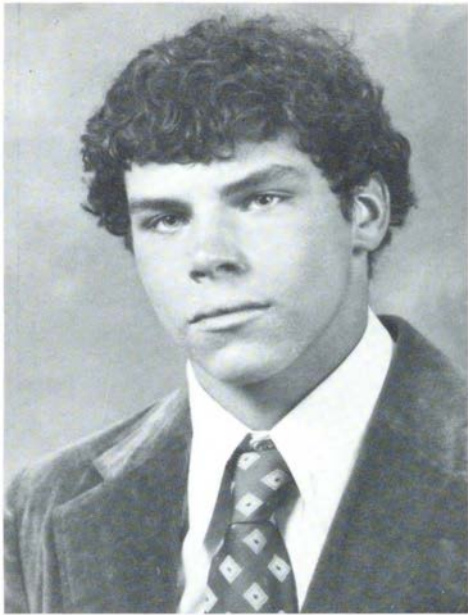


Junior Year 1981-1982

Senior Year 1982-1983

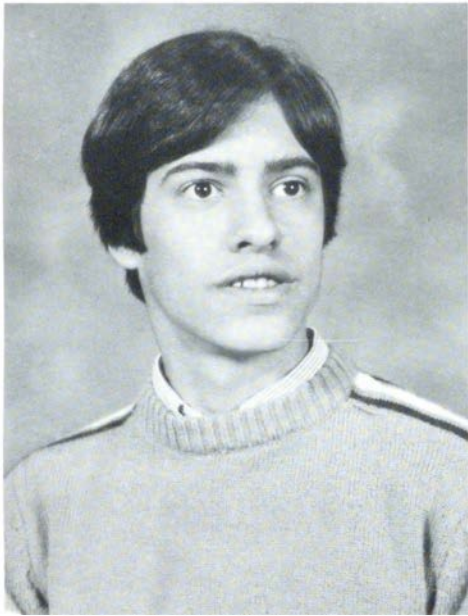
