committee and both started out to be non-profit and ended up making money. A soda machine was needed, but cups were a problem. One was installed with cans, clean-up crews were activated, and it is now our most steady form of revenue. Students needed more freedom, so, through long, careful planning, a senior lounge was instituted. Bulletin boards began to instill spirit as students became proud to see their achievements recognized. Exchanges with schools around the Suburban Conference became a new experience. Even vandalism has been curtailed by constant peer pressure, and it is the feeling that because of propaganda by this Council, the Middle States Evaluation of our school was a success. This year the Council even made a strong contribution of its members to the Honor Society.

Future projects the Council plans to undertake include Baskets for Burns, a sports marathon, and investigations into the workings of our school.

This year's Council would like to extend its thanks to its members who sat through boring meeting; the teachers who constantly encouraged us; the administration who were always patient with us; but most of all, the five officers who worked their hearts out for us.
